MINUTES OF THE MEETING TO DISCUSS THE PROGRESS OF MATTER FOR ASSESSMENT OF BENEFITS & BALANCE COST OF POLAVARAM IRRIGATION PROJECT (PIP) AT +41.15 M HELD UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF MEMBER (WP&P), CWC ON 22.02.2022

A meeting under the Chairmanship of Shri Kushvinder Vohra, Member (Water Planning and Projects), Central Water Commission on 22.02.2022 was held through video conferencing to discuss the progress in respect of benefits and balance cost of PIP at +41.15 m in the reservoir. The list of participants present during the meeting is attached as **Annexure**.

- 1. At the outset, the Member (WP&P), CWC welcomed the participants. He briefly informed that the meeting is being held to examine the details submitted by Govt of Andhra Pradesh (GoAP) in pursuance of the direction of MoF and DoWR, RD & GR for inclusion of Water-Component of PIP for funding. GoAP has submitted the details of benefits and the balanced cost of the project by keeping water level at +41.15 m and below.
- 2. Member (WP&P), CWC further informed that, in view of above, certain observations / clarifications were sought from PPA & GoAP by CWC and compliance to the same has been received from PPA / GoAP. However, for firming up the balance cost and benefits, following additional information is required to understand the extent of supply of water in command areas:
- i. Whether in the Kharif Season, level of +41.15 m can be maintained? And inflows will be sufficient to meet all the demand for Kharif season.
- ii. During monsoon season, whether the demands of drinking and industrial is fulfilled.
- iii. During non-monsoon period, after fulfilling the demands of drinking and industrial, how much water is left for Rabi requirements for existing downstream barrages.
- 3. For assessing water availability for the benefits as projected by GoAP, Member (WP&P), CWC directed Govt of AP to submit the **Working Tables** (Month-Wise) assuming the FRL at 41.15 m and below duly considering the needs of water to downstream delta portion along with losses at the earliest. Further, Member (WP&P), CWC directed CE (IMO), CWC to perform preliminary assessment within one week after the submission of desired Working Table by GoAP.

Action:Engineer-in-Chief (EnC), PIP, GoAP & CE (IMO), CWC

- 4. Member Secretary, PPA raised the issues regarding supply of water through LMC upto Vishakhapatnam under gravity with the reduced head & completion of hydraulic connectivity in LMC to harness the projected benefits, when reservoir will be operational at level +41.15 m.
- 5. EnC (PIP), GoAP responded that present assessment is only for irrigation benefit at +41.15 m and the requirement for drinking water to reach Vishakhapatnam is presently not included in the benefits. The supply of drinking water to Vishakhapatnam is being served at present from Yeleru Reservoir Project (Y.R.P.).
- 6. Director, BCD (NW&S), CWC informed that preliminary examination of the discharge data at head of canals submitted by GoAP seems to be in order. As such, Project Authority may only verify the facts that how much water will move upto what distances of canals with withdrawals at various outlets. Regarding balanced cost, Director, Cost Appraisal (Irrigation-2), CWC requested GoAP to depute an official for further clarification for examination of the projected balance cost especially regarding detailed calculations as only quantities has been provided by GoAP. GoAP assured to

depute the official for the same along with sharing of detailed calculation of balance cost. In this regard, Member (WP&P), CWC directed Director, Cost Appraisal (Irrigation-2), CWC to examine the balance cost for +41.15 m level within one week after necessary compliance by GoAP.

Action: EnC (PIP), GoAP & Director [CA (Irrigation-II)], CWC

7. Director, PPA / M&A (Hyderabad), CWC enquired about the completion timeline of connectivity between Tadipudi and RMC and whether the cost of same has been included in the projected balanced cost by GoAP. Further, he stated whether the cost of distribution system beyond Tadipudi & Pushkara has been included in the projected balanced Cost and if the same is included, it may be excluded as these were not part of command in approved DPR. In this regard, Member (WP&P), CWC directed to ascertain the cost of the balance work only upto the point where projected benefits are to be realised (i.e. upto Tadipudi and Pushkar). Member (WP&P), CWC directed GoAP to deduct /revise the cost estimate if it is included in cost of distribution system or canal system beyond Tadipudi and Pushkar.

Action: EnC, PIP, GoAP

- 8. In his closing remarks, Member (WP&P), CWC underscored the need for resolving all the issues related to assessment of benefits and balance cost of PIP at level +41.15 m expeditiously.
- 9. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
