
#### 2.0 SYNOPTIC SITUATION: as per IMD dated: 08.08.2019

- South west monsoon was Vigorous over North Interior Karnataka & South Interior Karnataka and active over Coastal Karnataka.
- > The Depression over northeast Chhattisgarh & neighbourhood moved westnorthwestwards with a speed of about 33 kmph in last six hours and lay centred at 0830 hours IST of today, the 08th August, 2019, over north Chhattisgarh & neighbourhood near Latitude 23.0°N and Longitude 82.9°E about 40 km westnorthwest of Ambikapur (Chhattisgarh), about 250 km west of Ranchi (Jharkhand) and about 190 km southsoutheast of Sidhi (East Madhya Pradesh). It is very likely to continue to move westnorthwestwards and weaken gradually into a Well Marked Low Pressure Area during next 48 hours.
- > The feeble offshore trough at mean sea level from south Maharashtra coast to Kerala coast persists.
- A cyclonic circulation lies over southeast Arabian Sea off Kerala coast extending between 7.6 & 9.5 km above mean sea level.
