1.0 Bids shall be submitted online only at TCIL website URL <https://www.tcil-india-electronictender.com>. Tenderer/Contractor are advised to follow the instructions provided in the 'Instructions to the Contractors/Tenderer for the e-submission of the bids online through TCIL portal. The tender notice is also available at www.eprocure.gov.in and www.cwc.gov.in

2.0 Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one contractor or contractors having business relationship. Under no circumstance will father and his son(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection

3.0 Tenderer who has downloaded the tender from the TCIL website URL <https://www.tcil-india-electronictender.com>, Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) website <https://eprocure.gov.in> and www.cwc.gov.in shall not tamper/modify the tender form including downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tampered/modified in any manner, tender will be completely rejected and EMD would be forfeited.

4.0 Intending tenderers are advised to visit again TCIL website URL <https://www.tcil-india-electronictender.com> and www.cwc.gov.in and CPPP website <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> at least 3 days prior to closing date of submission of tender for any corrigendum / amendment

5.0 Applicant contractor must provide demand draft for Rs 500/- (Rupees Five hundred only) in favour of Executive Engineer, Lower Yamuna Division, Agra obtained from any Nationalized/ scheduled Bank with their application/downloaded tenders as the cost of tender forms/ documents. All applicable bank charges shall be borne by the applicant and he shall not have any claim what so ever on this account on department. In case of re-tendering, the firms which have submitted the DD in earlier calls will require to submit DD along with their tender/application in subsequent calls also. Tender not accompanied with the cost of tender documents is liable to be rejected.

NOTICE INVITING E- TENDER

1. Item rate / percentage rate tenders are invited on behalf of the President of India from approved and eligible contractors of C.P.W.D (and those of appropriate list of MES, BSNL, Railways and U.P.State P.W.D. (B&R) or State Government Departments etc., Dealing with building and roads, if there is no state PWD (B& R) for the work of **“for Construction of boundary wall around the GDSQ & wireless station at Banda (Bhuragarh) site Distt. Banda (U.P.), Ken sub division Banda under Lower Yamuna Division Agra”**.

1.1 The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 10,56,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakh Fifty Six Thousand only)**. This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.

1.1.1 The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the tenders. He will also nominate Division which will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of tenders.

For composite tender, besides indicating the combined estimated cost put to tender, should clearly indicate the estimated cost of each component separately. The eligibility of tenderer will correspond to the combined estimated cost of different components put to tender.

1.2 Tenders will be issued to eligible contractors provided they produce definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below :-

Criteria of eligibility for issue of tender documents

Three similar works each cost not less than Rs 4.22 lacs or two similar works each costing not less than Rs 6.33 lacs or one similar work costing not less than Rs 8.44 lacs in last 7 years ending 31-03-2016.

The Value of executd works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per anum, calculated from the date of completion to the last date of receipt of applications for tender.

2. A greement shall be drawn with the successful tenderer on prescribed Form **No.CPWD-7/8**, which is available as a Govt. of India Publication. Tenderer shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be one month from the date of start as defined in schedule “F” or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender documents.
4. The work place where construction work is to be provided will be the site under Lower Yamuna Division, CWC, Agra.

Tender documents consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of the various classes of work to be done and the set of terms & conditions of contract to be complied with by the contractor whose tender may be accepted and other necessary documents can be seen in the office of the **Executive Engineer, Lower Yamuna Division, C.W.C., Agra** between hours of **11:00 A.M. to 04:00 P.M.** from 11.11.2016 to 19.11.2016 everyday except on Sundays and Public Holidays.

5. (i) Tender shall be accompanied with Earnest Money of Rs. 21,120/- (**Twenty One Thousand One Hundred Twenty only**) in Receipt, Treasury Challan/Deposit at Call receipt of a scheduled bank/fixed deposit receipt of a scheduled bank/Demand Draft of a scheduled bank issued in favour of **Executive Engineer, Lower Yamuna Division, C.W.C., Agra**. 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 lakh, whichever is less, will have to be deposited in the shape prescribed above and balance amount of earnest money can be accepted in the form of Bank Guarantee issued by a scheduled bank having validity for 6 months or more from the last date of receipt of tenders.
- 5 (ii) The tender and the earnest money shall be placed in seperate sealed envelopes, each marked “Tender” and “Earnest Money” respectively. In cases where earnest money in cash in acceptable, the same shall be deposited with the Cashier of the Division and the receipt placed in the envelope meant for earnest money. Both the envelopes shall be submitted together in another sealed envelope with the name of work and due date of opening written on envelope, which will be received by the **Executive Engineer, Lower Yamuna Division, C.W.C., Agra** upto **11:00 P.M. on 19.11.2016** and will be opened as per date/time as mentioned in the Tender Key Event Sheet, interested bidder or their representative not more than 1 or 2 per bidder may be present in 404-409, Sector 12C, Avas Vikas Colony, Sikandra, Agra-282007 .The envelope marked “Tender” of only those tenderers shall be opened, whose earnest money, placed in the other envelope, is found to be in order.

6. The contractor whose tender is accepted, will be required to furnish performance guarantee of **5% (Five Percent)** of the tendered amount within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of cash (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs. 10,000/-) or Deposit at call receipt of any scheduled bank/Banker's cheque of any scheduled bank/Demand Draft of any scheduled bank / Pay order of any scheduled bank (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs. 1,00,000/-) or Government Securities or Fixed Deposit Receipts or Guarantee Bonds of any Scheduled Bank or the State Bank of India in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in schedule 'F' including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor.

7. The description of the work is as follows:

“Construction of boundary wall around the GDSQ & wireless station at Banda (Bhuragarh) site Distt. Banda (U.P.), Ken sub division, Banda under Lower Yamuna Division Agra”.

Copies of other drawings and documents pertaining to the works will be open for inspection by the tenderers at the office of the above mentioned officer.

Tenderers are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The tenderer shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a tender by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

8. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without the assignment of any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tenderer shall be summarily rejected.
9. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
10. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.

11. The contractor shall not be permitted to tender for works in the CWC circle (responsible for award and execution of contracts) in which his near relative is posted as Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Central Water Commission or in the Ministry of Water Resources, Govt. of India. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
12. No Engineer of gazetted rank or other Gazetted officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the previous permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractor's service.
13. The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of Ninety (90) days from the date of opening of the tenders. If any tenderer withdraws his tender before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the department, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. Further the tenderer shall not be allowed to participate in the re-tendering process of the work.
14. This Notice Inviting Tender shall form a part of the contract document. The successful tenderer/contractor, on acceptance of his tender by the Accepting Authority, shall, within **15 days** from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of:-
 - (a) The notice inviting tender, all the documents including additional conditions, specifications and drawings, if any, forming the tender as issued at the time of invitation of tender and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence leading thereto.
 - (b) Standard C.P.W.D. Form – 7/8.
15. For Composite Tenders :
 - 16.1.1.1 The Executive Engineer in charge of major component will call tenders for the composite work. The cost of tender documents and Earnest Money will be fixed with respect to the combined estimated cost put to tender for the composite tender.
 - 16.1.1.2 The tender document will include following three components :

Part A : - CPWD- 6 , CPWD- 7/8 including schedule A to F for major component of the work, Standard General Conditions of Contract for CPWD 2010 or latest edition as applicable with all amendments/ modifications.

Part B : - General/specific conditions, specifications and schedule of quantities applicable to major component of the work .

Part C : - Schedule A to F for minor component of the work, (SE/EE in charge of major component shall also be competent authorityh under clause 2 and clause 5 as mentioned in schedule A to F for major components). General/Specific conditions, specifications and schedule of quantities applicable to minor component(s) of the work.

- 16.1.3 The tenderer must associate with himself, agencies of the appropriate class eligible to tender for each of the minor component individually.
- 16.1.4 The eligible tenderers shall quote rates for all items of major component as well as for all items of minor components of work. It will be obligatory on the part of the tenderer to sign the tender document for all the components (The schedule of quantities, conditions and special conditions etc.)
- 16.1.5 After acceptance of the tender by competent authority, the Executive Engineer In charge of the major component of the work shall issue letter of award on behalf of the President of India. After the work is awarded, the main contractor will have to enter into one agreement with EE in charge of major component and has also to sign two or more copies of agreement depending upon number of EE's/DDH in charge of minor components. One such signed set of agreement shall be handed over to EE/DDH in charge of minor component. EE of major component will operate part A and part B of the agreement. EE/DDH in charge of minor component(s) shall operate Part C along with Part A of the agreement.
- 16.1.6 Entire work under the scope of composite tender including major and all minor components shall be executed under one agreement. .
- 16.1.7 Security deposit will be worked out separately for each component corresponding to the estimated cost of the respective component of works. The Earnest Money will become part of the security deposit of the major component of work.
- 16.1.8 The main contractor has to associate agency(s) for minor component(s) conforming to eligibility criteria as defined in the tender document and has to submit detail of such agency(s) to Engineer-in-charge of minor component(s) within prescribed time. Name of the agency(s) to be associated shall be approved by Engineer-in-charge of minor component(s).
- 16.1.9 In case the main contractor intends to change any of the above agency/agencies during the operation of the contract, he shall obtain prior approval of Engineer-in-charge of minor component. The new agency/ agencies shall also have to satisfy the laid down eligibility criteria. In case Engineer- in – Charge is not satisfied with the performance of any agency, he can direct the contractor to change the agency executing such items of work and this shall be binding on the contractor.
- 16.1.10 The main contractor has to enter into agreement with the contractor(s) associated by him for execution of minor component(s) . Copy of each agreement shall be submitted to EE/DDH in charge of each minor component as well as to EE in charge of major component. In case of change of associated contractor, the main contractor has to enter into agreement with the new contractor associated by him.
- 16.1.11 Running payment for the major component shall be made by EE of major discipline to the main contractor. Running payment for minor components shall be made by the Engineer-in-Charge of the discipline of minor component directly to the main contractor.
- 16.1.12 Final bill of whole work shall be finalized and paid by the EE of major component. Engineer(s) in charge of minor component(s) will prepare and pass the final bill for their component of work and pass on the same to the EE of major component for including in the final bill for composite contract.
