1.0 Rainfall Situation

2.0 SYNOPTIC SITUATION: as per IMD dated: 14.06.2020

South West Monsoon has been advanced in the sub basins to the most parts of Pravara(G2), Upper Godavari (G1), Sabari (G12), Purna (G3) and some parts of Maneru (G6), Penganga (G7), Wardha(G8), Wainganga(G9) of Godavari Basin and entire Lower Krishna(K7), Musi(K10), Palleru(K11), Munneru(K12) of Krishna Basin and Lower Godavari(G10), Middle Godavary(G5) of Godavari basin.

The Southwest Monsoon further advanced into remaining parts of Central Arabian Sea, some parts of Gujarat state, remaining parts of Maharashtra (including Mumbai), some parts of Madhya Pradesh and most parts of Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Bihar.

The Northern Limit of Monsoon (NLM) now passes through Lat.20°N/Long.60°E, Lat.20°N/Long.70°E, Surat, Nandurbar, Betul, Seoni, Pendra Road, Ambikapur, Gaya, Patna and Lat.27°N/Long.85°E.

Conditions are becoming favourable for further advance of Southwest Monsoon into some parts of North Arabian Sea, some more parts of Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh, remaining parts of Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Bihar and some parts of East Uttar Pradesh during next 48 hours.

The cyclonic circulation over north Interior Odisha & neighbourhood now lies over East Madhya Pradesh & neighbourhood and extends between 3.1 to 7.6 km above mean sea level.

The trough at mean sea level from northwest Rajasthan to north Interior Odisha, now runs from northwest Rajasthan to coastal Odisha and extends upto 2.1 km above mean sea level.

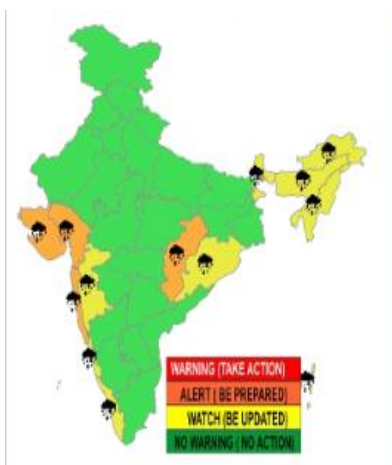
