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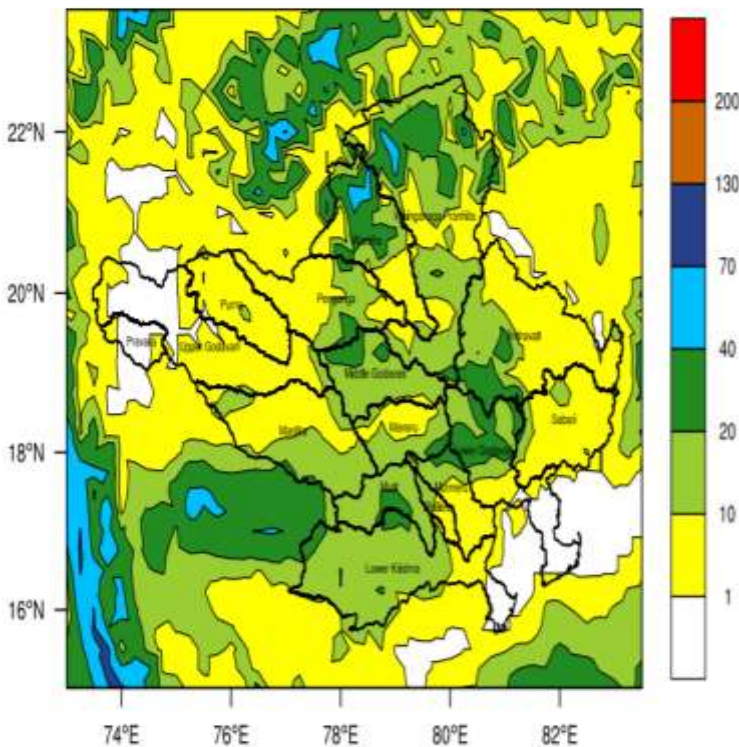

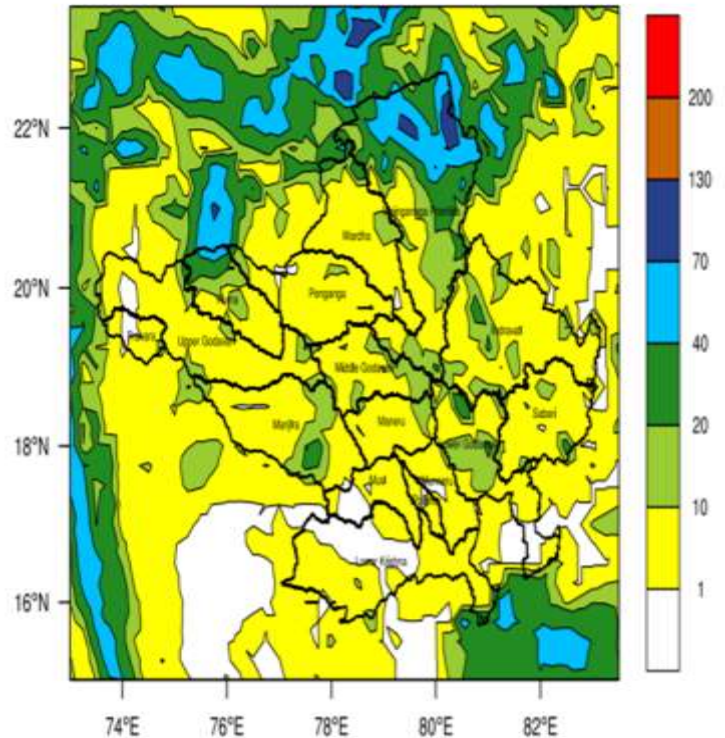

CWC Inference:- Rainfall warning as received from IMD is given above. On Day 1 Very Light Rain to Light Rain is predicted in Godavari Basin and on Day 2 Very Light Rain to Moderate Rain is predicted. Sites in Upper Godavari Manjira, Maneru, Middle Godavari, Wardha, Wainganga, Lower Godavari, Indravati, and Sabari catchment should be Watchful.
