2. Eligibility criteria for the post of Assistant Engineer

- i. Officers in the grade of Assistant Director-II/Sub Division Engineer having minimum 2 years' experience in the field of investigation, hydro meteorological observations and constructions of projects works in CWC will be required for applying the post.
- ii. Maximum age of the applicant on the last date of submission of application should not be more than 57 years.
- iii. Officials who have been posted or served in Bhutan/Nepal for a period of 2 years or more in any capacity during the last 10 years (Counted from the closing date of receipt of application) shall not be considered.
- iv. The applicants shall be awarded marks in various attributes on a scale of 100 marks as detailed below:

3. Eligibility criteria for the post of Junior Engineer

- Minimum 2 years of experience in the field of survey and investigation works in CWC will be required for applying the post
- Maximum age of the applicant on the last date of submission of application should not be more than 57 years.
- Officials who have been posted or served in Bhutan/Nepal for a period of 2 years or more in any capacity during the last 10 years (Counted from the closing date of receipt of application) shall not be considered.
- The applicants shall be awarded marks in various attributes on a scale of 100 marks as detailed below

Additionally, officers willing to submit their application must ensure that their updated Bio-Data is available on CWC website.
