CIRCULAR

The Ministry of External Affairs (CPV Division) intends to fill up two posts of Deputy Passport Officer (DPO) in the Central Passport Organisation on deputation basis (for appointment as DPO in Passport Offices at Jammu and Srinagar) in the pay band of Rs.15600-39,100 + grade pay of Rs.6,600 (pre-revised pay scale of Rs.10,000-325-15,200) from amongst officers of the Ministries / Departments of the Government of India and officers of the All India Services. An officer holding analogous post on regular basis or an officer with 5 years' regular service in the pay band of Rs.15,600-39,100 + grade pay of Rs.5,400 (pre-revised pay scale of Rs.8,000-275-13,500) is eligible for consideration for appointment against the post of Deputy Passport Officer.

2. The selected officer will be on deputation for a period of two years initially which can be curtailed or extended further depending on the requirements with the consent of the officer and with the approval of the lending department. The usual deputation terms will apply.
