2.0 SYNOPTIC SITUATION: as per IMD dated: 06.06.2020

Southwest Monsoon has further advanced into some more parts of South Interior Karnataka and Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal; most parts of southwest Bay of Bengal, entire southeast Bay of Bengal; some more parts of eastcentral Bay of Bengal and some parts of westcentral & northeast Bay of Bengal.

The Northern Limit of Monsoon (NLM) now passes through Lat.14°N/Long.60°E, Lat.14°N/Long.70°E, Karwar,Hassan, Salem, Puducherry, Lat.13°N/Long.85°E, Lat.16°N/Long.90°E and Lat.20°N/Long.93°E.

Conditions are becoming favourable for further advancement of Southwest Monsoon into some more parts of Karnataka, entire Tamil Nadu; some parts of Rayalaseema and Coastal Andhra Pradesh; entire southwest Bay of Bengal; some more parts of central and northeast Bay of Bengal and some parts of northeast India during next 2- 3days.

The Low Pressure Area [remnant of the Severe Cyclonic Storm 'NISARGA'] over Bihar & adjoining northeast Uttar Pradesh has become less marked. However, the associated cyclonic circulation now lies over Bihar & adjoining East Uttar Pradesh and extends upto 0.9 km above mean sea level.

A cyclonic circulation lies over east Vidarbha & neighbourhood and extends upto 0.9 km above mean sea level.

A cyclonic circulation lies over eastcentral Bay of Bengal & adjoining north Andaman Sea between 3.1 km and 5.8 km above mean sea level.
