# Control room to implement Centre's water schemes soon

**Mumbai:** Deputy CM Devendra Fadnavis on Monday said a control room would be established at the state level for time-bound and effective implementation of various schemes, including Swachh Bharat and Jal Jeevan missions, through the CM's 'war room'. The statement came after Fadnavis and CM Eknath Shinde had a review meeting with Union jal shakti minister Gajendra Singh Shekhawat.

Expressing displeasure over just one work order having been issued out of 92 plans prepared for plastic waste management, Fadnavis asked the rural development department to speed up various initiatives under the Swachh Bharat Mission. Shekhawat too said the projects must be expedited.

While Shekhawat expressed the hope that Maharashtra would play a pioneering role in implementing his ministry's schemes, Shinde said with the Centre extending support, priority would be given to complete various schemes in the state.
