Under no circumstance will father and his son(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parities liable to rejection

- 1.1 The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 14,16,830/- (Rupees Fourteen Lakh Sixteen Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty Only).** This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.
- 1.1.1 The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the tenders. He will also nominate Division which will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of tenders.
 - For composite tender, besides indicating the combined estimated cost put to tender, should clearly indicate the estimated cost of each component separately. The eligibility of tenderer will correspond to the combined estimated cost of different components put to tender.
- 1.2 Tenders will be issued to eligible contractors provided they produce definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified above.
- 2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful tenderer on prescribed Form **No.CPWD-7/8**, which is available as a Govt. of India Publication. Tenderer shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.

- 5. (i) Tender shall be accompanied with Earnest Money of Rs. 28,337/- (Five Twenty Eight Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Seven Only) in Receipt, Treasury Challan/Deposit at Call receipt of a scheduled bank/fixed deposit receipt of a scheduled bank/Demand Draft of a scheduled bank issued in favor of Executive Engineer, Lower Yamuna Division, C.W.C., Agra. 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 lakh, whichever is less, will have to be deposited in the shape prescribed above and balance amount of earnest money can be accepted in the form of Bank Guarantee issued by a scheduled bank having validity for 6 months or more from the last date of receipt of tenders.
- 5 (ii) The tender and the earnest money shall be placed in seperate sealed envelopes, each marked "Tender" and "Earnest Money" respectively. In cases where earnest money in cash in accepteablethe same shall be deposited with the Cashier of the Division and the receipt placed in the envelope meant for earnest money. Both the envelopes shall be submitted

6. The contractor, whose tender is accepted, will be required to furnish performance guarantee of 5% (Five Percent) of the tendered amount within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of cash (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs. 10,000/-) or deposit at call receipt of any scheduled bank/Banker"s cheque of any scheduled bank/Demand Draft of any scheduled bank / Pay order of any scheduled bank (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs. 1,00,000/-) or Government Securities or Fixed Deposit Receipts or Guarantee Bonds of any Scheduled Bank or the State Bank of India in accordance with the prescribed form. 7. The description of the work is as follows:

Tenderers are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The tenderer shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a tender by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

- 8. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without the assignment of any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tenderer shall be summarily rejected.
- 9. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
- 10. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
- 11. The contractor shall not be permitted to tender for works in the CWC circle (responsible for award and execution of contracts) in which his near relative is posted as Divisional Accountant or

as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Central Water Commission or in the Ministry of Water Resources, Govt. of India. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.

- 12. No Engineer of gazetted rank or other Gazetted officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the previous permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractor service.
- 13. The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of Fourty Five (45) days from the date of opening of the tenders. If any tenderer withdraws his tender before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the department, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. - Part B: General/specific conditions, specifications and schedule of quantities applicable to major component of the work .
- Part C: Schedule A to F for minor component of the work, (SE/EE in charge of major component shall also be competent authorityh under clause 2 and clause 5 as mentioned in schedule A to F for major components). General/Specific conditions, specifications and schedule of quantities applicable to minor component(s) of the work.
- 16.1.3 The tenderer must associate wih himself, agencies of the appropriate class eligible to tender for each of the minor component individually.
- The eligible tenderers shall quote rates for all items of major component as well as for all items of minor components of work. It will be obligatory on the part of the tenderer to sign th tender document for all the components (The schedule of quantities, conditions and special conditions etc.)
- After acceptance of the tender by competent authority, the Executive Engineer In charge of the major component of the work shall issue letter of award on behalf of the President of India. - 16.1.6 Entire work under the scope of composite tender including major and all minor components shall be executed under one agreemnet.
- 16.1.7 Security deposit will be worked out separately for each componednt conrresponding to the estimated cost of the respective component of works. The Earnest Money will become part of the security deposit of the major component of work.
- The main contractor has to associate agency(s) for minor component(s) conforming to eligibility criteria as defined in the tender document and has to submit detail of such agency(s) to Engineer-in-charge of minor component(s) within prescribed time. Name of the agench(s) to be associated shall be approved by Engineer-in-charge of minor component(s).





- 3. Get your organization's concerned executives trained on ETS well in advance of your first tender submission deadline on ETS
- 4. Submit your bids well in advance of tender submission deadline on ETS (There could be last minute problems due to internet timeout, breakdown, et al)
 - 5. It is the responsibility of each bidder to remember and securely store the Pass Phrase for each Bid-Part submitted by that bidder. In the event of a bidder forgetting the Pass Phrase before the expiry of deadline for Bid-Submission, facility is provided to the bidder to "Annul Previous Submission" from the Bid-Submission Overview page and start afresh with new Pass-Phrase(s)

6. ETS will make your bid available for opening during the Online Public Tender Opening Event

(TOE) "ONLY IF" your "Status pertaining Overall Bid-Submission" is "Complete". For your record, you can generate and save a copy of "Final Submission Receipt". This receipt can be generated from 'Bid-Submission Overview Page' only if the "Status pertaining overall Bid-Submission" is "Complete".

NOTE:

While the first three instructions mentioned above are especially relevant to first-time users of ETS, the fourth, fifth and sixth instructions are relevant at all times.
