2.0 SYNOPTIC SITUATION: as per IMD dated: 13.06.2020

Southwest Monsoon has further advanced into some more parts of Madhya Maharashtra, most parts of Marathwada & Vidarbha, some more parts of Chhattisgarh, remaining parts of Odisha & West Bengal and most parts of Jharkhand and some parts of Bihar.

The Northern Limit of Monsoon (NLM) passes through Lat.18°N/Long.60°E, Lat.18°N/Long.70°E, Harnai, Ahmednagar, Aurangabad, Gondia, Champa, Ranchi, Bhagalpur, Lat.27°N/Long.86.5°E.

Conditions are becoming favourable for further advance of Southwest Monsoon into remaining parts of Central Arabian Sea, some parts of North Arabian Sea, remaining parts of Maharashtra (including Mumbai), some more parts of Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand & Bihar and some parts of south Gujarat State and south Madhya Pradesh during next 24 hours.

The low pressure area over north Coastal Andhra Pradesh and adjoining Coastal Odisha & neighbourhood has become less marked. However, the associated cyclonic circulation now lies over north Interior Odisha and neighbourhood and extends upto 7.6 km above mean sea level, tilting southwestwards with height.

The cyclonic circulation over North Konkan & neighbourhood now lies over North Madhya Maharashtra & neighbourhood and extends between 1.5 km & 2.1 km above mean sea level.

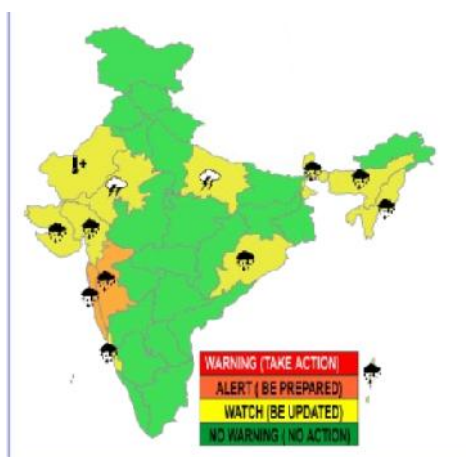
