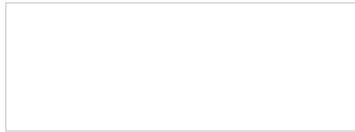

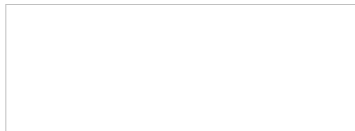

Dear Secretary,

As you may be aware that the Government has given high priority to frame laws facilitating enforcement of contracts with a view to make India one of the preferred destinations for investment and business. In this context, the Department of Legal Affairs had earlier enacted the Commercial Courts Act, 2015. Further to facilitate the Ease of Doing Business (EoDB) and improve India's ranking in World Bank Report on EoDB, Commercial Courts Act, 2015 was amended for providing quick resolution of commercial disputes of a specified value of rupees 3 lakhs and above by dedicated Commercial Courts. This forms part of systemic reforms envisaging effective and amicable resolution of maximum commercial disputes in a time bound manner through judicial process.

2. In this regard, e-filing in commercial cases has also been operationalized in the dedicated Commercial Courts of Delhi and Mumbai, through eCourts Services Project, being implemented by the Department of Justice. This e-filing portal having the facility for e-payment of court fees is aimed at promoting paperless filing and also to save time, reduce costs and add efficiency to judicial process.

3. I am therefore to request you that in cases pending before the Commercial Courts in Mumbai and Delhi, being handled by your Ministry/ Department including Autonomous Bodies, Subordinate Offices, attached Offices and PSUs under Administrative control of your Ministry, the e-filing route, be mandatorily followed.
