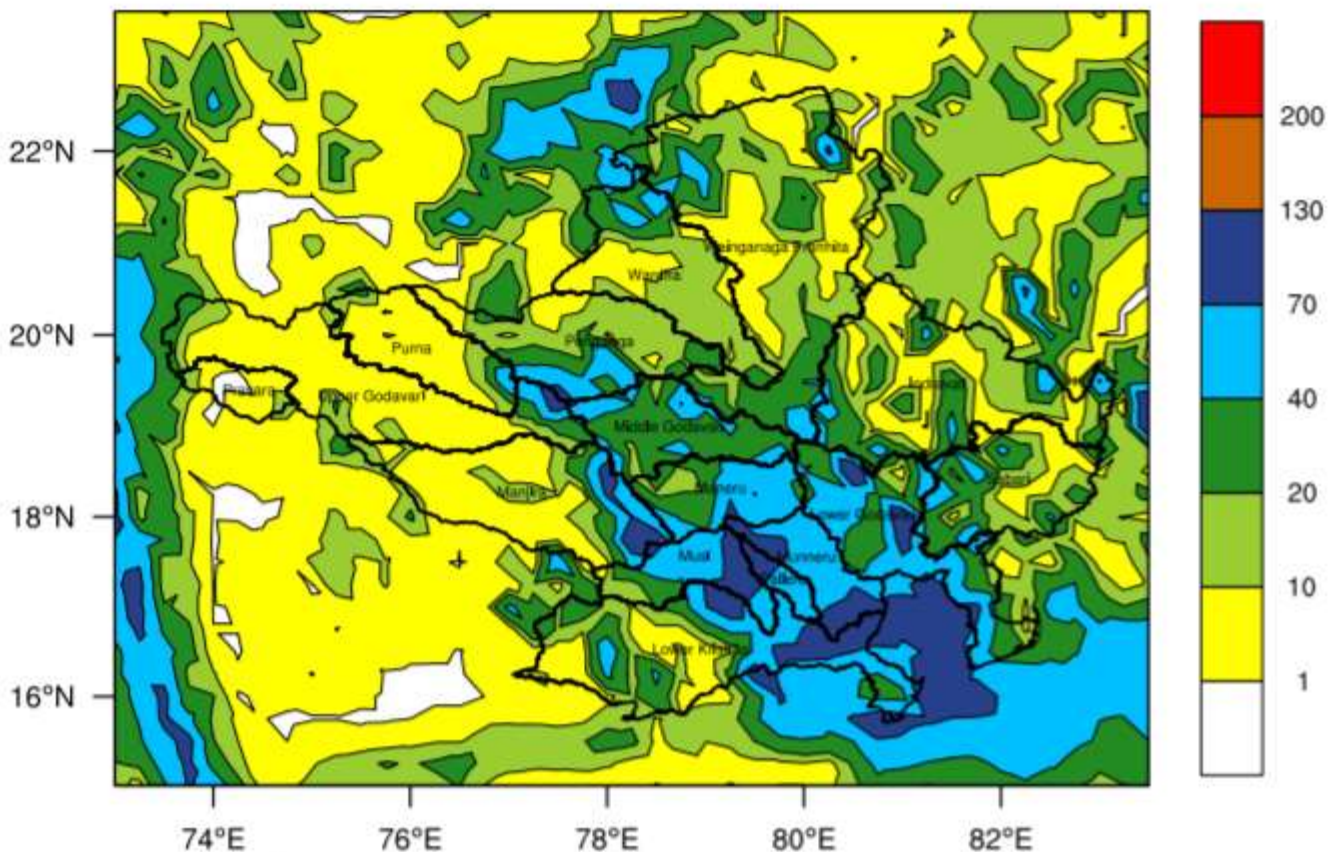

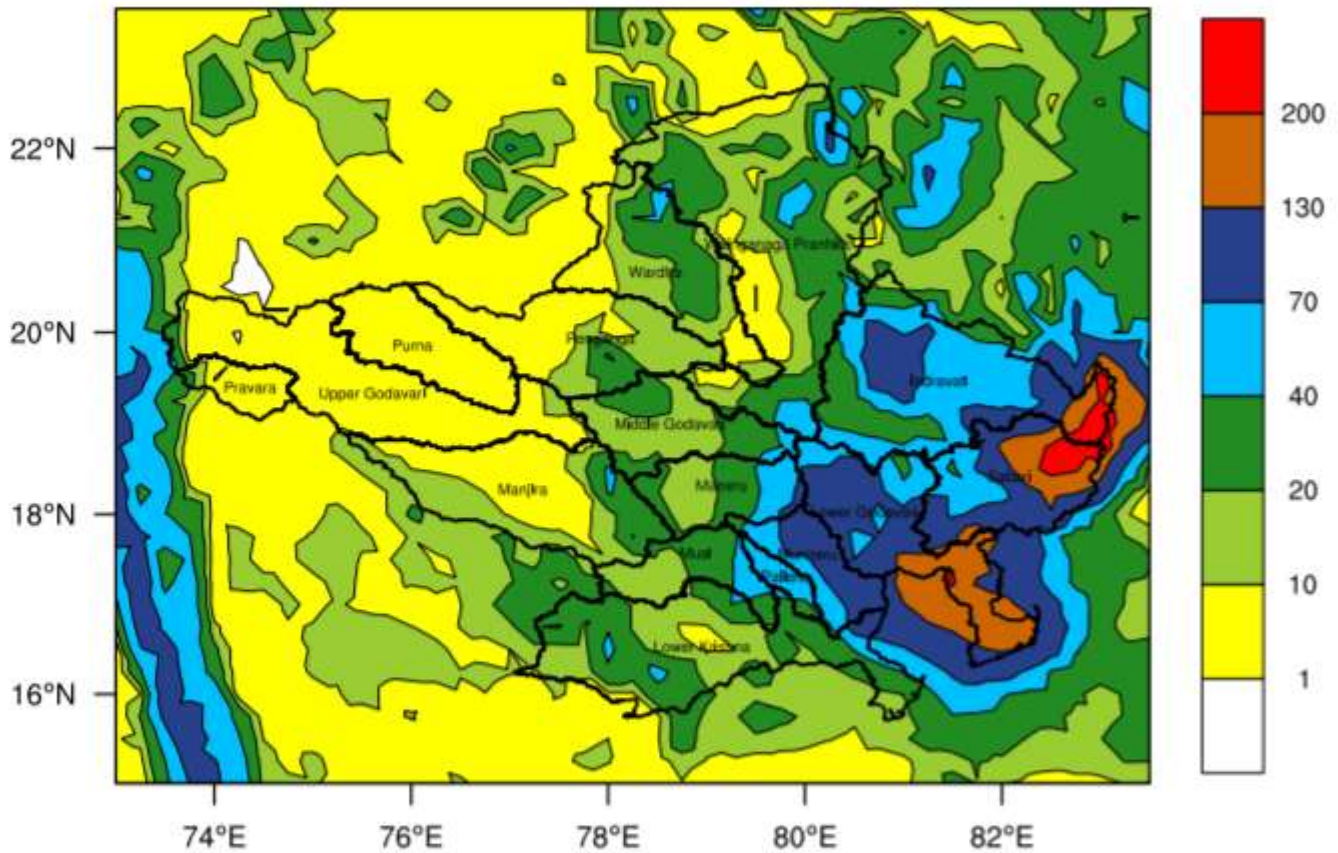

Manjira = 13 mm	Sabari = 123 mm
Middle Godavari = 21 mm	Upper Godavari = 4 mm
Munneru = 80 mm	Wainganga/Pranhita = 22 mm
Musi = 26 mm	Wardha = 17 mm

There is only light rain forecast for day one in entire Godavari Basin. Heavy Rain forecast for Indravati, Lower Godavari and Sabari on Day 2. All other sub catchments of Godavari may receive light rains only. Isolated Heavy Rainfall warning is given for Wainganga, Lower Godavari, Indravati & Sabari Sub catchment for tomorrow and Day after tomorrow. So water levels may rise in Indravati, Sabari basins from Day-2 onwards. So be alert and keep watch in Indravati and Sabari Sub Catchments.
