Sir,

Central Water Commission is monitoring live storage status of 91 reservoirs of the country on weekly basis and is issuing weekly bulletin on every Thursday. The total live storage capacity of these 91 reservoirs is 157.799 BCM which is about 62% of the live storage capacity of 253.388 BCM which is estimated to have been created in the country as per last re-conciliation of Live Storage Capacity made by CWC during 2009-10 on the basis of the information collected from various sources. Due to the lowering of gates of Sardar Sarovar Dam the additional storage created in the Country is (5.760 - 1.566) = 4.194 BCM. (1.566) is the storage created before lowering the gate.). The Storage has further increased by 0.230 BCM under the List of projects having dam component completed under 99 priority projects during the last two years thus increasing the Storage Capacity to 257.812 BCM.

The State wise figure reflecting 257.812 BCM attached will be considered for all purposes including Parliament and other related matters and queries as on 01.12.2017 until further reconciliation of information related to storage capacity created / under creation through various reservoir projects.

It is hereby requested that if there are any changes in the status of the major and medium (completed/under construction) in respect to your State including projects operated by PSUs and private companies located in your state may be intimated to us immediately.
