**NOTICE INVITING TENDER**

Sealed tenders are invited for and on behalf of the President of India by the EE, Wainganga, Central Water Commission, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Block- C, C.G.O. Complex, Seminary Hills, Nagpur- 440006 (Maharashtra) for the work prescribed below from the registered contractors who have carried out similar works in other Government offices and PSUs etc.

- 1.0 Name of work:** Providing semi-skilled man power Services for collection of Hydro-meteorological data at CWC Hydro-meteorological sites Under Wainganga Division, CWC, Nagpur during the Monsoon-2016. (List of sites enclosed at (Annex-I).
- 2.0 Estimated Cost:** Rs. 30, 83,300/- (Rupees Thirty lakh eighty three thousand three hundred only)
- 3.0 Earnest Money:** Rs.61, 670/- (Rupees Sixty one thousand six hundred seventy only)
- 4.0 Performance Guarantee:** 5% of tendered and accepted value of work.
- 5.0 Contract Period:** From 01/09/2016 to 15/11/2016.
- 6.0 Cost of Tender Document:** Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five hundred) only.

- a) The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 30,83,300/-**. This estimate however, is given merely as a rough guide.
- b) The Executive Engineer, Wainganga Division, Central Water Commission, Nagpur shall be the "Accepting Authority" hereinafter referred to as such for the purpose of this Contract.

- d) Tender document will be issued during the period from **16/08/2016 to 25/08/2016** between 1100 Hrs to 1630 Hrs on every working day.
- e) The tender shall be submitted in the original tender document.
- f) The tenderers are advised to inspect and survey the Site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the form and nature of the Site, the means of access to the Site, the accommodation they may require etc. In general, tenderers shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances, which may influence or affect their tenders. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the Site, whether he inspects it or not and no extra claims due to any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed.
- g) Submission of a tender by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the works to be done and of conditions and other factors bearing on the execution of the works.
- h) The tenderer should quote his rates in figures as well as in words.
  - l) The Tender in sealed cover accompanied with Earnest Money must be submitted not later than **15.00 Hrs on 29.08.2016** into specified tender box at the **Executive Engineer, Wainganga Division, Central Water Commission, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Block- C, C.G.O. Complex, Seminary Hills, Nagpur- 440006 (Maharashtra)**. The tenders received after the due date & time will not be entertained. The tender documents should be placed in a

sealed envelope super-scribed “**Tender for Providing Semi-skilled man power assistance services for collection of Hydro-meteorological data at river gauging sites under Waingangā Division, CWC, Nagpur**” due for opening on **29.08.2016 at 15.30 hrs.** in the presence of the tenderers or their authorized representatives, if any.

- j) The tender shall be accompanied by Earnest Money Rs.61, 670/- (Rupees Sixty one thousand six hundred seventy only). **EMD @ 2 % of the Estimated amount** of the work i.e. Rs. 61670.00 (Rupees Sixty one thousand six hundred seventy only) shall be enclosed in the form of demand draft drawn in favour of the Executive Engineer, Wainganga Division, CWC payable at Nagpur. EMD of un-successful bidders will be returned immediately after finalization of bids without interest. The EMD of the successful bidders shall be adjusted first against the recovery of security deposit if the bidder desires. **EMD exemptions as per Govt. Policy for Small & Micro industries will be provided subject to submission of Registration certificates & notifications issued by Govt. of India.**
- k) Earnest money of successful tenderer will be treated as part of security deposit.
- l) The tenderer shall submit the tender which satisfies each and every condition laid down in the tender documents, failing which, the tender is liable to be rejected.
  - i) The **Executive Engineer, Wainganga Division, Central Water Commission, Seminary Hills, Nagpur** do not bind themselves to accept the lowest or any tender or to give any reasons for their decision.

- m) This Notice Inviting Tender shall form part of the Contract document.

The tenderer shall not be entitled during the said period of validity to revoke or cancel his tender or vary the tender given or any item thereof. **2. Estimated Cost:** Rs. 30, 83,300/- (Rupees Thirty lakh eighty three thousand three hundred only)

**3. Earnest Money:** Rs.61, 670/- (Rupees Sixty one thousand six hundred seventy only)

**4. Performance Guarantee:** 5% of tendered and accepted value of work

**5. Contract Period:** From 01/09/2016 to 15/11/2016

**6. Cost of Tender Document:** Rs 500/-

**Should this tender be accepted in whole or in part, I/We hereby agree:**

## **SECTION – III**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CONTRACTOR/TENDERER**

#### **1.0 GENERAL:**

These special conditions supplement the General Conditions of Contract and shall be considered as part of the contract document. Where these special instructions are at variance with the corresponding conditions, stipulations, specification elsewhere in the tender document these special instructions shall prevail.

#### **1.1 LOCATION:**

The proposed site of work is under Wainganga Division, Central Water Commission, Seminary Hills, Nagpur and its Sub-Divisions viz: Upper Wainganga, Sub-Division, CWC, Nagpur, Lower Wainganga, Sub-Division, CWC, Chandrapur, Wardha Sub-Division, CWC, Chandrapur, Penganga Sub-Division, CWC, Yavatmal and the sites under its control.

#### **1.2 SITE CONDITIONS:**

Tenderers are advised to visit the site to acquaint themselves with the site conditions, approaches, camping facilities for their work labour forces for the execution of the work. Non-familiarity with the site conditions will not be considered a reason either for extra claim or for not carrying out the work in strict conformity with instructions.

#### **1.3 SECURITY:**

The contractor shall follow all security rules as may be framed by the EE, Wainganga Division, Central Water Commission, Seminary Hills, Nagpur from time to time regarding control of entry of persons and other similar matters. The contractor's personnel shall abide by all security measure imposed by the Engineer-in -charge or his duly authorized representative from time to time.

#### **1.4 PAYMENT TO WORKMEN:**

**1.4.1** The contractor shall comply with all the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948, Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970 and rules framed there under and other labour laws that may be brought into force from time to time. Increase in the wages due to any statutory act or by rules framed there under by the Government or by local authorities during the currency of the contract or during any valid period of extension of contract shall not be considered for any reimbursement. The tenderer is deemed to have taken this aspect in his unit rates for various items of work covered under this contract.

**1.4.2** The contractor shall record a certificate on every bill that minimum wages as applicable have been paid to the semi-skilled worker provided. All

(Government/Departmental) notification procedure issued in this regard shall be applicable to this contract.

**1.5 LIABILITY FOR LOSS, DAMAGE, ACCIDENT ETC.:**

During the execution of the contract, until completion certificate is issued, the contractor will be fully liable to compensate all concerned for any loss, damage or destruction of "works" structures, plant and machinery, persons, property etc. including third party risk arising due to causes attributable to the contracts as may be decided by the Engineer-in-charge whose decision in this regard will be final. On this account contractor shall not make any claim whatsoever against the EE, Wainganga Division, Central Water Commission, Seminary Hills, Nagpur.

**1.6 SUB CONTRACTS:**

The contractor shall not sublet the whole or any part of the work.

**2.0 Qualification Criteria of Bidder:**

This invitation to bid is open to any bidder meeting the following requirements:

- a) Should have registration for EPF, ESI
- b) The firm should have at least 3 years experience in the business of providing semi-skilled worker/man power assistance/labour services. However, **this qualification criterion can be relaxed** as per Govt. Policy for Small & Micro industries subject to submission of Registration certificates & notifications issued by Govt. of India.

The firm should enclose documentary proof /evidence to substantiate the eligibility criteria given above along with the quotation.

**3.0 One Bid per Bidder:**

Each bidder shall submit only one bid either by himself or as a partner in a joint venture. Bidder who submits or participates in more than one bid will be disqualified.

**4.0 Contents of bidding documents:**

The set of bidding document comprises the following documents:

- a) Notice Inviting tender
- b) Terms and condition of the contract
- c) Letter of Acceptance
- d) Issue of notice to proceed with works
- e) Contract/Agreement form
- h) Schedule of work.
- i) Bank Guarantee form for performance security.

**5.0 Amendment of Bidding Document:**

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the Employer may amend bidding documents by issuing suitable addenda. Any addendum thus issued, shall be part of the bidding document and shall be communicated in writing to all bidders of the bidding document. To give prospective bidders, reasonable time in which to take an addendum into account in preparing their bids, the Employer shall extend as necessary the deadline for submission of bids.

**6.0 Language of the Bid:**

All documents relating to the bid shall be in the English language. However, the documentary proofs such as registration certificate etc. can be in English or local language

**7.0 Security Deposit/ Performance Guarantee:**

The successful bidder shall furnish an amount equivalent to 5% of the value of contract as Security Deposit/ Performance Guarantee in the form of DD/Bank Guarantee/NSC/FDRs from any scheduled bank in favour of **Executive Engineer, Wainganga Division, Central Water Commission**, payable at **Nagpur** within 10 days of the receipt of letter of acceptance. The performance guarantee will be forfeited in case of termination of the contract by the Department due to lapses on the part of the contractor /agency.

**8.0 Bid Prices:**

- a) The bid shall be for the full quantity as described in the schedule of work, corrections, if any, shall be made by crossing out, initialing, dating and re writing.
- b) Rates quoted shall be inclusive of all charges, taxes and other levies and incidental expenses, if any payable.
- c) The rates quoted by the tenderer shall remain fixed for the duration of the contract and shall not be subject to adjustment on any account.
- d) No additional charges will be paid over and above the quoted rates of the Agency and the department shall also not pay any extra amount on any account.
- e) The rate quoted by the Agency shall be inclusive of monthly wages (Basic plus VDA), Employees Provident fund, ESI/Insurance and all other benefits as per minimum wages act of the State of Maharashtra.
- f) The rates quoted by the agency shall not be less than the minimum wages mentioned in the schedule of works.
- g) The rates shall be quoted in Indian Rupee only.

**9.0 Bid Validity:**

Bid shall remain valid for the period of 60 days from the date of bid opening. In exceptional circumstances prior to the expiry of the original bid validity, the Employer may request the bidders to extend the period of validity in a specified additional period. The request and the responses thereto shall be made in writing.

**10.0 Corrupt and fraudulent practices:**

It is expected that Bidders under this contract observe the highest standard of ethics during the execution of this contract. In pursuance of this policy, the employer;

(a) Defines for purpose of these provisions, the terms set forth below as follows:-

- (i) 'Corrupt practice' means the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the contract execution, and
- ii) 'Fraudulent practice' means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence the execution of a contract to the detriment of the employer, and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid process at artificial non-competition levels and to deprive the employer of the benefits of free and open competition.

(b) Will reject a proposal for award of work if he determines that the Bidder recommended for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for contract in question.

**11.0 Clarification of Bidding Documents:**

To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of bids, the Employer may at its discretion, ask any bidder for clarification of its bid,. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing, but no change in the price or substance of the bid shall be sought or offered or permitted except as required to confirm the correction of arithmetic errors discovered by the Employer in the evaluation of the bids.

**12.0 Examination of Bids and Determination of Responsiveness:**

A substantially responsive bid is one that confirms to all the terms and conditions of the bidding document without material deviation or reservation. A material deviation or reservation is one which affects in any substantial way the scope, quality, or performance of the work and which limits in any substantial way. Inconsistent with the bidding documents, the Employer's rights or the bidder's

obligations under the contract, or who's Rectification would affect unfairly the competitive position of other bidders presenting substantially responsive bids. If a bid is not substantially responsive, it will be rejected by the Employer and may not subsequently be made responsive by correction or withdrawal and the non-confirming deviations or reservations.

**13.0 Award criteria:**

The employer shall award the contract to the Bidder whose Bid has been found to be substantially responsive and who has offered the lowest evaluated Bid Price.

**14.0 Notification of Award:**

The bidder whose bid has been accepted will be notified of the award by the employer prior to expiration of the Bid validity period. This letter of acceptance will state the sum that the employer will pay the contractor in consideration of the execution of the works by the contractor.

**15.0 Dispute Resolution Mechanism:**

Any disputes arising on the contract will be referred to Superintending Engineer(C), MCO, CWC, Nagpur and his decision will be final and binding on the bidder.

**16.0 Signing of Contract:**

The successful bidder, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority, shall, within 10 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign and execute the Contract in the contract/agreement form.

**17.0 Changes in Contractor's organization to be approved:**

Where the contractor is a partnership firm, the previous approval in writing of the Employer shall be obtained before any change is made in the constitution of the firm. If previous approval from the employer is not obtained action may be taken against the contractor as per relevant rules in force.

**19.0 Loss of equipment and recovery of cost:**

The man power provided by the bidder should be able to handle the instruments/tools required for the data collection and the contractor will be responsible for the safety of the instruments while in use, excluding normal wear and tear. Any loss of the instrument/tools handled by the semi-skilled workers will be recovered from the Security Deposit/ running bills of the contractor. The cost of such lost/damaged items will be decided by Superintending Engineer(C), MCO, CWC, Nagpur as per the practice followed in the department, and the decision of

Superintending Engineer in fixing the cost of lost/damaged equipments/facilities is final and binding on the contractor.

**20.0 Training:**

The bidder should follow the well established procedures laid down by CWC in river gauging. To acquaint with the procedure laid down by CWC in river gauging, demonstration regarding the work of the site will be arranged by CWC at the site to the staff deployed by the bidder. The staff provided by the bidder need to have the capacity to understand the procedures and method of collection Hydro-meteorological data at the site.

The persons provided by the bidder should follow the safety and security instructions and use safety devices while carrying out the duties and discharging their responsibilities.

**21.0 Payment Terms:**

No intermediate payment shall be made for work. The payment will be released to the agency by the Executive Engineer every Calendar month within 10 days after obtaining the Bill in triplicate from the agency through concerned subdivision. TDS and other taxes as applicable will be deducted from every bill.

**22.0 Labour Laws to be complied:**

The contractor shall comply with the provisions of the relevant Central and State labour laws.

**23.0 Payment of wages:**

- i) The contractor shall make payments to the semi-skilled workers before 10th of the succeeding month and shall produce documentary proof showing that the payments due to the semi-skilled workers, including details of deposit made against ESI, EPF etc. is paid before 10th of the succeeding month. In case the contractor fails to pay by 10th of the succeeding month to the semi-skilled worker, the contract will be terminated and the performance guarantee will be forfeited. In such cases, if the semi-skilled worker deployed by the contractor wishes to continue the work necessary arrangements will be made by the Department to make payments to the semi-skilled workers as per the contract agreement till such time the department wishes to continue the work.
- ii) Wages shall be paid to the employees by the agency without any deductions of any kind except those specified by the Central Government by general or special order in this behalf or permissible under the Payment of Wages Act 1936.

**24.0 Removal of Contractor's Employee:**

The Employer may require the contractor to dismiss or remove semi-skilled worker employed upon the work who may be incompetent or misconduct himself and the contractor shall forthwith comply with such requirements. The service of the semi-skilled workers can be terminated by the contractor only with the prior permission of the Executive Engineer or his authorized representative. On termination of the service of a semi-skilled worker, the contractor should provide substitute within 5 days.

**25.0 Termination of Contract:**

Without prejudice to any of the rights or remedies under this contract if the Contractor dies, the Executive Engineer on behalf of the President of India shall have the option of terminating the contract without compensation to the Contractor.

**26.0 Contract Period:**

The contract is for a period from 01/09/2016 to 15/11/2016. However, if required, the contract can be extended further on mutually acceptable terms.

**27.0 Working hours:**

The hydro-meteorological data collection at site will start at 08.00 a.m. Chart showing the duty hours of semi-skilled worker from 08.00 a.m. to 08.00 a. m. next day will be displayed on notice board and semi-skilled workers have to attend the duty as per the duty chart. The working hours in a day is fixed as 9 hours with a normal break and a day off per week

## **SECTION – IV** **SPECIFICATIONS**

### **1.0 INTRODUCTION:**

This section defines the scope of work and contractual obligations for Providing Semi-skilled man power Services for collection of Hydro-meteorological data at CWC Hydro-meteorological sites Under Wainganga Division, CWC, Nagpur and its Sub-Divisions viz: Upper Wainganga, Sub-Division, CWC, Nagpur, Lower Wainganga, Sub-Division, CWC, Chandrapur, Wardha Sub-Division, CWC, Chandrapur, Penganga Sub-Division, CWC, Yavatmal during the Monsoon-2016 for a period from 01/09/2016 to 15/11/2016.

Wainganga Division, CWC, Nagpur under the control of Monitoring Central Organization is engaged in collection of Hydrological and Meteorological data and in flood forecasting activities in Wainganga Sub- Basin. The Division is maintaining G&D sites and Wireless sites in the states of Maharashtra / Madhya Pradesh / Telangana. In order to collect the hydrological data and maintaining the sites, it is proposed to provide man power assistance at the following sites.

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- a) The Department will not be responsible for any injury sustained to the Agency workers during the performance of their duties and also for any damage or compensation due to any dispute between the Agency and its workers. Any expenditure incurred by the department to face the situation arising out of act of his workers will be made good by the agency. If, any incident / accident occur during the duty period, the department will not be held responsible for the same. - c) **This is purely a temporary arrangement which can be terminated on mutual basis at any time without assigning any reasons by serving one-month notice. And no claim by engaged personals for Government service in future will be entertained.**
- d) The quantity indicated under schedule of work is tentative which can be increased or decreased.

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

- T&C No.1 : The “Agency” shall be responsible for any loss/damage/theft/accident of any type due to the irresponsible/negligence of semi-skilled worker, deployed by the “Agency” during their duty and the “Authority” has the right to recover full loss of such amount from the “Agency”.
- T&C No.2 : The “Agency” shall be responsible for the protection of Govt. property while on duty. In the event of any accident the Agency shall indemnify the department from any liability arising out of dispute with their party or legal matters.

- T&C No.6 : The “Authority” reserves the rights to extend/reduce the period of contract without assigning any reasons.
- T&C No.7 : The “Agency” shall register themselves in the labour enforcement Departments and should deal with the labour Department directly and shall meet all the requirements of Central Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970, contract labour (Regulation and Abolition) Central Rules 1971 and child labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act, 1986. Nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
- T&C No.8 : In case of any dispute, the decision of the “Authority” will be final and binding.
- T&C No.9 : In case it is noticed by the “Authority” that the work carried out by the “Agency” is not up to the mark/required standard, 7 days written notice will be given to the “Agency”, warning the inefficient state of work and asking “Agency” to improve upon the standard within this period. representative.

- T&CNo.13 : The “Agency” shall be responsible for the conduct, behavior and for the fidelity of the semi-skilled worker employed by it.
- T&CNo.14 : The department reserves the right to terminate the services of any deployed semi-skilled worker without standing any reason at any time or ask for the replacement semi-skilled worker.
- T&CNo.15 : If semi-skilled worker is found in drunken state or found misbehaving while on duty or unfit for duty, such semi-skilled worker shall be replaced immediately at the absolute discretion of “Authority” or his representative.
- T&CNo.16 : Twice the amount would be deducted from the bill for willful absent period.
- T&CNo.17 : Semi-skilled worker engaged by the “Agency” shall not be paid less than minimum wages fixed by Government from time to time.

- T&CNo.22 : If the duty of the semi-skilled worker required beyond the duty hours ( 8 hours ), he will be bound to perform the duty without paying any money for the extra duty, however he will be compensated by, as a compensatory leave for performing extra duty on location station on any other day as directed by the Authority.

- T&CNo.23 : The “Agency” shall maintain a register of the attendance at office in order to have record of the semi-skilled worker on duty.
- T&CNo.24 : Any other rules of CPWD codes and its amendment and the order of the CWC (HQs) from New Delhi as applicable will be binding on the for this deal.
- T&CNo.25 : The department reserves the right to test and interview the semi-skilled worker before engagement.
- T&CNo.26 : The persons deployed for semi-skilled worker by the agency should have attained the minimum age of 18 years.
- T&CNo.27 : The “Agency” shall disburse wages to its employees on or before 7<sup>th</sup> day of the succeeding month to the month in respect whereof wages are payable irrespective of fact whether it has received amount of consideration from the department or not.
- T&CNo.28 : The “Agency” shall be solely responsible for any compensation, penalty or any other expense, which may be imposed by the authority for failure in complying with any of the statutory requirement. The Agency indemnifies the Authority for any damage/penalty/cost or any obligation, which the Authority may sustain or incur on account of failure or alleged failure on the part of the contractor for such compliances.
