Light rainfall of (11-25) is predicted in PURNA, MANJIRA, MANERU, PENGANGA, WAINGANGA INDRAVATHI, SABARI, on day 1. UPPER GODAVARI, PRAVARA, PURNA, MIDDLE GODAVARI, MANERU, PENGANGA, WARDHA, LOWER GODAVARI, INDRAVATHI, SABARI on day 2.

Very light rainfall of (0.1-10mm) is predicted for all Subcatchments from Day 1 to Day 7 of Godavari Basin.
