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The details of revised eligibility criteria terms and conditions for preparations of panel for posting of AD Gr.II/SDE(Civil/Mechanical) in Bhutan Investigation Division, CWC, Phuentsholing, Bhutan are as under:

The revised criteria for ranking are as under:

Revised Selection Criteria:

- The officers for posting to BID, CWC, Bhutan are selected for a tenure of two years. Keeping in view significant financial benefits which they get on posting to Bhutan, it was decided that officers who have already served in Bhutan/Nepal or any other foreign country for a period of two years or more shall not be considered.
- 2. The officer should have the requisite experience, sincere and ready to take on the challenging job.
- 3. The officers past performance to be assessed on the basis of their APARs for the last 5 years.
- 4. Seniority of the officers needs to be given due weightage.
- 5. As job involves working in difficult areas and extreme weather conditions, younger officers shall be given preference.
- 6. Applicant is capable to handle challenging task. The officers past years of investigation experience in Topographical/Geological works and survey shall be given preference(if the applicant has handled only discharge observation may not indicate his potential for Investigation works). Capability to handle instruments such as total stations etc. be assessed.
- 7. The marks to be allotted depend on the judgment of the Committee.
- 8. To determine the relative ranking of eligible applicants in the grade of AD/AD Gr.II, the committee approved the marking system giving due weightage to different attributes as mentioned below:
