

BRIEF NOTE ON LIVE STORAGE STATUS OF 140 RESERVOIRS IN THE COUNTRY (WITH REFERENCE TO RESERVOIR STORAGE BULLETIN OF 05.05.2022)

1. ALL INDIA STATUS

Central Water Commission is monitoring live storage status of 140 reservoirs of the country on weekly basis and is issuing weekly bulletin on every Thursday. Out of these reservoirs, 45 reservoirs have hydropower benefit with installed capacity of more than 60 MW. The total live storage capacity of these 140 reservoirs is **175.957 BCM** which is about **68.25%** of the live storage capacity of 257.812 BCM which is estimated to have been created in the country. As per reservoir storage bulletin dated **05.05.2022**, live storage available in these reservoirs is **62.124 BCM**, which is **35%** of total live storage capacity of these reservoirs. However, last year the live storage available in these reservoirs for the corresponding period was **57.556 BCM** and the average of last 10 years live storage was **48.96 BCM**. Thus, the live storage available in 140 reservoirs as per **05.05.2022 Bulletin** is **108%** of the live storage of corresponding period of last year and **127%** of storage of average of last ten years.

As per Table-01, the overall storage position is **better than the** corresponding period of last year in the country as a whole and it is also **better than the** average storage of last ten years during the corresponding period.

2. REGION WISE STORAGE STATUS:

a) NORTHERN REGION

The northern region includes States of Himachal Pradesh, Punjab and Rajasthan. There are 9 reservoirs under CWC monitoring having total live storage capacity of 19.37 BCM. As per Reservoir Storage Bulletin dated **05.05.2022**, the total live storage available in these reservoirs is **5.77 BCM** which is **30%** of total live storage capacity of these reservoirs. The storage during corresponding period of last year was **21%** and average storage of last ten years during corresponding period was **33%** of live storage capacity of these reservoirs. Thus, storage during current year is better than the corresponding period of last year but is less than the average storage of last ten years during the corresponding period.

b) EASTERN REGION

The Eastern region includes States of Jharkhand, Odisha, West Bengal, Tripura, Nagaland and Bihar. There are 21 reservoirs under CWC monitoring having total live storage capacity of 20.09 BCM. As per Reservoir Storage Bulletin dated **05.05.2022**, the total live storage available in these reservoirs is **6.02 BCM** which is **30%** of total live storage capacity of these reservoirs. The storage during corresponding period of last year was **27%** and average storage of last ten years during corresponding period was **35 %** of live storage capacity of these reservoirs. Thus, storage during current year is better than the corresponding period of last year but is less than the average storage of last ten years during the corresponding period.

c) WESTERN REGION

The Western region includes States of Gujarat and Maharashtra. There are 46 reservoirs under CWC monitoring having total live storage capacity of 36.41 BCM. As per Reservoir Storage Bulletin dated **05.05.2022**, the total live storage available in these reservoirs is **14.27 BCM** which is **39%** of total live storage capacity of these reservoirs. The storage during corresponding period of last year was **40%** and average storage of last ten years during corresponding period was **27%** of live storage capacity of these reservoirs. Thus, storage during current year is less than the storage of last year but is better than the average storage of last ten years during the corresponding period.

d) CENTRAL REGION

The Central region includes States of Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh. There are 25 reservoirs under CWC monitoring having total live storage capacity of 47.39 BCM. As per Reservoir Storage Bulletin dated **05.05.2022**, the total live storage available in these reservoirs is **17.96 BCM** which is **38%** of total live storage capacity of these reservoirs. The storage during corresponding period of last year was **33%** and average storage of last ten years during corresponding period was **33%** of live storage capacity of these reservoirs. Thus, storage during current year is better than the storage of last year and also it is better than the average storage of last ten years during the corresponding period.

e) SOUTHERN REGION

The Southern region includes States of Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, AP&TG (2combined projects in both states), Karnataka, Kerala and Tamil Nadu. There are 39 reservoirs under CWC monitoring having total live storage capacity of 52.70 BCM. As per Reservoir Storage Bulletin dated **05.05.2022**, the total live storage available in these reservoirs is **18.11 BCM** which is **34.4%** of total live storage capacity of these reservoirs. The storage during corresponding period of last year was **33.6%** and average storage of last ten years during corresponding period was **19%** of live storage capacity of these reservoirs. Thus, storage during current year is better than the storage of corresponding period of last year and is also better than the average storage of last ten years during the corresponding period.

The region wise and reservoir wise details are given in the following pages of the Bulletin.

BROAD ANALYSIS OF OTHER TABLES IN THE BULLETIN

- Normal storage means average storage of last ten years, Close to normal storage means where shortfall is upto 20% of normal, deficient storage is where shortfall is more than 20% of the normal and upto 60% of the normal, highly deficient means where shortfall is more than 60% of normal.
- In the table on page 12, better than normal storage is available in Ganga, Narmada Tapi, Rivers of Kutch, Godavari, Krishna, , Cauvery & neighbouring EFRs and West Flowing Rivers of South. Close to Normal in Subarnarekha, Indus and Mahanadi & Neighbouring East Flowing Rivers. Deficient in Sabarmati and Mahi and Nil in Highly Deficient.
- Table on page 13-15 of the bulletin. The numbers of reservoirs having storage more than last year are **84** and reservoirs having storage more than average of last ten years are **97**. The numbers of reservoirs having storage less than or equal to 20% with respect to last year is **06** and having storage less than or equal to 20% with reference to average of last ten years is **04**. The number of reservoirs having storage less than or equal to 50% with respect to last year are **12** and having storage less than or equal to 50% with reference to average of last ten years are **11**.

States having better storage (in %) than last year for corresponding period: Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Jharkhand, Odisha, West Bengal, Nagaland, Bihar, Uttarakhand, Madhya Pradesh, AP&TG (Two combined projects in both states), Karnataka, Kerala and Tamil Nadu.

States having equal storage (in %) to last year for corresponding period: Nil

States having lesser storage (in %) than last year for corresponding period: Rajasthan, Tripura, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

1 Central Water Commission is monitoring storage status of 140 important reservoirs spread all over the country, in which **45** reservoirs have hydropower benefit each with installed capacity of more than 60 MW. These reservoirs are identified thus(*) in the enclosed weekly report.

2 The total live storage in 140 important reservoirs in different parts of the country, monitored by CWC as on

05-05-2022 is **62.124** BCM (**35** percent of the live storage capacity at FRL).The current year's storage is nearly **108** percent of last year's storage and **127** percent of the average of last ten years.






STORAGE POSITION OF 140 IMPORTANT RESERVOIRS IN INDIA (WATER YEAR 2021-2022)
