**1.0 Rainfall Situation**

**2.0 SYNOPTIC SITUATION: as per IMD dated: 02.07.2019**

◆Southwest monsoon has further advanced into some parts of East Rajasthan, most parts of Madhya Pradesh, remaining parts of Chhattisgarh, some more parts of Uttar Pradesh, most parts of Uttarakhand and some parts of Himachal Pradesh and Jammu & Kashmir. Northern Limit of Monsoon (NLM) passes through Lat. 22°N/Long. 60°E, Lat. 22°N/Long. 65°E, Dwarka, Ahmedabad, Rajgarh, Khajuraho, Lucknow, Najibabad, Mandi and Lat. 33°N/Long. 79°E.

◆The well marked low pressure area over north Odisha & adjoining areas of Gangetic West Bengal now lies over southeast Jharkhand & adjoining areas of Odisha & Gangetic West Bengal. Associated cyclonic circulation extends upto 7.6 km above mean sea level tilting southwards with height.

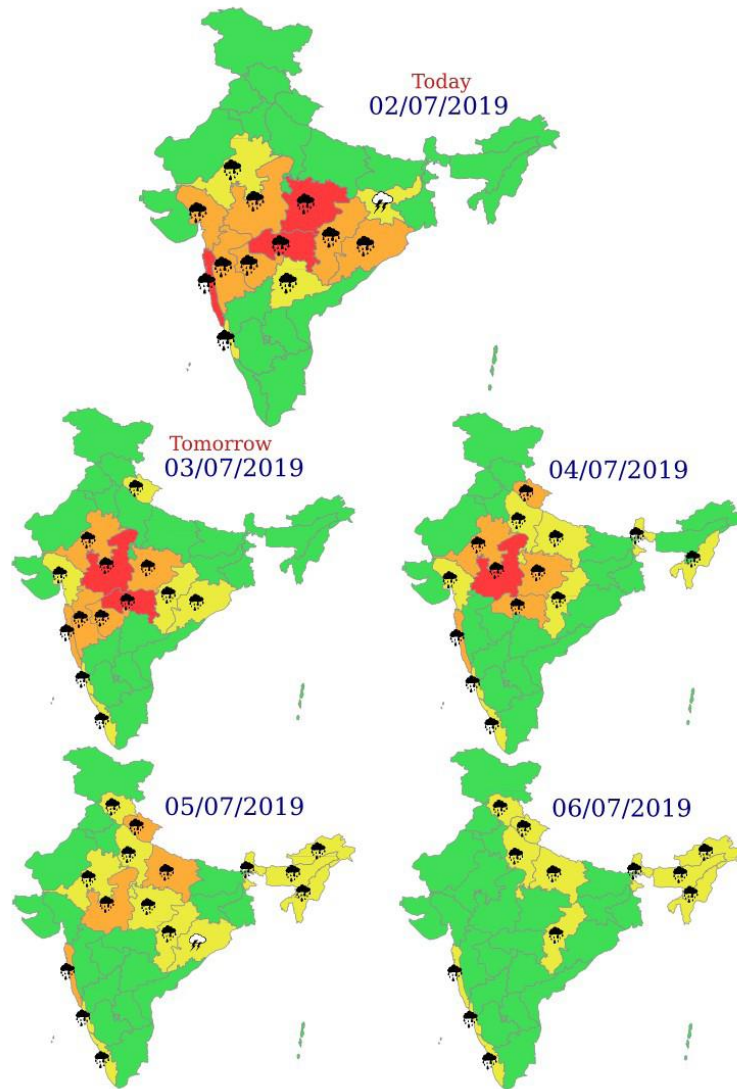
◆In association with its likely westnorthwestward movement, conditions are very likely to become favourable for further advance of Southwest Monsoon into remaining parts of North Arabian Sea, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, some more parts of Rajasthan, Himachal Pradesh & Uttar Pradesh, some parts of Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi and remaining parts of Uttarakhand during next 2-3 days.

◆The eastwest shear zone roughly along Lat. 20°N between 4.5 & 5.8 km above mean sea level has become less marked.
