2.0 SYNOPTIC SITUATION: as per IMD dated: 09.06.2020

The Northern Limit of Monsoon (NLM) passes through Lat.14 $^{\circ}$ N/Long.60 $^{\circ}$ E, Lat.14 $^{\circ}$ N/Long.70 $^{\circ}$ E, Karwar,Shimoga, Tumukuru, Chittoor, Chennai, 18 $^{\circ}$ N/Long.87 $^{\circ}$ E and Lat.22 $^{\circ}$ N/Long.93 $^{\circ}$ E.


Conditions are becoming favourable for further advance of Southwest Monsoon into some more parts of Central Arabian Sea, Goa, Some parts of Maharashtra, some more parts of Karnataka and Rayalaseema, remaining parts of Tamilnadu, some parts of Telangana and Coastal Andhra Pradesh, some more parts of Central and North Bay of Bengal and some parts of Northeastern states during next 48 hours.

Conditions are likely to become favorable subsequently for further advance of Southwest monsoon into some more parts of Maharashtra, Karnataka and Telangana remaining parts of Rayalaseema and Coastal Andhra Pradesh, remaining parts of Bay of Bengal & northeastern states, Sikkim, some parts of Odisha and Gangetic West Bengal during subsequent 48 hours.

Under the influence of the cyclonic circulation over eastcentral Bay of Bengal & neighbourhood a low pressure area has formed over the same region. Associated cyclonic circulation extends upto mid-tropspheric levels. It is likely to move west-northwest wards and become well marked during next 48 hours.

A cyclonic circulation extending upto 0.9 km above mean sea level lies over north Odisha & neighbourhood.

3.0Rainfall forecast for next 5 days issued on 09th June 2020 (Midday) by IMD 9th June 2020



There is no heavy Rainfall warning in Basin states fo of Krishna Basin hence no flood situation for next five days.
