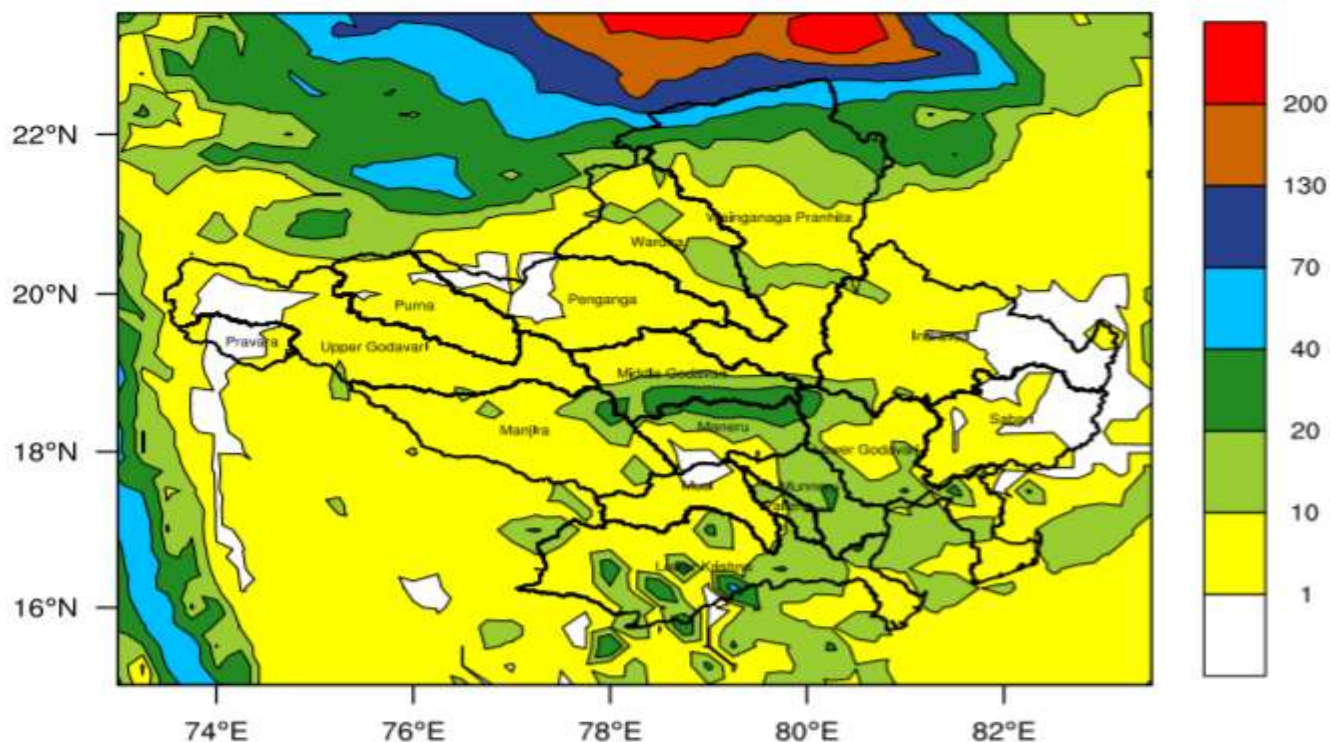

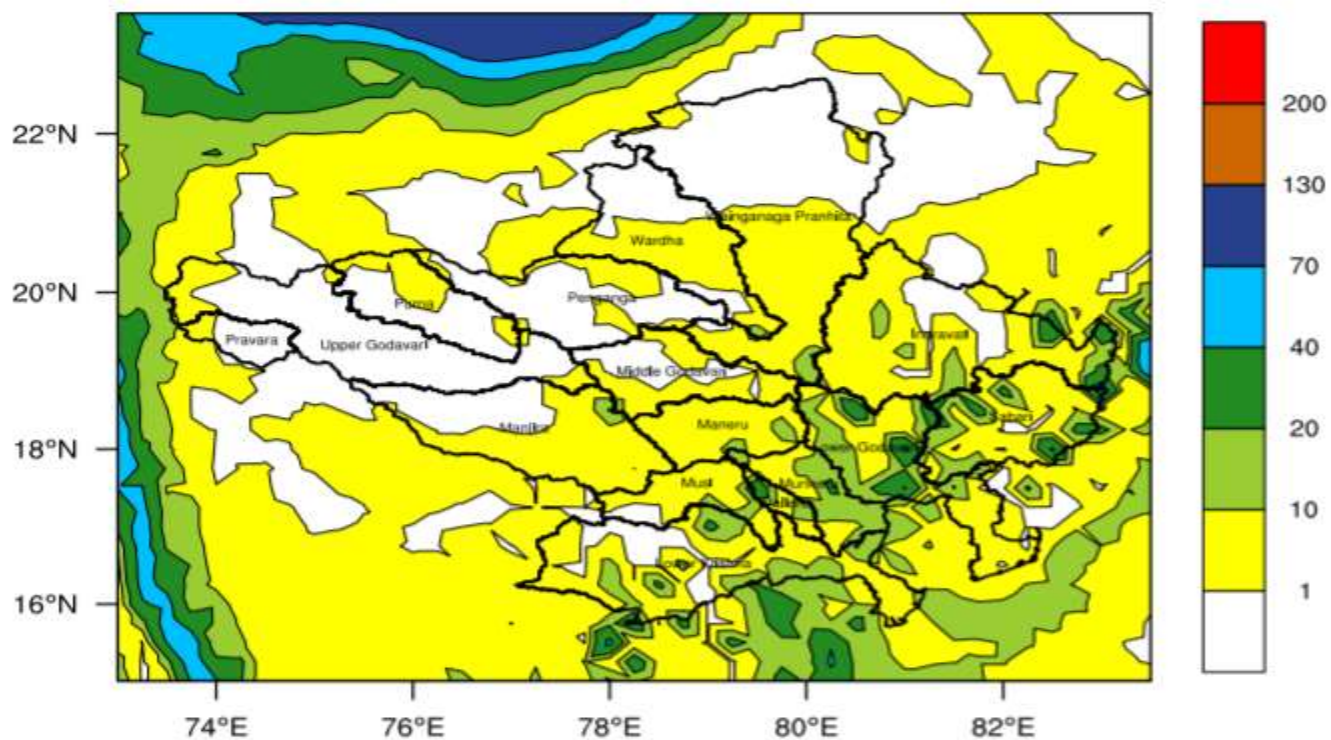

Heavy Rainfall warning as given by IMD for Godavari Basin is shown above. Moderate Rainfall is predicted Lower Godavari and Wainganga-Pranahita on Day1. Similarly on Day2 in Lower Godavari and Sabari sub Catchments moderate Rainfall is predicted. Due to heavy rainfall occurred today in the catchment of Wainganga-Pranahita and Wardha the water levels from Kaleswaram to Dowlaiswaram may rise during next two days so close watch may be kept.
