# Flood victims see discrimination in relief distribution

Flood victims complained of discrimination in the disbursement of immediate relief granted by the government.

They alleged that people who are close to public representatives or political leaders are getting relief while many are being refused.

The residents' grievance was that officials are showing discrimination in distributing the immediate

relief of ₹10,000, which reduces their chances of their getting full relief later. They complained that the officials have selected particular families on the instance of the concerned corporator or MLA. They apprehend that if they raise voice against the discrimination, they will be targeted by political goons and deprived further.

Residents of Shaikpet, Himathnagar, Jubilee Hills and Amberpet complained that they were provided

with a reduced relief amount.

Two and sometimes four families were asked to share the amount allocated for a single dwelling unit. They said in clusters many families reside in a single house.

In such cases, the amount was divided among the dwellers.

In Ahmed nagar, Pochamma basti, Anjuman area in Vijaynagar colony, Sabir nagar, Gosha mahal, many people complained that only selected residents

were getting benefits. Residents of Red Hills also complained that they were denied just because they were not familiar with the corporator. When they approached him, they were asked to consult the political leaders they supported in the elections.

Amjedullah Khan,

spokesperson for Majlis Bachao Tehreek, demanded an inquiry into the rampant corruption and loot of the ₹550 crore relief package for flood victims. Leaders of the ruling party and its allies with the help of corrupt officials had made it a private corporate fund as it is being released from their party's exchequer.

The public fund is being looted openly and most of the amount disbursed on false claims recommended by political leaders or with-

out proper verification. He alleged that the state fund is being disbursed based on political affiliation as a campaign for the forthcoming GHMC elections which defeats the purpose of relief and the welfare scheme.

Social worker, Asif Hussain, said there is a need to carry out an independent assessment of the damages due to flood without the involvement of political leaders to ensure selection of genuinely affected families.

There are a lot of complaints from different areas about not receiving relief amounts, said Hussain. People who lost their belongings in the flood should not be denied aid being distributed by the government just because of their political affiliations or the lack of them.

He suggested establishing a grievance control room to resolve complaints of discrimination in the disbursement of the relief amount.

## Expedite relief, restoration works in rain-hit areas: KTR

Municipal administration and urban development minister K. T. Rama Rao on Wednesday held a review meeting with senior officials of Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC), Hyderabad Metropolitan Water Supply and Sewerage Board (HMWSSB), and TS State Electricity Board (TSSEB) with regard to ongoing relief and restoration works in the rain-affected areas of twin cities.

He instructed officials to speed up relief and restoration works in

Officials said they have launched a special drive to collect 3,500 metric tonnes of waste. With this, about 18,000 metric tonnes of waste has so far been removed.

GHMC and surrounding areas, so that normalcy could be restored immediately.

Municipal officials informed the minister that ₹10,000 financial assistance is being handed over to the rain and flood-affected families at a fast pace. Additional municipal workers have been deployed to take up sanitation works, remove

sludge accumulated due to rains, dispose of garbage and spray disinfectants. Officials said they have launched a special drive to collect 3,500 metric tonnes of waste. With this, about 18,000 metric tonnes of waste has so far been removed.

KTR asked officials to provide helpline numbers to citizens through which they can ask the municipal corporation to clear debris and flood-related trash from their areas. He wanted officials to rope in resident welfare associations and NGOs for assistance in extending relief measures to the needy. He

instructed officials to immediately start road repair works along all major roads to avoid inconvenience to citizens.

The minister ordered officials to set up retro fittings along all flyovers for ensuring that rain-water flows down easily. In this context, officials informed him that they have sought suggestions and inputs given by the irrigation department for repairing damaged lakes.

KTR also asked officials to ensure that garbage, which had accumulated in nalas during recent rains, is removed.

# Central Govt to award Chhattisgarh CM's Narva programme: Bilaspur, Surajpur districts selected for National Water Award


**RAIPUR:** The state of Chhattisgarh has achieved another major achievement under the leadership of Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel. The Central Government will award the Chief Minister's Narva programme. Bilaspur district of the state for the works done for the renovation of the river/drains and Surajpur district for the water conservation work, was ranked first among the best districts in the country for works done in two years, under the Narva programme by the Ministry of Water Power, Government of India.

The National Water Award for the year 2019 will be given to both the districts for the conservation and promotion of water sources by the Ministry of Water Power of the Central Government. Bilaspur district has been selected for the first

prize at the national level in the East Under Revival of River category and Surajpur district in the East Under Water Conservation category. The award will be given in the month of November.

It is worth mentioning that with the formation of new government in the state, Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel has given a new life to the rural economy of the state with the vision of saving the four icons of Chhattisgarh, 'Narva, Garuva, Ghurwa and Bari'.

Under Narva programme, an important component of the ambitious Suraji village scheme of Chhattisgarh government, a large number of rivers and drains are being conserved and promoted in all districts of the state. With this, availability of drinking water is ensured, development of irrigation resources, recharge of ground water is being done giving a



new life to the rural economy.

Under the Narva programme, 47 structures were constructed in various rivers and drains in Bilaspur district and 17.508 million cubic meters of water-logging capacity was created and up to 152 kilometers, water availability was ensured in rivers and drains. With this, 49 small reservoir schemes are under construction in the district which will create 48.53 million cubic

meters of water logging capacity. Due to this, water will be filled in 181 km long river and drains.

The total length of the 13 main rivers and drains and local drains flowing in Bilaspur district is 2352.56 km. In this, the Water Resources Department has constructed one large, one medium and 165 small reservoirs and 117 anicut. The Water Resources Department has revived a total of 1146.90 km of rivers and drains. 284 structures have been built in these river-channels, out of which 13 in Kharang River, 5 in Shivrath, 13 in Lilagar, 17 in Arpa, 12 in Son River, 8 in Maniyari River, 12 in Ghulagha Nala, 5 in Gokna Nala. Small reservoirs and anicuts have been constructed at Tunggan Nala, 3 at Narmada Nala, 3 at Champi Nala, 4 at Alan Nala, 5 at Jevan Nala and 181 at local drains.

Similarly, the Dabri Mahabhiyan program was launched to conserve water in Surajpur district and raise the level of ground water. In which structures like Loose Boulder Check Dam were constructed to revive the beneficiary-oriented Dabri, the well-known small drains in addition to the well. About 7 thousand Dabri and 4200 wells have been built in the last two years under the Dabri Mahabhiyan. In this, about 18 thousand acres of land was irrigated and farmers started taking crops twice a year. Apart from this, the work of reviving small and large drains was started in the last two years. Structures like 29 earthen dams, 57 stop dams, 10 under-ground dykes and 10,000 contour trenches were constructed, due to which irrigation potential has been increased in about 12 thousand hectare land and underground water level has also increased.

## बिलासपुर और सूरजपुर को जल संरक्षण के लिए राष्ट्रीय पुरस्कार

देश में जल संरक्षण एवं संवर्धन के लिए जल स्रोतों के पुनरोद्धार के मामलों में छत्तीसगढ़ के बिलासपुर और सूरजपुर जिलों को पहले राष्ट्रीय जल पुरस्कार के लिए चुना गया है। इन जिलों में छत्तीसगढ़ सरकार ने पिछले दो सालों में नदी व नालों के पुनरोद्धार के लिए नरवा कार्यक्रम के तहत बड़ी उपलब्धि हासिल की है। जलशक्ति मंत्रालय ने जल स्रोतों के संरक्षण एवं संवर्धन में विशेष योगदान के लिए छत्तीसगढ़ के बिलासपुर और सूरजपुर जिलों को 2019 का 'राष्ट्रीय जल पुरस्कार' के लिए चयनित किया गया है। पुरस्कार नवंबर में दिया जाएगा।

## लद्दाख में 2021-22 तक सभी ग्रामीणों को मिलेगा शुद्ध पानी

नई दिल्ली। केंद्र सरकार 2024 तक देशभर के सभी ग्रामीण परिवारों को नल कनेक्शन के जरिए शुद्ध पीने का पानी मुहैया कराने के लिए जल जीवन मिशन का युद्ध स्तर पर कार्यान्वयन कराने में जुटी हुई है। इसी मिशन के तहत एक साल पहले अस्तित्व में आए नए केंद्र शासित प्रदेश लद्दाख में वर्ष 2021-22 तक सभी ग्रामीण परिवारों में गुणवत्तायुक्त शुद्ध पानी पहुंचाने की योजना है। केंद्रीय जल शक्ति मंत्रालय के अनुसार जल जीवन मिशन के कार्यान्वयन को लेकर मंत्रालय द्वारा राज्यवार प्रगति की मध्यावधि समीक्षा की जा रही है। इसी श्रृंखला में जम्मू-कश्मीर के विभाजन के बाद अस्तित्व में आए नए केंद्र शासित प्रदेश लद्दाख में वीडियो कॉन्फ्रेंसिंग के जरिए जल जीवन मिशन के कार्यान्वयन की प्रगति की मध्यावधि समीक्षा की गई।

**जल जीवन मिशन: केंद्रीय जलशक्ति  
मंत्रालय ने की मध्यावधि समीक्षा**

**राजस्थान के 20.69 लाख  
ग्रामीण घरों में इस साल  
नल से पहुंचेगा जल**

नई दिल्ली. केंद्र सरकार की जल जीवन मिशन योजना के तहत राजस्थान में वर्ष 2020-21 में 20.69 लाख ग्रामीण घरों में नल से जल आने लगेगा, इस वर्ष चूरू जिले के 100 फीसदी ग्रामीण घरों में नल से जल पहुंचाने की योजना है। राजस्थान में वर्ष 2023-24 तक सभी ग्रामीण घरों में 100 फीसदी नल कनेक्शन की योजना बना रहा है। राज्य में करीब 1.01 करोड़ ग्रामीण आवास हैं, जिनमें से 88.57 लाख में घरेलू नल कनेक्शन नहीं है। केंद्रीय जलशक्ति मंत्रालय ने जल जीवन मिशन की मध्यावधि समीक्षा की है, जिसमें 44,641 बस्तियों में मौजूदा पाइप लाइन से जलापूर्ति (पीडब्ल्यूएस) योजनाओं के विश्लेषण की आवश्यकता पर जोर दिया गया है। समीक्षा के दौरान 20,172 गांवों को चिन्हित कर वहां योजनाओं की जांच कराने का फैसला किया गया है।

राजस्थान में दिसंबर 2020 तक 8.74 लाख की आबादी वाली शेष बची 1,545 फ्लोराइड प्रभावित बस्तियों में शुद्ध पेयजल उपलब्ध कराने की योजना है। राज्य को पानी की कमी वाले क्षेत्रों, आकांक्षी जिलों, एससी/एसटी बहुल गांवों और सांसद आदर्श ग्राम योजना (एसएजीवाई) के तहत गांव को बराबरी के साथ शामिल करने के लिए विशेष

रूप से ध्यान देने के निर्देश दिए गए हैं। केंद्र ने 2020-21 में जल जीवन मिशन के तहत राजस्थान को 2,522 करोड़ रुपए का आवंटन किया है। राज्य को पहले से 389 करोड़ रुपए राष्ट्रीय जल गुणवत्ता उप मिशन के तहत पानी की गुणवत्ता प्रभावित बस्तियों को सुरक्षित पेयजल उपलब्ध कराने के लिए अलग से आवंटित किए गए हैं। वहीं 15वें वित्त आयोग का पंचायती राज संस्था-पीआरआई को 50 फीसदी अनुदान पानी और स्वच्छता पर खर्च किया जाना है। राजस्थान को 2020-21 में वित्त आयोग के अनुदान के रूप में 3,862 करोड़ आवंटित किए गए हैं। जल जीवन मिशन योजना के तहत वर्ष 2024 तक प्रत्येक ग्रामीण आवास में नल कनेक्शन उपलब्ध कराकर प्रति व्यक्ति प्रतिदिन 55 लीटर पीने योग्य पानी प्रदान करने का लक्ष्य निर्धारित किया गया है।

केंद्र ने राजस्थान से अनुरोध किया गया कि सभी आंगनवाड़ी केंद्रों, आश्रमों और स्कूलों को नल से जलापूर्ति प्रदान की जाए क्योंकि 2 अक्टूबर, 2020 को विशेष 100-दिवसीय अभियान चलाया गया है, ताकि पीने, हाथ धोने के लिए, शौचालयों में उपयोग के लिए और मध्याह्न भोजन पकाने के लिए इन संस्थानों में पीने योग्य पानी उपलब्ध हो सके।
