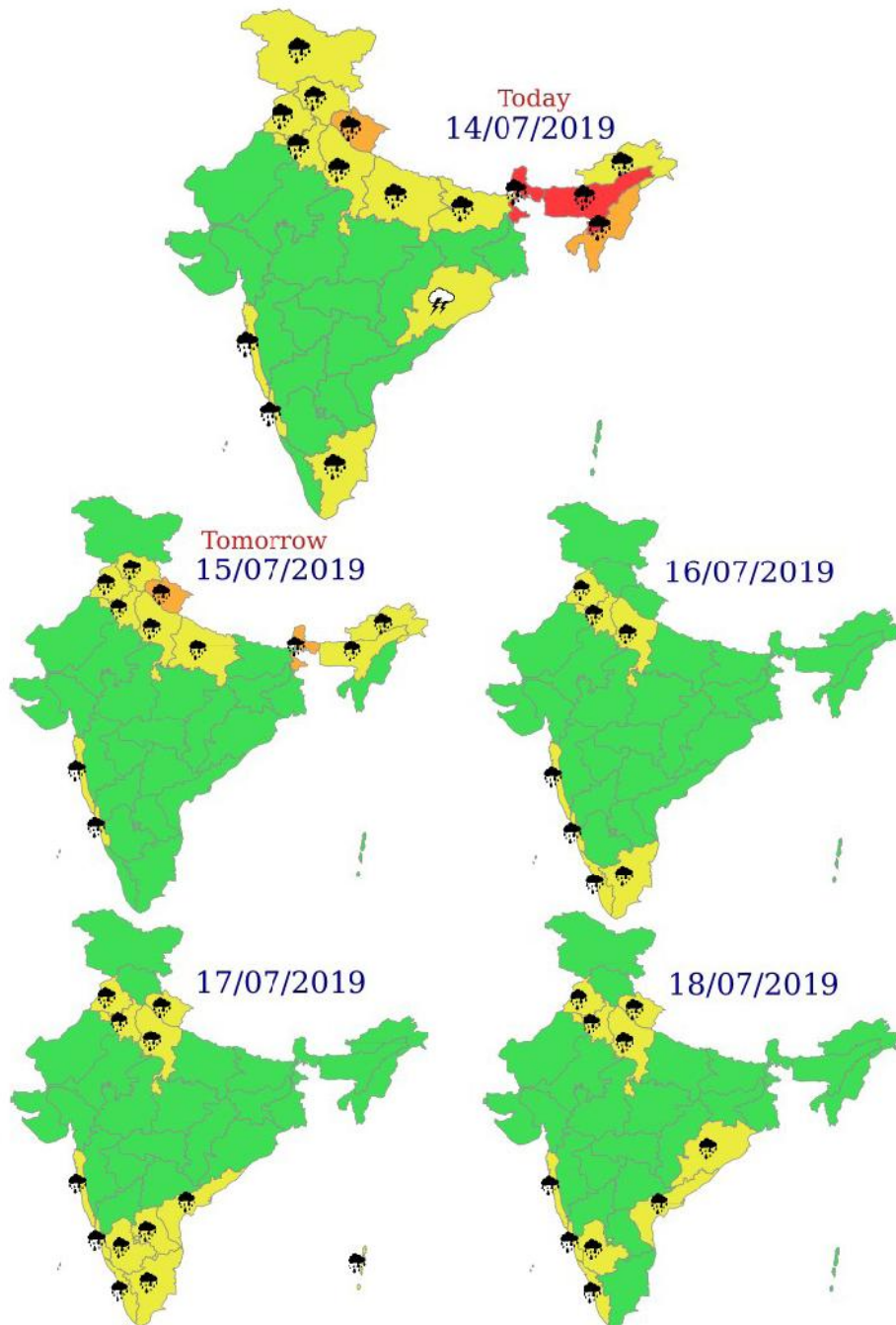
2.0 SYNOPTIC SITUATION: as per IMD dated: 14.07.2019
