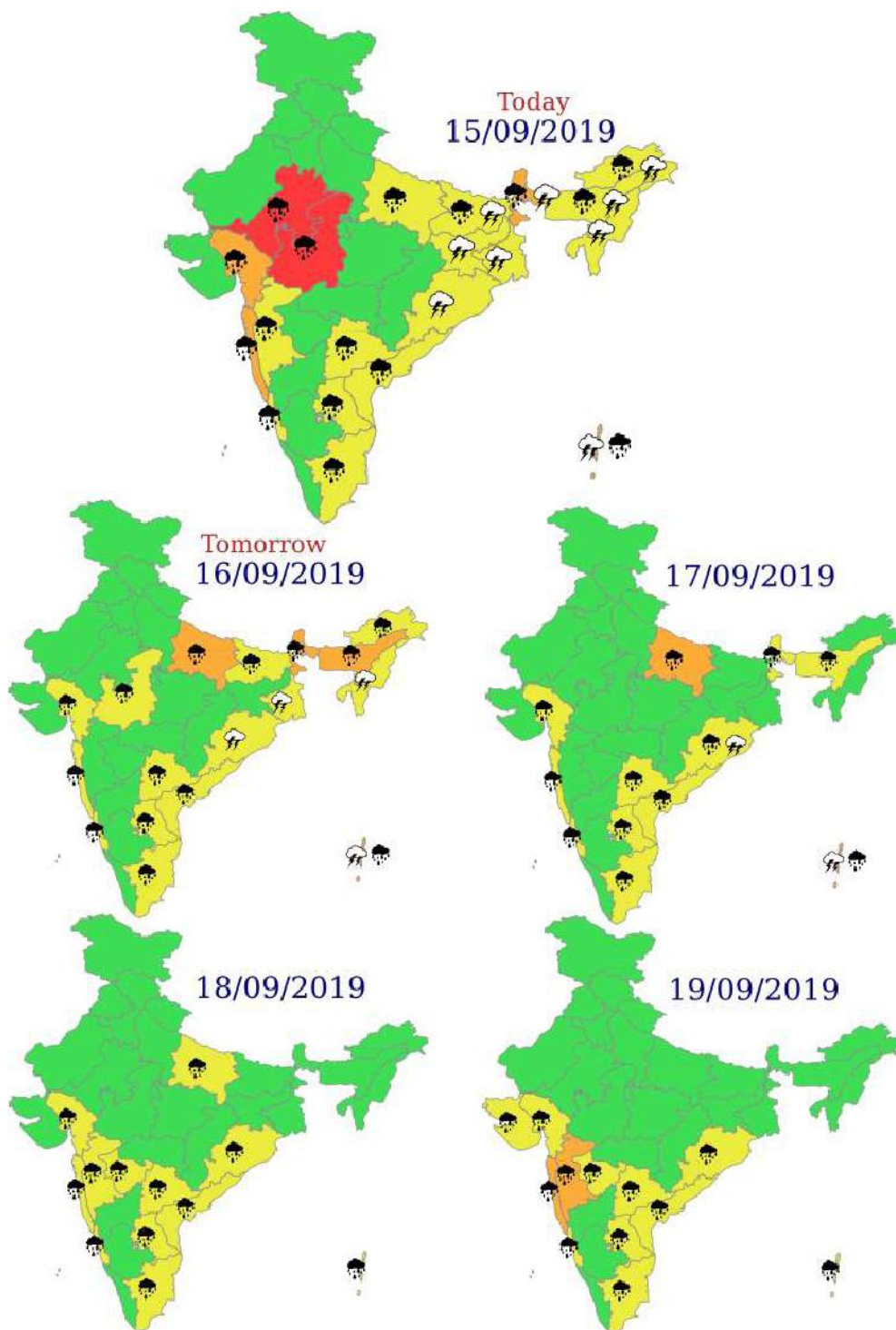
2.0 SYNOPTIC SITUATION: as per IMD dated: 15.09.2019

- The Low Pressure area over northwest Madhya Pradesh & neighbourhood now lies over southeast Rajasthan and adjoining northwest Madhya Pradesh.
- The associated cyclonic circulation extends upto 5.8 km above mean sea level.
- The cyclonic circulation over north Tamilnadu & neighbourhood persists and now seen between 4.5 and 5.8 km above mean sea level.
- A cyclonic circulation lies over south Gujarat & neighbourhood between 4.5 and 5.8 km above mean sea level.
- The cyclonic circulation over Kutch & neighbourhood at 0.9 km above mean sea level has become less marked.
