“Nari Shakti Puraskars” – National Award for Women –Guidelines

International Women's Day is celebrated every year on 8th March. The Ministry of Women & Child Development celebrates this day to acknowledge the achievements of women for the nation and recognize their contributions to the society.

Therefore, it has been decided by the Ministry to confer 'Nari Shakti Puraskars' every year to individuals and institutions in recognition of their service towards the cause of women empowerment, especially vulnerable and marginalized women.

2. Objectives

- 2.1 In the past few years, there have been concerted efforts by the Government to recognise and encourage women to participate in all spheres and issues related to women have gained utmost importance and focused attention. “Nari Shakti Puraskars” shall showcase the Government's commitment towards women with the aim of strengthening their position in the society.
- 2.2 Nari Shakti Puraskar will also provide an opportunity to Young Indians to understand the contribution of women in building of society and the nation.
- 2.3 The awards will inspire the individuals & institutions to follow the league of awardees.

3. Description

- 3.1 The recipients of the Nari Shakti Puraskars shall be declared every year by 20th February and awards will be conferred on 8th March on the occasion of International Women's Day (IWD).
- 3.2 The maximum number of awards (including individual and institutional) would be 30. The Award in each category shall carry a certificate and a cash amount of rupees one lakh.

4. Eligibility Criteria for Nomination

- 4.1 The awards are open to all individuals and institutions.
- 4.2 In case of individual category, the awardee must be at least 25 years of age on the last date of receipt of nomination.
- 4.3 If the applicant is an institution, it should have worked in the relevant field for at least 5 years.
- 4.4 The applicant should not be a recipient of the same award earlier (including Stree Shakti Puraskars as were awarded by the Ministry).
- 4.5 The Nari Shakti Puruskar may be awarded for outstanding work, preferably in exceptional circumstances, to - individuals/ groups / institutions / NGOs, etc. in the areas of: economic and social empowerment of women; effective

implementation of women related legislations; gender mainstreaming and positive actions in favour of women.

The Nari Shakti Puruskar may be awarded to individuals/ groups/ NGOs/ institutions etc. who encouraged women to participate in decision making roles; encouraged women's skill development in traditional and non-traditional sectors; facilitated basic amenities for rural women; promoted women in non-traditional sectors like science and technology, sports, art, culture, etc.

- 4.6 An award shall also be given to a State or Union Territory, which has appreciably improved Child Sex Ratio (CSR).
- 4.7 Normally the awards shall not be presented posthumously; excepting in cases where death occurred subsequent to a proposal having been submitted to the Ministry in the manner as stipulated in these guidelines.

5 Nominations

- 5.1 Nominations for the award shall be invited from:
 - (a) State Governments, Union Territory Administrations, concerned Central Ministries/Departments.
 - (b) Non-Governmental Organizations, Universities/ Institutions, Private and Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) working for empowerment of women through the State Govt./Central Ministry/Department concerned.
 - (c) However, in exceptional cases, the Selection Committee may also, *suomoto*, recommend an individual/ institution for the award with sufficient justification.
 - (d) Self-nominations for the awards shall also be considered.
- 5.2 The Nominations would be sent to the Ministry of Women and Child Development with details as per application form (Annexure-I) alongwith supporting documents as mentioned in the application form.
- 5.3 The entities at para 5.1 recommending the nominations should clearly certify the work carried out by the nominees for which the award is being recommended.

6. Mode of calling the nominations

- 6.1 For inviting the applications for the awards, an advertisement will be published by the Ministry of Women and Child Development, Govt. of India in leading Newspapers across the country. The Ministry will also write to all the State Governments, Union Territory Administrations, concerned Central Ministries/ Departments.
- 6.2 The information will be simultaneously placed on Ministry's website and other social media platforms (facebook, twitter, etc.) along with the prescribed format.
- 6.3 The last date of the submission of the application will be mentioned in the advertisement. The applications received after the last date will not be considered.

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7. Screening of Nominations

7.1 A Screening Committee shall be constituted by the Ministry of Women and Child Development to scrutinize and short list the nominations received for the Awards considering the achievements of the individuals and institutions.

7.2 The Screening Committee shall consist of :

(i)	Joint Secretary, Ministry of Women and Child Development	-	Chairperson, ex-officio

(v)	Representative of CII and FLO(FICCI)	-	Member
(vi)	Concerned Under Secretary, Ministry of Women and Child Development	-	Member Secretary

8. Selection of Awardees by the Selection Committee

8.1 A Selection Committee shall be constituted by the Ministry of Women and Child Development to select the awardees on the basis of recommendation of the Screening Committee.

8.2 The Selection Committee shall consist of:

(i)	Hon'ble Minister for Women and Child Development	-	Chairperson, ex-officio
(ii)	Hon'ble Minister of State for Women and Child Development		Member, ex-officio
(iii)	Secretary, Ministry of Women & Child Development	-	Member, ex-officio
(iv)	Special or Additional Secretary, Ministry of Women & Child Development	-	Member, ex-officio
(v)	Secretary or his nominee from Ministry of Rural Development	-	Member, ex-officio
(vi)	Five National level eminent NGOs/Individuals/ Institutions	-	Co-opted members
(vii)	Joint Secretary (Women Awards),	-	Member-Secretary

8.3 The Selection Committee may at its discretion also consider individuals other than those recommended by the State Governments/Central Ministries.

8.4 The Ministry reserves the right to reject any entry.

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9. Presentation of Award

- 9.1 The Award shall be presented at New Delhi at a special ceremony/function held on the occasion of the International Women's Day on 8th March every year.
- 9.2 The Ministry will reimburse travel expenses by economy class by shortest route, for the awardees to and from Delhi, by Air India or any other airline as specifically permitted and local travelling allowance on production of bills and air tickets. Apart from this, boarding and lodging arrangements for the awardees for three days (one day prior and one day after the date of Award ceremony) shall be arranged by the Ministry.

The undersigned is directed to say that this Ministry has instituted awards viz. National Award for Child Welfare and Rajiv Gandhi Manav Seva Award to give due recognition to individual and institutions who make outstanding contribution towards child welfare and service. A copy of the guidelines and proforma in Hindi and English are enclosed and the same are also available on the Ministry's Website (i.e. www.wcd.nic.in) under Award head. The salient features of the awards are given below :-

(1) National Award for Child Welfare for 2016

This award will be given to 3 individuals and 5 institutions for each year who have worked for the welfare of children for some years. Paid officers of institutions will not be eligible for selection. The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 3 lakh and a citation to each institution and Rs. 1 lakh and a citation to each individual. The last date for receipt of applications /nominations is 31.07.2017.

(2) Rajiv Gandhi Manav Seva Award for 2017

This award will be given to 3 individuals who have worked for the cause of children for over 10 years in the field of Child Development, Child Protection, and Child Welfare. Paid officers of institutions will not be eligible for selection. The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 1 lakh and a citation. The last date for receipt of applications /nominations is 31.07.2017

(3) National Child Award for Exceptional Achievement Award, 2017


This awards will be given to children above the age of 5 and not exceeding 18 years with exceptional abilities and outstanding achievement in field of innovation, scholastic achievements, sports, arts, culture, social service, music and any other field which deserves recognition as per decision of the Central Selection Committee. One gold medal and 35 silver medals (one per each State/ UT) are given. For gold medalist, a gold medal, a cash prize of Rs. 20,000/-, book vouchers worth Rs. 10,000/- and a certificate and citation is given while for silver medalist a silver medal, a cash prize of Rs. 10,000/-, book vouchers worth Rs. 3,000/- and a certificate and citation is given. The last date for receipt of applications /nominations is 31.07.2017

SCHEME OF NATIONAL AWARDS FOR THE BEST WORK DONE IN A YEAR IN THE
CAUSE OF CHILDREN

INTRODUCTION

The United Nations had declared 1979 as the "International Year of the Child". The objectives of the "International Year of the Child", as delineated in the United Nations General Assembly Resolution of 21 December 1976, were as follows:-

- a. To provide a framework for advocacy on behalf of children and for enhancing the awareness of the special needs of children on the part of decision-makers and the public
 - b. To promote recognition of the fact that programmes for children should be an integral part of economic and social development plans with a view to achieving, in both the long term and the short term, sustained activities for the benefit of children at the national/international levels.
2. India has been one of the leading nations to espouse the cause of the children and promote the efforts of the international community that led to the declaration of 1979 as the "International Year of the Child". The advocacy of the cause of the children and the enhanced emphasis on the programmes for the welfare of children were not confined to the year 1979 alone. Rather, the International Year of the Child was the jumping board to promote programmes of a larger dimension and create a greater awareness in the nation for the cause of children.
3. Voluntary efforts have a special place in the total efforts of the country to promote the well being of the children. A number of voluntary organizations are already engaged in this work. The dimension of voluntary action and its importance in the country are expected to grow with time.
4. As a system of state recognition of voluntary efforts for the cause of children, the Govt. of India initiated, in 1979, the scheme of State recognition of voluntary efforts in the cause of children in the country.
5. The scheme as revised from time to time, now envisages awards to (i) three individuals who have done the best work in the cause of children; and (ii) five institutions that have done the best work in any branch of child welfare.

SCOPE

6. Separate awards will be presented to individuals who have rendered the best work for the cause of children and to institutions who have rendered the best work for the cause of children in a particular year. There is no objection to an individual and the institution with whom the individual is connected receiving the award in the same year.

NATURE OF AWARDS

7. The Award for each individual (Maximum three) shall consist of:-

- (i) A cash prize of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rs.One Lakh)
- (ii) A citation.

8. The award to each institution (Maximum five) shall consist:-

- (i) A cash prize of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rs.Three Lakh)
- (ii) A citation.

PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION

9. Initially, a Committee appointed by each State/UT will make selection among individuals and institutions in a State/Union Territory. The composition of this Committee will be left to the State Government/Union Territory Administration. They may take into consideration the pattern of composition of the National Selection Committee.

10. The State/UT Selection Committee will make selections in accordance with the guidelines issued in this regard from time to time.

11. A National Committee consisting of the following persons will make final selection: -

(i) Minister of Women & Child Development	Chairperson
(ii) Secretary, M/o Women & Child Development	Member
(iii) A representative of the D/o School Education & Literacy	Member
(iv) A representative of the M/o Health & Family Welfare	Member
(v) A representative of the M/o Social Justice & Empowerment	Member
(vi) President, Indian Council for Child Welfare	Member
(vii) President, Indian Academy of Pediatrics	Member
(viii) Joint Secretary, M/o Women & Child Development	Member-Secretary

12. Each State Govt./UT Administration will forward its recommendation to Ministry of Women & Child Development taken by 31st July every year. Particulars of the recommended institutions should be furnished in the Performa given at Annexure 'A' and those of the individuals in Performa given as Annexure 'B'. Recommendations received after 31st July will not be considered.

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CRITERIA FOR SELECTION FOR INSTITUTIONS

13 Institutions should be those that are not entirely Government funded. They could be Govt. aided or otherwise. The institutions should have been in the field of child welfare for some years and should have, to their record, a good performance in the field. The branches of institutions working independently will also qualify for selection for the award. The selection will be made solely on the basis of quality of performance and the number of children served by the institution.

FOR INDIVIDUALS

14 The individuals to be selected for the award should have worked for the cause of children for some years. Paid officers of the institutions will not be eligible for selection. The sole basis of selection will be the quality of work performed by the individual for the cause of children and its significance of the cause.

DATE OF AWARDS

15 The awards will be announced on Children's Day - 14th November every year and will be given away in New Delhi on a convenient date and time.

PROCEDURE FOR MAKING THE AWARDS

16 The selected individuals and representatives of the Institutions on behalf of the institutions selected for the awards should receive the awards personally. They will be paid travelling and daily allowances/actual expenditure incurred, by them.

परिचय

संयुक्त राष्ट्र ने वर्ष 1979 को 'अंतरराष्ट्रीय बाल वर्ष' के रूप में घोषित किया था। जैसा कि 21 दिसम्बर, 1976 की संयुक्त राष्ट्र महासभा के संकल्प में प्रतिपादित किया गया है, अंतरराष्ट्रीय बाल वर्ष के उद्देश्य इस प्रकार हैं:-

- (क) बच्चों की ओर से पक्ष समर्थन के लिए तथा निर्णय लेने वाले लोगों तथा आम जनता की ओर से विशेष जरूरतों वाले बच्चों के बारे में जागरूकता बढ़ाने के लिए रूपरेखा प्रदान करना।
- (ख) इस तथ्य की स्वीकृति बढ़ाना कि बच्चों के लिए कार्यक्रम आर्थिक एवं सामाजिक विकास की योजनाओं के अभिन्न अंग होने चाहिए ताकि दीर्घ अवधि एवं लघु अवधि दोनों में राष्ट्रीय/अंतरराष्ट्रीय स्तर पर बच्चों के लाभ के लिए स्थायी रूप से गतिविधियाँ आयोजित की जा सकें।

2. बच्चों के हित को बढ़ावा देने तथा अंतरराष्ट्रीय समुदाय के ऐसे प्रयासों को बढ़ावा देने वाले अग्रणी राष्ट्रों में से भारत एक राष्ट्र है, जिसकी वजह से वर्ष 1979 को अंतरराष्ट्रीय बाल वर्ष के रूप में घोषित किया गया। बच्चों के हितों को बढ़ावा देने तथा बच्चों के कल्याण के लिए कार्यक्रमों पर अधिक जोर देने का कार्य केवल वर्ष 1979 तक सीमित नहीं था। निःसंदेह: अंतरराष्ट्रीय बाल वर्ष यूएन आयाम के कार्यक्रमों को बढ़ावा देने तथा बच्चों के हित के लिए देश में अधिक जागरूकता लाने के लिए एक जम्पिंग बोर्ड था।

3. बच्चों के कल्याण को बढ़ावा देने के लिए देश के समय प्रयासों में स्वीचिङ्क प्रयासों का एक विशेष स्थान है। अनेक स्वीचिङ्क समूह इस कार्य में पहले से ही लगे हुए हैं। देश में स्वीचिङ्क कार्रवाई के आयाम एवं इसकी अहमियत में समय के साथ बढ़ोतरी होने की उम्मीद है।

4. बच्चों के हित के लिए स्वीचिङ्क प्रयासों को राज्य की ओर से पहचान प्रदान करने की पद्धति के रूप में भारत सरकार ने 1979 में देश में बच्चों के हित में स्वीचिङ्क प्रयासों को राजकीय पहचान प्रदान करने की स्कीम शुरू की।

5. समय-समय पर संशोधित इस स्कीम के तहत अब (i) तीन व्यक्तियों जिन्होंने बच्चों के हित में सर्वोत्कृष्ट कार्य किया है; और (ii) पाँच संस्थाओं जिन्होंने बाल कल्याण के किसी क्षेत्र में सर्वोत्कृष्ट कार्य किया है, को पुरस्कार देने की परिकल्पना है।

कार्यक्षेत्र

6. किसी विशेष वर्ष में बच्चों के हित के लिए सर्वोत्कृष्ट कार्य करने वाले व्यक्तियों तथा बच्चों के हित के लिए सर्वोत्कृष्ट कार्य करने वाली संस्थाओं को प्रथम अलग पुरस्कार दिए जाएंगे। इस संबंध में कोई आपत्ति नहीं है कि किसी व्यक्ति तथा संस्था को इसी वर्ष में पुरस्कार दिया जा रहा है जिससे वह व्यक्ति जुड़ा है।

पुरस्कारों का स्वरूप

चयन की प्रक्रिया

9. शुरू में प्रत्येक राज्य/संघ राज्य क्षेत्र द्वारा नियुक्त समिति राज्य/संघ राज्य क्षेत्र में व्यक्तियों एवं संस्थाओं के बीच से उनका चयन करेगी। इस समिति की संरचना की जिम्मेदारी राज्य सरकार/संघ राज्य क्षेत्र प्रशासन पर छोड़ दी जाएगी। ये राष्ट्रीय चयन समिति की संरचना के पैटर्न को ध्यान में रख सकते हैं।

10. राज्य/संघ राज्य क्षेत्र की चयन समिति समय-समय पर इस संबंध में जारी दिशानिर्देशों के अनुसरण में चयन करेगी।

11. एक राष्ट्रीय समिति अंतिम चयन करेगी, जिसकी संरचना इस प्रकार है :

7. अध्यक्ष, भारतीय बाल रोग अकादमी	सदस्य
8. संयुक्त सचिव, महिला एवं बाल विकास मंत्रालय	सचिव

12. प्रत्येक राज्य सरकार/संघ राज्य प्रशासन हर साल 31 जुलाई तक महिला एवं बाल विकास मंत्रालय को अपनी सिफारिश अर्पित करेगी। संस्तुत संस्थाओं के विवरण अनुलग्नक-क में दिए गए प्रारूप में प्रस्तुत करना चाहिए तथा व्यक्तियों के विवरण अनुलग्नक-ख के अनुसार प्रस्तुत करना चाहिए। 31 जुलाई के बाद प्राप्त सिफारिशों पर विचार नहीं किया जाएगा।

संस्थाओं के चयन के मानक

13. संस्थाएं ऐसी होनी चाहिए जो सरकार द्वारा पूर्णतया चित्त बांधित न हों। वे सरकार से सहायता प्राप्त करने वाली संस्था या अल्पशा हो सकती हैं। सरकार कुछ साल से बाल कल्याण के क्षेत्र में होनी चाहिए तथा इस संघ में उनका अच्छे निष्पादन का रिकॉर्ड होना चाहिए। स्वतंत्र रूप से काम करने वाली संस्थाओं की

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शाखाओं को भी पुरस्कार के लिए घबने के मानदंडों को पूरा करना होगा। भगवत केवल निष्पादन की गुणवत्ता तथा संस्था द्वारा संचित बच्चों की संख्या के आधार पर किया जाएगा।

व्यक्तियों के लिए

2. Voluntary efforts have a special place in the cumulative effort of the country in promoting the well being of the children. A number of voluntary organizations are already engaged in this work. The dimension of voluntary action and its importance in the country are expected to grow with time.

3. As a system of state recognition of voluntary efforts for the cause of children, the Government of India initiated in 1979 the Scheme of State recognition of voluntary effort in the cause of children in the country.

4. The "Rajiv Gandhi Manav Seva Award for Service to Children" recognizes individuals who have made an outstanding contribution towards service for children. Each year the National Selection Committee will select 3 individuals for the awards.

Scope

5. The Awards will be presented annually to 3 individuals who makes outstanding contribution in the following fields

- i. Child Development
- ii. Child Protection
- iii. Child Welfare

Nature of Awards

6. The Award for three individuals shall consist of. -

- i. A cash prize of Rs. 1 lakh to each awardee;
- ii. Silver plaque; and
- iii. A citation to each awardee

Selection Committee

7. There shall be a National Selection Committee Consisting of the following: -

(i) Minister of Women & Child Development	Chairperson
(ii) Secretary, Ministry of Women & Child Development	Member
(iii) A representative of the Department of School Education & Literacy	Member
(iv) A representative of the Department of Health and Family Welfare	Member
(v) A representative of the M/o Social Justice & Empowerment	Member
(vi) President, Indian Council for Child Welfare	Member
(vii) Dean, Department of social work, Delhi University	Member
(viii) Joint Secretary, Ministry of Women & Child Development	Member-Secretary

8. Each State Governments/Union Territory Administration will forward its recommendations to Ministry of Women & Child Development by 20th July every year. Particulars of the recommended individuals should be furnished in the proforma given at Annexure. Recommendations received after 20th July will not be considered.

9. The National Selection Committee may, at its discretion, also consider individuals other than those recommended by a State Governments/U.T. Administrations Experts, for the Awards

Criteria for Selection for Individuals

10. The 3 individuals to be selected for the Awards should have worked for the cause of children for over 10 years. Paid officers of the institutions will not be eligible for selection. The sole basis of the selection will be quality of work performed by the individual for the cause of children and its significance for the cause

Arrangements for the Awardees

11. Arrangements for the lodging and boarding of awardees shall be made by the Ministry of Women and Child Development. The awardees will receive the awards personally and not through their nominees. Only the actual expenses incurred by the awardee on this account will be paid. Local Awardees will be entitled for reimbursement of local transport charges as per government rules as may be amended from time to time.

9. राष्ट्रीय चयन समिति अपने विवेक के आधार पर पुरस्कार के लिए ऐसे व्यक्तियों पर भी विचार कर सकती है जिनकी शिफारिश राज्य सरकारों/संघ राज्य क्षेत्र प्रशासनों द्वारा नहीं की गई है।

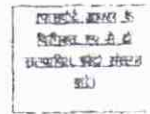
