1.0 Rainfall Situation

2.0 SYNOPTIC SITUATION: as per IMD dated: 05.07.2020

Under the influence of cyclonic circulation over Westcentral & adjoining northwest Bay of Bengal off north Coastal Andhra Pradesh and south Odisha coasts, a low pressure area has formed over Northwest Bay of Bengal off Odisha and Gangetic West Bengal coasts. **Associated** circulation extends 7.6 km above upto mean sea level tilting southwestwards with height.

The low pressure area over coastal Saurashtra & neighbourhood now lies over Kutch & neighbourhood and associated cyclonic circulation extends upto 5.8 km above mean sea level tilting southwards with height. It is very likely to become more marked during next 24 hours.

The monsoon trough at mean sea level now passes through center of low pressure area of Kutch & neighbourhood, Ahmedabad, Raisen, Seoni, Pendra Road, Sambalpur, center of low pressure area over Northwest Bay of Bengal off Odisha & Gangetic West Bengal coasts and thence southeastwards to eastcentral Bay of Bengal.

The off- shore trough from south Gujarat coast to Karnataka coast now runs from Gujarat coast to north Kerala coast.

A trough in westerlies with its axis at mid-tropospheric levels runs roughly along Longitude 63° E to the north of Latitude 30°N


