 The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of bids.

In case the last date of submission of bid is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of bids.

- 1.1 Estimated cost of the work is **Rs. 98,44,830/-**. This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.
- 1.1.1 The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the bids. He will also nominate Division which will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of bids. For composite bid, besides indicating the combined estimated cost put to bid, should clearly indicate the estimated cost of each component separately. The eligibility of bidders will correspond to the combined estimated cost of different components put to bid.
- 1.2 Intending bidders is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below:-
 - Criteria of eligibility for submission of bid documents
- 1.2.1 Three similar works each of value not less than Rs. 39,00,000 or two similar work each of value not less than Rs. 49,00,000 or one similar work of value not less than Rs. 79,00,000 in last 7 years ending previous day of last date of submission of bids.

To become eligible for issue of bid, the bidders shall have to furnish an affidavit asunder:-

I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for bidding in CWC in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer-in-Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee. (Scanned copy to be uploaded at the time of submission of bid or can also be submitted offline before the last date & time of submission of bids to the Executive Engineer, MBD, CWC, CWC Complex, behind Adabari Bus Stand, Adabari, Guwahati 781014)

- 1.2.2 The Company / Firm / Agency should have
 - a. The Manpower Company / Firm / Agency should be registered with the appropriate Registration authority.
 - b. PAN / GIR card
 - c. submitted IT returns for the last two financial years
 - d. EPF registration
 - e. ESI registration
 - f. Registration for Service Tax/Sales Tax

- 2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form No-CPWD 7/8 (or other Standard Form as mentioned) which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website https://eprocure.gov.in/cppp. Bidders shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
- 3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be approximately **6 months** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.
- 4. The site for the work is available.
- The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions of Contract Form can be seen on website http://www.tcil-india.com and https://eprocure.gov.in/cppp free of cost.
- 6. The tenderers uploading the tender shall upload the scanned copy of A/C payee Demand Draft (non-refundable) drawn on any scheduled bank in favour of the Executive Engineer, Middle Brahmaputra Division, CWC, Guwahati payable at Guwahati for Rs. 1000/-(Rupees One thousand only) towards the cost of tender document at the time of submission.
- 7. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
- 8. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
- 9. When bids are invited in three stage system and if it is desired to submit revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted then the bid submitted earlier shall become invalid.
- 10. Earnest Money in the form of Treasury Challan or Demand Draft or Pay order or Banker's Cheque or Deposit at Call Receipt or Fixed Deposit Receipt (drawn in favour of Executive Engineer, MBD, CWC, Guwahati) shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission.

A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, minimum 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 lakhs, whichever is less, **shall** have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and balance **may be deposited** in shape of Bank Guarantee of any scheduled bank **having validity for six months or more from the last date of receipt of bids** which is to be scanned and uploaded by the intending bidders.

The physical EMD of the scanned copy of EMD uploaded shall be deposited by the lowest bidder within a week after opening of financial bid failing which the bid shall be rejected and enlistment of the agency shall be withdrawn by the enlisting authority. The agency shall be debarred from tendering in CWC.

Interested contractor who wish to participate in the bid has also to make following payments

within the period of bid submission *E-tender processing fee shall be payable to M/s TCI Limited throught their e-gateway by credit /debit card, internet banking or RGTS/NEFT facility.*

Copy of Enlistment Order and certificate of work experience and other documents as specified in the press notice shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. However, certified copy of all the scanned and uploaded documents as specified in press notice shall have to be submitted by the lowest bidder only along with physical EMD of the scanned copy of EMD uploaded within a week physically in the office of tender opening authority.

- 11. The bid submitted shall become invalid and e-Tender processing fee shall not be refunded if:
 - (i) The bidder is found ineligible.
 - (ii) The bidder does not upload all the documents (including EPF registration, ESI registration and relevant Tax/GST registration) as stipulated at clause 15 of scope of work and general instructions for tenderers including the undertaking about deposition of physical EMD of the scanned copy of EMD uploaded.
 - (iii) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted *physically by the lowest bidder* in the office of bid opening authority.
 - (iv) The lowest bidder does not deposit physical EMD within a week of opening of bid.
- The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish **performance guarantee of** 5 % (Five Per cent) of the bid amount within the period specified in Schedule F. 13. The description of the work is as follows:

Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidders implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to

him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

- 14. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.
- 15. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
- 16. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
- 17. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CWC Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the CWC or in the MoWR, RD&GR. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
- 18. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.
- 19. The bid for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of opening of bids in case of single bid system. If any bidders withdraws his bid before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the bid which are not acceptable to the department, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. Further the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the rebidding process of the work.

 - XIII. Treasury Challan/Demand Draft/Pay order or Banker's Cheque /Deposit at Call Receipt/FDR/Bank Guarantee of any Scheduled Bank against EMD.
 - XIV. The Manpower Company/Firm/Agency should be registered with the appropriate Registration authority.
 - XV. Certificates of Work Experience as per clause 1.2 of CPWD-6.
 - XVI. Copy of PAN/GIR card
 - XVII. Copy of the IT return filed for the last two financial years
 - XVIII. Copies of EPF registration
 - XIX. Copies of ESI registration certificates

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

General

- 1. The contracting firm /agency/company should be registered with appropriate authorities.
- 2. The contract shall be for a period of approximately 6 (six) months w.e.f. 01.05.2018 to 31.10.2018 (Tentatively), unless it is curtailed or terminated by this office owing to deficiency of service, sub-standard quality of Attendants deployed, breach of contract, reduction or cessation of the requirements of work.
- 3. The contract shall automatically expire after 6 (Six) months from commencement of the contract unless extended further by this office.
- 4. The contract may be extended, on the same terms and conditions, for a further period not exceeding 1 (one) month.
- 5. The contracting Company/Firm/Agency shall not be allowed to transfer, assign, pledge or sub-contract its rights and liabilities under this contract to any other agency without the prior written consent of this Department.
- 6. The contractor will be required to pay minimum wages as prescribed under the Minimum Wages Act. The contractor will maintain proper record as required under the Law/Acts. The Contractor will also ensure the required subscription of EPF, ESI, Service Tax and other liabilities as prescribed in the rules, is deposited in the account of concerned employees.
- 7. This office, at present, has requirement of workload equivalent to approximately 80 Nos. Semi Skilled workmen to be engaged at various locations in Assam, Manipur and Tripura states under three Sub-Divisions/at Division as enclosed at Annexure I. The requirement of this office may further increase or decrease during the period of initial contract also and the tenderer would have to provide additional manpower, if required on the same terms and conditions.

- 14. In case, the person employed by the successful Company/Firm/Agency commits any act of omission/commission that amounts to misconduct/Indiscipline/incompetence and security risks, the successful Company/Firm/Agency will be liable to take appropriate disciplinary action against such persons, including their removal from site of work, if required by this office within 2 days of being brought to their notice either by phone/fax/letter.
- 15. The tendering company shall provide identity cards to the personnel deployed in this office carrying the photograph of the personnel and personal information as to name, DOB, age and Identification mark etc.
- 16. The service provider shall ensure that any details of office, operational process, technical know-how, security arrangements, and administrative/organizational matters are not divulged or disclosed to any person by its personnel deployed in this office.
- 17. The service provider shall ensure proper conduct of his personnel in office premises, and enforce prohibition of consumption of alcoholic drinks, paan, smoking, loitering without work.
- 18. The contractor shall be responsible for any theft of the items from site office. The details of the stolen materials/stores will be given to the contractor in writing by the designated authority and the full cost of the material reported stolen will be recovered from the contractor within 4 weeks from the date of theft. The decision of CWC authorities on this will be final and binding on the contractor.
- 19. The person deployed shall be required to report for work according to instruction issued by the concerned SDE/site in-charge. In case, person deployed is absent on a particular day or comes late/leaves early on three occasions, one day wage shall be deducted. In case of repetition of such instances, clause 14 will be applicable.
- 20. The agency shall depute a coordinator, out of the deployed personnel, who would be responsible for immediate interaction with this office, so that optimal services of the persons deployed by the agency could be availed without any disruption.
- 21. The selected agency shall immediately provide a substitute in the event of any person leaving the job due to his/her personal reasons. The delay by the Agency in providing a substitute beyond one working day shall attract liquidated damages @ Rs.200 per day (per such case) on the service providing agency, besides deduction in payment on pro-rata basis.

- 22. It will be the responsibilities of the service providing agencies to meet transportation, food, medical and any other requirements in respect of the persons deployed by it (Agency) in this office and this office will have no liabilities in this regard at any stage.
- 23. For all intents and purposes, the service providing agency shall be the "Employer" within the meaning of different Labour Legislations in respect of multitask manpower so employed and deployed in this office. The persons deployed by the agency in this office shall not have claims of any Master and Servant relationship nor have any principal and agent relationship with or against Executive Engineer, Middle Brahmaputra Division, Central Water Commission, Guwahati.
- 24. The service providing agency shall be solely responsible for the redressal of grievances / resolution of disputes relating to person deployed. This office shall, in no way, be responsible for settlement of such issues whatsoever. This office shall not be responsible for any damages, losses, claims, financial or other injury to any person deployed by service providing agency in the course of their performing the functions/duties, or for payment towards any compensation.
- 25. The persons deployed by the service providing agency shall not claim nor shall be entitled to pay, perks and other facilities admissible to casual, ad hoc, regular / confirmed employees of this office during the contract or after expiry of the contract.
- 26. In case of termination of this contract on its expiry or otherwise, the persons deployed by the service providing agency shall not be entitled to and will have no claim for any absorption nor for any relaxation for absorption in the regular / otherwise capacity in this office. Contractor should make it known the above to the manpower of the contractor.
- 27. The payment shall be made only to the contractor and on monthly basis as per actual service on proportionate basis.

LEGAL

- 28. The successful bidder will be responsible for compliance of all statutory provisions relating to **Minimum Wages**, **Provident Fund**, **and Employees State Insurance etc.** in respect of the persons deployed by it in this office. The payment particulars of Service Tax, EPF, ESI etc of previous month may be submitted along with the current month bill. Failing which appropriate action may be taken, as deemed fit.
- 29. The successful bidder shall also be liable for depositing all taxes, levies, Cess etc. on account of service rendered by it to O/o E.E., MBD, CWC, Guwahati to concerned tax collection authorities from time to time as per extant rules and regulations on the matter.
- 30. The successful bidder shall maintain all statutory registers under the applicable Law. The agency shall produce the same, on demand, to the concerned authority of this office or any other authority under Law.
- 31. The Tax Deduction at Source (T.D.S.) shall be deducted as per the provisions of Income Tax Department, as amended from time to time and a certificate to this effect shall be provided to the agency by this office.
