TN plans third check-dam across Palar costing ₹70 crore

The Tamil Nadu government is planning to construct a third check-dam across the Palar at Nallathur, at an estimated cost of ₹70 crore. Besides providing water for irrigation and drinking purposes, the check-dam project is expected to improve the groundwater table in the nearby villages.

Farmers, who welcome the Tamil Nadu government's efforts to stop the construction of a dam across the Palar at Kuppam in Andhra Pradesh, also demand more schemes to utilise the Palar water.

The Palar, besides providing water for irrigation in Chengalpet, is also a major source of drinking

water for Chennai suburbs till Alandur. Even in the driest of times, underground water from the Palar riverbed is pumped and supplied to

Chennai's suburbs and Chengalpet district.
Though the river is dry on the surface for almost 10 to 11 months, it stores a huge amount of

it stores a huge amount of water underground.

Check-dams at many places across the Palar is a long-time demand of farmers and a check-dam at Nallathur is one of them.

The PWD is providing water to the Kalpakkam atomic plant from the Palar by digging deep borewells and setting up several pumping stations. A check-dam at Nallathur will be useful to supply water to the Kalpakkam

atomic plant and to irrigate agricultural land on both sides of the river.

The proposal for a checkdam at the place at an estimated cost of ₹32 crores was presented by the PWD department. The project was implemented in the Vayalur-Cuddalore area on the Palar bed for 1,190 metre and a height of 16 metre. The check-dam was completed in 2019 and 1 tmc ft of water is stored.

Another check-dam was constructed in the Vallipuram-Eesur area, 13 km from the first check-dam. Both check-dams have been used for irrigation and drinking water purposes for the last five years.

In December last year, the river received a huge quantity of water due to heavy rains brought in by Cyclone Michaung. However, the check-dams were quickly filled and the remaining water drained into the sea without any utility. The need for a third check-dam was highlighted by the December 2023 floods and the PWD had come out with another proposal to construct a check-dam.

A project at a cost of ₹70 crore was prepared by the PWD and submitted to the government for clearance is Given, the department will start construction of the check-dam.

Maharashtra releases 0.6 tmc water for TS

Maharashtra Irrigation officials on Friday released 0.6 tmc of water from the Babli project for Telangana. The water release was made according to the Supreme Court orders issued in 2013 to meet the drinking water needs in downstream reaches.

Irrigation officials from both Maharashtra and Telangana States and representatives of the Central Water Commission were present as water was released. As per the Supreme Court orders, which were issued while clearing the Maharashtra project, would lift the gates of the Babli project on July levery year and keeps it open till October 28 letting the Godavari waters for utilisation in the downstream stretches. The same orders made it obligatory for Maharashtra to let 0.6 tmc of water from Babli project on March 1 every year.
