OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Observance of two minutes' silence on 30th January (Martyrs' Day) in the memory of those who gave their lives in the struggle for India's freedom.

Reference is invited to Ministry of Home Affairs' letter No. 2/1/2023-Public dated 10th January, 2023 on the subject cited above.

2. On 30th January every year, two minutes' silence is observed at 11:00 AM throughout the country, in the memory of those who gave their lives in the struggle for India's freedom. As part of this programme, two minute silence would be observed in CWC on 30th January, 2023 at 11:00 AM. In this connection, all the officers/officials of Central Water Commission are requested to stand up and observe the silence for two minutes sharp at 11:00 AM.

3. The Commencement and termination of the two minutes' silence period would be indicated by sound of siren. Sirens would be sounded from 10.59 hours till 11.00 hours and after two minutes, all clear sirens would again be sounded from 11.02 hours till 11.03 hours.
