Cyclone leaves 72 dead in Gujarat, Maharashtra

Saurashtra worst affected; Navy pressed into service

Ahmedabad/Mumbai, May 19: In Gujarat, as many as 46 people have been killed due to Cyclone Tauktae across 12 districts, and in Maharashtra at least 26 personnel on board accommodation barge P305 that went adrift in the cyclone fury before sinking in the Arabian Sea off Mumbai coast are dead and 49 still missing, officials said Wednesday.

To assess the damage and destruction wrecked by Cyclone Tauktae, Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday conducted an aerial survey of areas affected in Gujarat and adjoining Union Territory of Diu.

"Undertook an aerial survey over parts of Gujarat and Diu to assess the situation in the wake of Cyclone Tauktae. Central government is working closely with all the states affected by the cyclone," Mr Modi tweeted afterwards.

The Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) questioned why the Prime Minister did not visit cyclone-hit areas in Maharashtra.

The cyclone made landfall between Diu and Una town of Gir-Somnath district in Gujarat on Monday night. Before making landfall in Gujarat, Cyclone Tauktae had claimed seven lives and caused damages in parts of Maharashtra.

The cyclone, categorised as an extremely severe cyclonic storm on Monday, has now weakened into a depression and lay centred over south Rajasthan and adjoining Gujarat region on Wednesday.

Navy warship INS Kochi reached Mumbai on Wednesday carrying 22 bodies and 125 of the 186 rescues from P305.

In Gujarat, 24 deaths were reported due to wall collapses during the cyclone, while six died after trees fell on them. Five each died because of house collapse and electrocution, four due to roof collapse and rest died due to a tower collapse, an official said.

As many as 30,000 structures including 28,430 kachcha houses, 74,493 electricity poles and 674 roads were damaged, 68,753 trees uprooted and power supply snapped in over 9,000 Gujarat villages.

From Amreli district in Gujarat's Saurashtra region, the worst affected in the cyclone that crossed the state coast as an extremely severe cyclonic

storm on Monday night and completed landfall around 1.30 am Tuesday, 15 deaths were reported from.

In Maharashtra, a Navy spokesperson said the bodies were brought to Mumbai along with 125 of the barge P305 survivors. Forty-nine people who were on barge P305 which sank on Monday are still missing.

Calling the victims "Brave Nature's Victims (BNV)", he said Navy personnel, battling extreme weather, have so far rescued 186 of the 261 people who were onboard barge P305 and also two from tugboat Varaprada. "Search and rescue operations are still on and we haven't lost hopes of bringing them ashore," he said. However, the chance of finding survivors is getting bleaker as the hours pass by, he added.

MODI DOLES OUT ₹1,000 CR FOR CYCLONE RELIEF IN GUJARAT

Ahmedabad, May 19: Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday approved assistance ₹1,000 crore for "immediate relief activities" in Gujarat after conducting an aerial survey of areas hit by cyclone Tauktae in the state, an official release said.

He also announced ex-gratia compensation of ₹2 lakh for the kin of those killed due to cyclone in all affected states.

Immediate financial assistance for the other affected states would be given after the respective state governments share the assessment of the damage with the Centre, the Press Information Bureau (PIB) release added.

The announcement was made after Modi held a review meeting here with Gujarat Chief Minister Vijay Rupani and top officials to assess the damage caused by the cyclone.

Gujarat will get additional assistance after an inter-ministerial team which will visit soon submits its assessment, the release said.

Modi announced an ex-gratia of ₹2 lakh to the next of kin of the deceased and ₹50,000 to the seriously injured in the cyclone across Kerala, Karnataka, Goa, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Rajasthan, Daman and Diu, and Dadra and Nagar Haveli, the PIB release said.

CYCLONIC STORM TO DEVELOP OVER BAY OF BENGAL BY MAY 26: IMD

A cyclonic storm is very likely to develop by May 26 over the Bay of Bengal.

According to the India Meteorological Department (IMD), a low pressure area is likely to form over the north of Andaman Sea and adjoining east-central Bay of Bengal around May 22. This low pressure area is very likely to intensify into a cyclonic storm in the subsequent 72 hours.

It is likely to move north-westwards and reach the Odisha-West Bengal coast around May 26. If the cyclone forms, it will be called 'Yaas,' a name given by Oman.

The Met office also informed that continuous watch was being maintained over Andaman Sea and adjoining Bay of Bengal for probable development of depression around May 23. The IMD issued a wind warning for Odisha in view of the possible formation of a cyclonic storm.

Delhi's max temperature for May dips to lowest since 1951

'Tauktae' impact: 24-hour rainfall in May highest since 1976

Delhi on Wednesday recorded a maximum temperature of 23.8 degrees Celsius, 16 notches below normal and the lowest in the month of May since 1951, as rain drenched the national capital under the impact of cyclonic storm 'Tauktae' and a western disturbance, the India Meteorological Department said.

Delhi also recorded 60 mm rainfall till 8:30 pm on Wednesday, the highest 24-hour precipitation in May since 1976. Delhi's maximum temperature during the day was less than that of Srinagar (25.8 degrees Celsius) and Dharamshala (27.2 degrees Celsius) up in the north. The rainfall in Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, northern Rajasthan, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand is a result of interaction between the remnant of cyclonic storm "Tauktae" and a Western Disturbance, the IMD said.

The Safdarjung Observatory, which provides representative figures for the city, recorded

31.3 mm rainfall between 8:30 am and 5:30 pm, the IMD said. It said moderate rainfall is likely in the national capital on Thursday too.

Even if no rainfall is recorded till 8:30 am on Thursday, it will still be the highest 24-hour rainfall in May since 2014, according to Met department data.

The capital had recorded 41.8 mm rainfall on May 22 in 2014. Najafgarh and SPS Mayur Vihar recorded 31.5 mm and 20 mm precipitation, respectively. Several other areas recorded light rainfall.

The incessant rains brought the maximum temperature down to 23.8 degrees Celsius at Safdarjung. The minimum temperature settled at 21.4 degrees Celsius, five notches below normal. "Today, Safdarjung recorded a maximum temperature of 23.8 degrees Celsius. This is the lowest maximum temperature since 1951," Kuldeep Srivastava, the head of the IMD's regional forecasting centre, said. In between, a low of 24.8 degrees Celsius was recorded on May 13 1982, he said.

Rs 1,000 cr cyclone aid for Gujarat

Prime Minister conducts aerial survey of cyclone-hit areas in the State, death toll reaches 46

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday announced a financial assistance of Rs 1,000 crore for immediate relief measures in the areas hit by cyclone Tauktae in Gujarat, an official release said.

As many as 46 people were killed in the cyclone which made a landfall on Monday night in Gujarat and left a trail of destruction before weakening and moving to Rajasthan, officials said on Wednesday.

Thousands of houses were damaged and trees and electricity poles were uprooted as Tauktae brought along heavy rains and high winds. Of 46 deaths, 15 were reported from Amreli district in Saurashtra region, among the worst affected by the cyclone that crossed the state coast as an "extremely severe cyclonic storm" on Monday night.

The Prime Minister also conducted an aerial survey of areas affected by cyclone Tauktae in Gujarat and adjoining Union Territory of Diu and held a meeting with top officials later to review the situation.

He announced Rs 2 lakh ex-gratia compensation for the kin of the deceased and Rs 50,000 for those injured in cyclone-related incidents in all States affected by Tauktae. The Prime Minister approved the help package after holding a review meeting here with Gujarat Chief Minister Vijay Rupani

West Bengal, Odisha prepare for possible cyclone hitting east coast

MUMBAI/ KOLKATA/ AHMEDABAD/ BHUBANESWAR: As many as 26 personnel on board accommodation barge P305 that went adrift in Cyclone Tauktae fury before sinking in the Arabian Sea off Mumbai coast are dead and 49 are still missing, as the Navy continued search and rescue operations through the night.

The Navy said its personnel, battling extreme weather, have so far rescued 186 of the 261 people who were onboard barge P305 and also two from tugboat Varaprada. Chances of finding more survivors are looking bleak, an official said.

The Navy had so far maintained that there were 273 persons on board the barge but an official on Wednesday evening said that the company which operated it has informed that there were 261 personnel on board the ill-fated barge.

Mumbai Police will conduct a probe as to why the ill-fated barge P-305 stayed in the area despite warnings about cyclone Tauktae, an official said.

south Mumbai on Wednesday registered an accidental death report (ADR) in connection with persons on the barge whose bodies have been recovered.

Warships INS Kochi, INS Kolkata, INS Beas, INS Betwa, INS Teg, P8I maritime surveillance aircraft, Chetak, ALH & Seaking helicopters are involved in the SAR operations.

All the 137 personnel on barge GAL Constructor were rescued on Tuesday by the Navy and Coast Guard. The 196 personnel on barge SS-3

and 101 personnel on board oil rig Sagar Bhushan are safe, the official said.

Three barges and an oil rig with 695 personnel on board went adrift on Monday. These included barge P305 with 261 persons, cargo barge GAL Constructor with 137 personnel on board, accommodation barge SS-3 with 196 personnel on board and the Sagar Bhushan oil rig with 101 personnel on board, the official said.

City records highest 24-hour rainfall in May since 1976 under 'Tauktae' impact



NEW DELHI: Delhi on Wednesday recorded 60 mm rainfall till 8:30 pm, the highest 24-hour precipitation in May in 35 years, under the impact of cyclonic storm 'Tauktae' and a western disturbance, the IMD said.

The city also recorded a maximum temperature of 23.8 degrees Celsius, 16 notches below normal and the lowest in the month of

May since 1951, the IMD said. The capital had recorded 60 mm rainfall in a 24-hour period on May 24 in 1976.

Palam, SPS Mayur Vihar and Najafgarh recorded 36.8 mm, 39.5 mm and 57 mm rainfall during the period.

Rainfall recorded below 15 mm is considered light, between 15 and 64.5 mm is moderate, between 64.5 mm and 115.5 mm is heavy, between 115.6 and 204.4 is very heavy. Anything above 204.4 mm is considered extremely heavy rainfall.

The IMD said "rainfall activity is very likely to decrease" on Thursday and "scattered to fairly widespread" rainfall is forecast in the Capital.

Another cyclone 'Yaas' to hit east coast

Cyclonic formation to reach WB, Odisha coast by May 22

AFTER cyclone Tauktae leaves a trail of destruction in the West Coast, another cyclone is likely to form over Bay of Bengal.

With the variation in the sea surface temperature, weather experts say that conditions turn out to be favourable for another cyclone which gains a nomenclature 'Yaas'.

The Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) warned that the cyclone is likely to intensify into a deep depression on May 23. Later, it is likely to cross the shores of Odisha. With the formation of a low-pressure over Bay of Bengal, IMD officials mentioned that it is likely to develop into a depression.

On May 21, southwest monsoon is likely to advance over South Andaman Sea and adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal. It is likely to strengthen and deepen south-westerly winds over the region.

Other atmospheric and oceanic conditions like conductive environment for convection, sea surface temperatures are also remaining favourable for persistent cloudiness over

Andaman Sea and adjoining areas of east central and South east Bay of Bengal around May 22. Hence a low-pressure area is likely to form over north Andaman Sea and adjoining east central Bengal the same day.

Gradually, it is expected to intensify into a cyclonic storm during the subsequent 72 hours. Around May 26, it is likely to move northwestwards and reach West Bengal-Odisha coasts.

With this, light to moderate rainfall at most places of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, heavy falls at isolated places are expected on May 22 and 23.

IMD forecasts light to moderate rainfall at most places in Odisha- West Bengal followed by heavy falls at isolated places from May 25 evening.

Wind speed reaching 45-55-kmph gusting to 65-kmph is likely to prevail over Andaman sea and adjoining east central Bay of Bengal on May 23. It is likely to increase up to 70-kmph.

The sea condition will be very rough over south east Bay of Bengal, south Andaman and adjoining east central Bay of Bengal and Odisha coasts.

कई राज्यों में तबाही मचाने वाले चक्रवाती तूफान तौकते के असर पश्चिमी विशोभ के चलते दिल्ली एनसीआर में करीब 24 घंटे बारिश होती रही। मौसम विभाग के अनुसार बुधवार सुबह साढ़े आठ बजे तक पिछले 24 घंटे में शहर में करीब 1.8 मिमी बारिश दर्ज हुई। दिल्ली के अधिकांश क्षेत्रों में मंगलवार देर रात से ही बारिश शुरू हो गई जो बुधवार देर रात तक जारी रही। हालांकि बहुत भारी बारिश की आशंका के अनुरूप बारिश देखने को नहीं मिली। मौसम विभाग का अनुमान है कि गुरुवार को भी दिल्ली में बारिश होगी लेकिन इसमें कमी दर्ज होगी। लगातार हो रही बारिश को लेकर प्रादेशिक मौसम विभाग ने पहले ही ऑरेंज अलर्ट जारी कर दिया था। वहीं निजी मौसम

विज्ञान कंपनी स्काईमेट वेदर के उपाध्यक्ष महेश पलावत ने भी इसका पूर्वानुमान जताया था।

वहीं बारिश और तेज हवाओं के चलते बुधवार को अधिकतम तापमान भारी गिरावट के साथ

24 डिग्री सेल्सियस व न्यूनतम तापमान 21.4 डिग्री सेल्सियस पर दर्ज हुआ। आंकड़ों के अनुसार पिछले कई चार साल से ज्यादा समय के दौरान मई महीने में दर्ज किया गया यह सबसे कम अधिकतम तापमान है। स्काईमेट वेदर के अनुसार दिल्ली में पिछले 36 घंटों में बहुत हल्की बारिश हुई है, जिससे आसमान में बादल छाए रहने और हल्की हवा चलने के साथ ही सुखद स्थिति बनी रही।

सफदरजंग और पालम वेधशालाओं में पारा सामान्य से 10 डिग्री सेल्सियस कम दर्ज किया गया। कंपनी की मानें तो चक्रवात तौकते का असर दिल्ली तक पहुंच रहा है और राजधानी के कई हिस्सों में व्यापक बारिश के आसार बन रहे थे। डिप्रेशन और कमजोर होकर एक वेल मावर्ड निम्न दबाव बन गया और बाद में एक साधारण निम्न दबाव बन गया।

बंगाल की खाड़ी और अरब सागर में चक्रवात के लिए अनुकूल हालात बने तौकते के बाद 'यास' का खतरा मंडराया दिल्ली, यूपी व उत्तराखंड में ऑरेंज अलर्ट

चक्रवात 'तौकते' का तांडव अभी थमा नहीं है कि इसी बीच एक और चक्रवात की आहट ने लोगों को परेशानी में डाल दिया है। दरअसल मौसम विभाग ने अपने ताजा अपडेट में कहा है कि 23-24 मई के आस-पास बंगाल की खाड़ी में एक लो प्रेशर दवाब विकसित होता दिख रहा है, जो कि साइक्लोन में तब्दील हो सकता है। मौसम विभाग की नजर इस दवाब पर बनी हुई है। आईएमडी ने कहा है कि इस वक्त सारी परिस्थितियां बंगाल की खाड़ी और अरब सागर में चक्रवात के अनुकूल हैं और इसी वजह से तूफान आ रहे हैं। मौसम विभाग का कहना है कि बंगाल की खाड़ी के ऊपर समुद्र की सतह का तापमान लगभग 31 डिग्री सेल्सियस है और लगातार जलवायु परिवर्तन और समुद्र के बढ़ते ताप के कारण इस तरह के साइक्लोन आ रहे हैं। इस तूफान का नाम 'यास' है, जिसे कि

तौकते के चलते 19-20 मई को देश के कई राज्यों में भारी बारिश की संभावना है। दिल्ली, हिमाचल प्रदेश, उत्तराखंड, हरियाणा, चंडीगढ़, उत्तर प्रदेश और पंजाब में भारी बारिश का अलर्ट जारी है। नागौर के लिए ऑरेंज अलर्ट जारी किया गया है।

राजस्थान के 8 राज्यों में चेतावनी दी

'अत्यंत गंभीर चक्रवात' तौकते का रुख अब राजस्थान की ओर हो गया है। सोमवार को उसने गुजरात में भारी तबाही मचाई है तो वहीं इससे पहले उसने केरल, कर्नाटक, गोवा और महाराष्ट्र में काफी नुकसान किया है। भारतीय मौसम विभाग ने अपने ताजा अपडेट में कहा है कि इस तूफान के कारण राजस्थान में भारी बारिश की आशंका है। इसी वजह से राज्य के 8 जिलों में अलर्ट जारी किया गया है।

उत्तर भारत को भी तौकते करेगा प्रभावित

भारत मौसम विज्ञान विभाग (आईएमडी) ने बताया है कि चक्रवाती तूफान ताउते अब



कमजोर पड़ गया है, लेकिन दक्षिणी राजस्थान तथा निकटवर्ती गुजरात क्षेत्र में अभी भी यह मौजूद है। ऐसे

में चक्रवाती तूफान ताउते के कारण राजस्थान में हल्की से मध्यम बारिश हो सकती है। इसके अलावा राजस्थान, उत्तराखंड, हिमाचल प्रदेश, उत्तर प्रदेश तथा दिल्ली सहित कई राज्यों में बारिश होने का अनुमान जताया गया है।

उत्तराखंड में भूस्खलन की चेतावनी

उत्तराखंड में बारिश होने का अनुमान है, जिसके चलते भूस्खलन की भी चेतावनी दी गई है। इसके अलावा हिमाचल प्रदेश, हरियाणा, चंडीगढ़, दिल्ली, पश्चिमी उत्तर प्रदेश तथा पश्चिमी राजस्थान में अगले 24 घंटे में भारी बारिश का अनुमान लगाया गया है। राजस्थान में अगले 12 घंटे में 45-55 किमी प्रति घंटे की रफ्तार से चलने वाली तेज हवाएं 65 किमी प्रति घंटे की रफ्तार से चल सकती हैं।
