### Tried to mediate on SYL, but Hry, Pb unyielding: Centre

The government informed the Rajya Sabha today that in a follow-up to the Supreme Court's directive, it tried to mediate between governments Haryana and Punjab to thrash out a mutually acceptable solution to the ticklish Sutlej-Yamuna Link (SYL) canal issue, but failed.

Responding to a supplementary by Congress member Kumari Selja, Union Jal Shakti Minister Gajendra Singh Shekhawat said the two states refused to arrive on a "middle ground". "We have apprised the Supreme Court, which had asked the Centre to explore for a middle ground between the two states," Shekhawat said.

The minister's statement was in response to a pointed question by Selja on the steps taken by the government to resolve the issue of SYL canal, which was meant to provide water to presently parched areas of south Haryana, where groundwater had depleted.

He said the National Green Tribunal had ordered that drinking water supply

- The matter has been pending for decades as Punjab is not willing to share its waters with neighbouring Haryana
- The SC had earlier directed construction of the SYL canal to link the waters of the Sutlej with the Yamuna for transfer of waters to Haryana, especially the southern area of the state

### **Unseasonal rain wreaks** havoc on N India farmers

New Delhi: "We may escape coronavirusbutnottheimpact of the other disaster (unseasonal rains and hailstorms) which struck us last week," said Subhash Chaudhary, who, likeotherfarmers in the north, suffered heavy damage to standing crops on Saturday even as 31 districts of Uttar Pradesh faced the wrath of the weather this month.

Unseasonal rains and hailstormshave, sofar, affected rabi (winter sown) crops on 4 lakh hectares of land in north India with UP the worst-hit till Saturday. Besides UP, a few districts of Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan too have borne the impact. "State government will provide compensa-

Vishwa.Mohan@timesgroup.com tion only after crop loss estimation. Many farmers will have nothing to survive on till then," Chaudhary told TOI.

Though the exact extent of damage is still unclear, officials in the agriculture ministry said preliminary reports from the ground suggest losses of up to 90% for vegetables, 70% for mustard and up to 60% for wheat and potatoes in certain districts in north-west India. Muzaffarnagar, Mathura, Ghaziabad, Gautam Budh Nagar and Aligarhareamong the 31 districts which faced heavy damage in western UP.

The IMD has predicted rainfallin Odisha, West Bengal, Sikkim, Jharkhand Chhattisgarh, east Madhya Pradesh and Vidarbha (Maharashtra).

# Centre clears 52 Master Plans of NE river basins

NEW DELHI, March 16: The Centre has cleared 52 Master Plans of River Basins of Northeast region, including main stem of Brahmaputra and Barak rivers prepared by the Brahmaputra Board for implementation of its recommendations by respective State governments.

The control of floods and erosion is also part of recommendations, said Minister of State for Jal Shakti Rattan Lal Kataria in a Rajya Sabha reply.

The Minister of State for Jal Shakti said that every year Assam, Manipur and other Northeast region suffer losses due to heavy rains and flood. Flood management being a State subject, schemes for flood management and erosion control are formulated and implemented by the State governments. The Centre plays advisory, catalytic and promotional role.

In addition, the Government of India has also released funds to Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram and Nagaland under the Flood Management Programme in the last four financial years for execution of their flood management schemes.

Further, as a soft measure, the Government of India through Central Water Commission issues flood forecasts for Northeast States which facilitates them to manage the flood, he added. and documented at WSE Dte, CWC.

# राज्यसमा में बोलीं सैलजा

# हरियाणा के रेवाड़ी में जल संकट के आसार!

नई दिल्ली (ब्यूरो)। हरियाणा की कांग्रेस सांसद कुमारी सैजला द्वारा हरियाणा के रेवाडी जिले में जल संकट के आसार बढ़ने के मामले पर केंद्र सरकार ने माना कि अधिक जल दोहन होने के कारण रेवाड़ी जिले के कुछ गांवों में जल संकट बना हुआ है। हालांकि सरकार देशभर में ऐसे इलाकों के भू-जल संसाधनों का आकलन कराकर समस्या से निपटने का प्रयास कर रही है। राज्यसभा में सोमवार को प्रश्नकाल के दौरान यह मामला हरियाणा की कांग्रेस सदस्य कुमारी सैलजा के सवाल के जवाब में केंद्रीय जल शक्ति मंत्री गजेन्द्र सिंह शेखावत ने माना कि जिस प्रकार से जल दोहन हो रहा है उससे हरियाणा के रेवाडी जिले में बड़ा जलसंकट पैदा होने से इंकार नहीं किया जा सकता। शेखावत ने सदन में जानकारी दी कि केंद्रीय भू-जल बोर्ड और राज्य भू-जल विभाग ने संयुक्त रूप से भारत के डायनामिक भ्-जल संसाधनों का आकलन करवाया है।

### जल उद्योगों की एनओसी रद

केंद्रीय मंत्री शेखावत ने सदन में जानकारी दी कि केंद्रीय भूजल बोर्ड के पास उपलब्ध आंकड़ों के मृताबिक रेवाडी में कुल 134 उद्योगों ने अनापत्ति प्रमाणपत्र के लिए आवेदन किया है. जिनमें से पात्र उद्योगों को २४ अनापति प्रमाणपत्र जारी किए गए हैं और 43 उदयोगों के एनओसी आवेदनों को रह कर दिया गया है**।** ६७ के आवेदन विचाराधीन हैं।
