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**Point No. 1:**

The main surface water sources of Telengana are Godavari and Krishna river basins. Godavari and Krishna Water Disputes Tribunal have in 1980 and 1976 respectively determined the water resources of these basins for erstwhile State of AP. Part IX of AP Reorganization Act, 2014 deals with management of water resources of erstwhile State of AP without indicating any specific quantum of water of aforesaid river basins to these States.

**Point No. 2:**

Under PMKSY-AIBP, 99 priority projects were identified out of the total 149 ongoing MMI Projects under AIBP in consultation with the states for prioritised completion. These projects are targeted to be completed by the end of the year 2019 in a phased manner. Out of these 99 projects, 11 projects are in State of Telangana. The requisite information is placed at Annexure.

**Point No. 4:**

As per records available, no water resources project of Telangana State is recognized as National Projects.

However, DPR of the Kaleshwaram Integrated Project has been accepted by the Advisory Committee during its 136<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 06.06.2018. Now, State Govt. has to submit the proposal for inclusion in National Projects after obtaining its Investment Clearance.

Central Govt. under the scheme of National Project gives Central assistance to projects as grant meeting any of the following selection criteria:

- (i) International projects where usage of water in India is required by a treaty or where planning and early completion of the project is necessary in the interest of the country.
- (ii) Inter-State projects which are dragging on due to non-resolution of inter-State issues relating to sharing of costs, rehabilitation, aspects of power production etc. including river interlinking projects.
- (iii) Intra-State projects with additional potential of more than 2, 00,000 ha with no dispute regarding sharing of water and where hydrology is established.
- (iv) Extension, renovation and modernization projects envisaging restoration of lost potential of 2 lakh or more subject to certain conditions.

As per Guidelines of National Projects, the concerned State Governments may submit the proposal for inclusion under the scheme of National Project to Central Water Commission Field unit after satisfying the above selection criteria, TAC & investment clearance of the project.

**Point No. 3 & 5:**

No information is available as far as WP&P Wing of CWC is concerned.
