Reference is invited to this office memorandum No. 3/3/2011-0&M/481 dated 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2011 (copy enclosed), wherein it has been conveyed that "It is brought to the notice of all CWC officials that they should not bring or attempt to bring any political or outside influence to bear upon any superior authority to further their interest in service matter. Necessary disciplinary action shall be taken against the officials violating the rule 20 of the CCS (conduct) Rule, 1964".

It is, therefore, reiterated that CWC employees seeking outside pressure in service matters either through VIPs or through close relatives of the employee in this regard is a clear violation of Rule 20 of the CCS (conduct) Rule, 1964. Necessary disciplinary action shall be taken against the officials violating the rule 20 of the CCS (conduct) Rule, 1964.

Sub:- Bringing of political or other out side influence by the officials of CWC to further their interest in respect of their service matters – violation of Rule 20 of CCS (conduct) Rule-reg.

It has been observed that many CWC employees seek outside pressure in service matters especially in the matters relating to transfer/postings. Representations received through VIPs or through close relatives of the employees in this regard is a clear violation of Rule 20 of the CCS (conduct) Rule, 1964 which provides that no Government servant shall bring any type of political or other outside influence to bear upon any superior authority to further his/her interest in respect of matters pertaining to his/her service under the Government.

It is brought to the notice of all CWC officials that they should not bring or attempt to bring any political or outside influence to bear upon any superior authority to further their interest in service matter. Necessary disciplinary action shall be taken against the officials violating the rule 20 of the CCS (conduct) Rule, 1964.
