



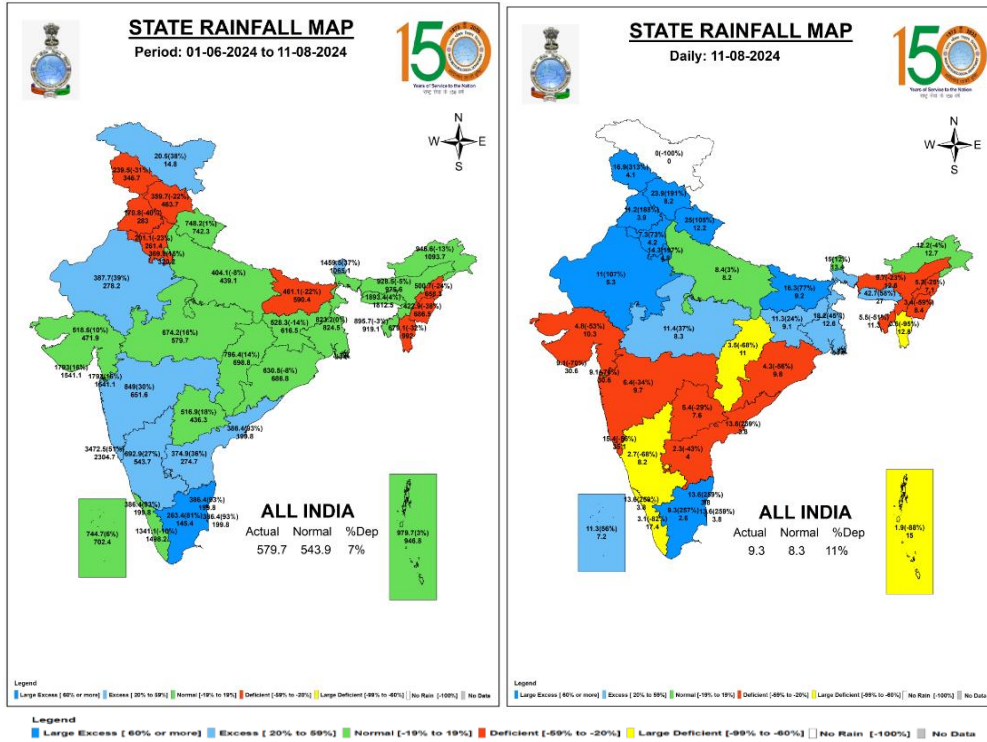

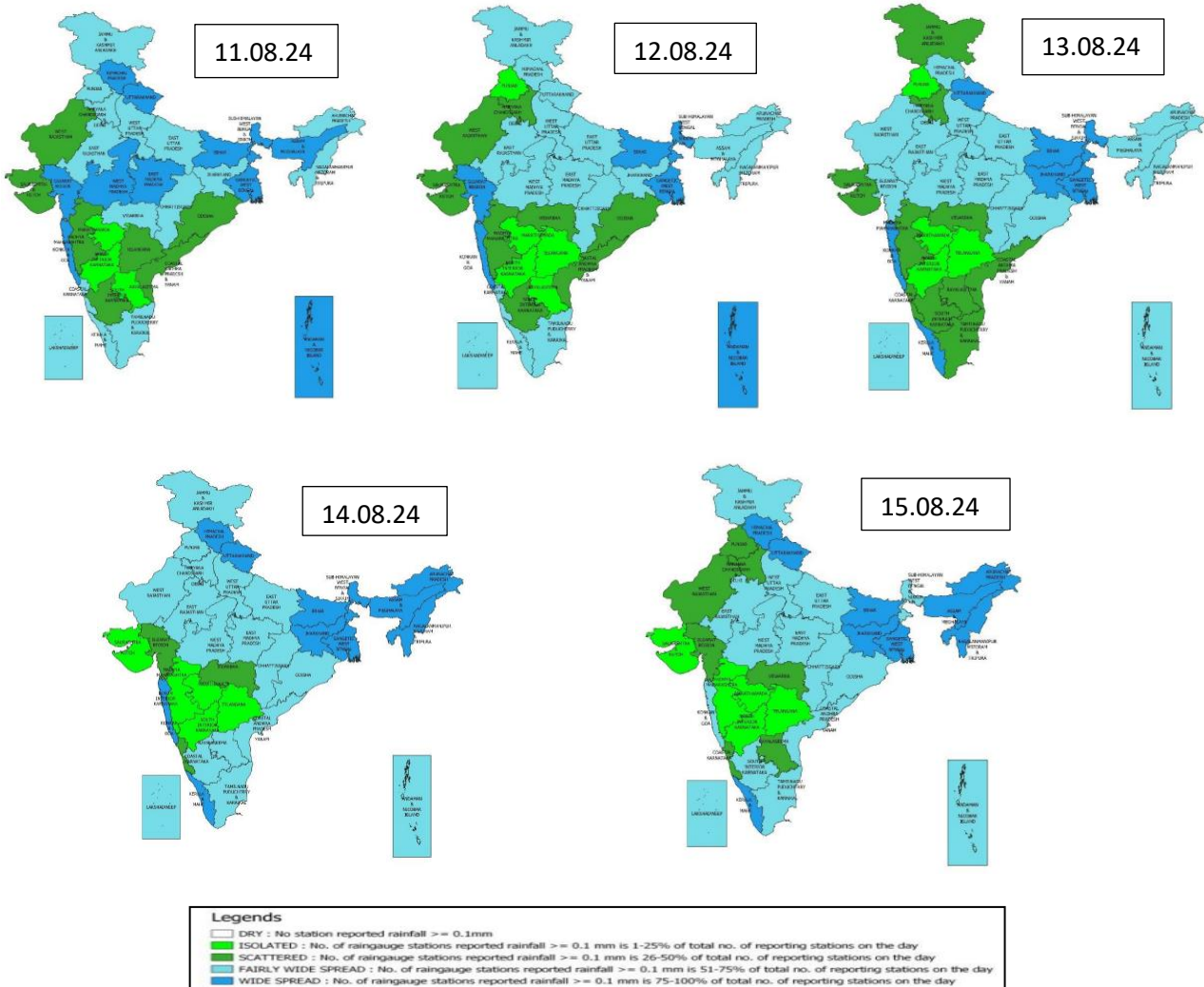

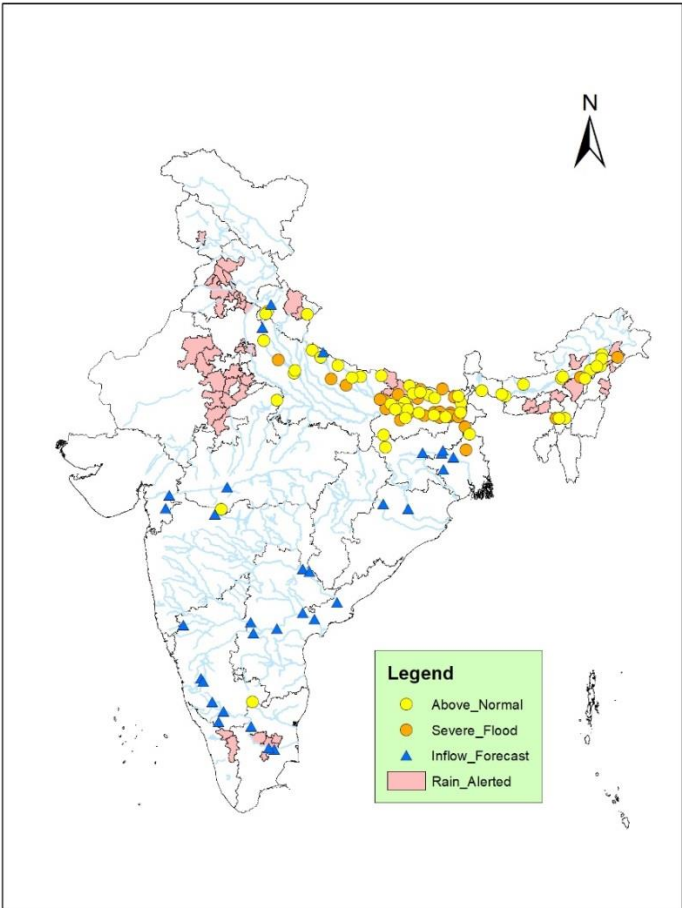
2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 11th August 2024, 21 Stations (12 in Bihar, 2 in Assam, 1 in Jharkhand & West Bengal and 5 in Uttar Pradesh) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 32 stations (13 in Assam, 12 in Bihar, 5 in Uttar Pradesh, 1 in Uttarakhand, 1 in West Bengal) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 31 dams and barrages (6 in Karnataka, 3 in Telangana, 5 in Andhra Pradesh, 3 in Tamilnadu , 2 in Uttar Pradesh, 2 in Gujarat, 1 in Madhya Pradesh, 2 in Odisha, 3 in Jharkhand, 1 in Maharashtra, 1 in Uttarakhand and 2 in West Bengal)

2.2 Flash Flood Guidance

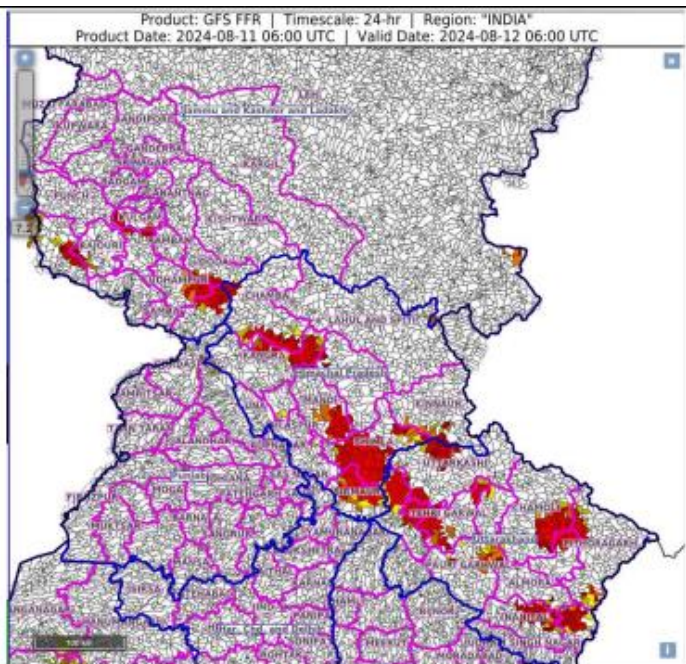
24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 12-08-2024 :

Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of **Himachal Pradesh** - Bilaspur, Chamba, Kangra, Kinnaur, Mandi, Shimla, Sirmaur and Solan districts.

Jammu & Kashmir & Ladakh - Doda, Kathua, Kulgam, Punch, Rajouri, Ramban, Riasi and Udhampur districts.

Uttarakhand - Bageshwar, Chamoli, Champawat, Dehradun, Nanital, Pauri Garhwal, Pithoragarh, Rudrapur, Tehri Garwal and Uttarkashi districts.

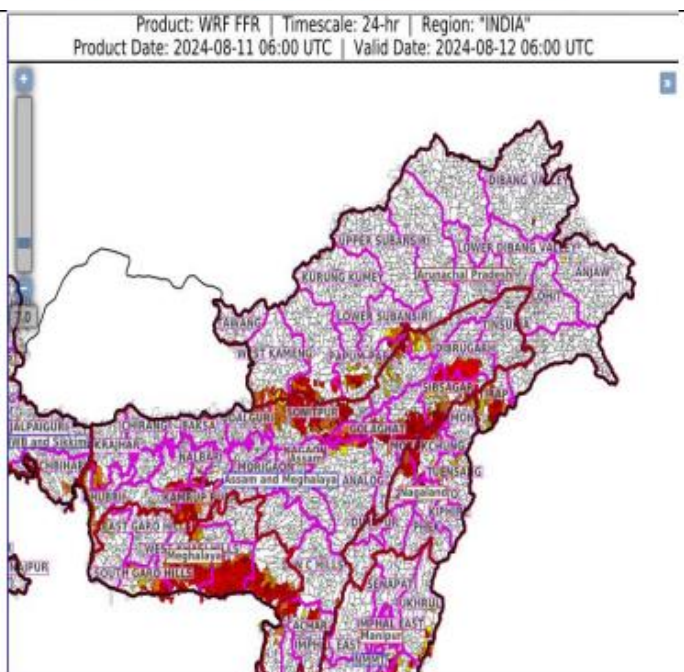


24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 12-08-2024 :

Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of **Assam & Meghalaya** - Barpeta, Cachar, Dibrugarh, Golaghat, Jorhat, Kamrup Rural, Nalbari, Sonitpur, East Khasi Hills, South Garo Hills, West Garo Hills, West Khasi Hills and Jaintia Hills districts.

NMMT - Longleng, Mokokchung, Mon and Tuensang districts of Nagaland.

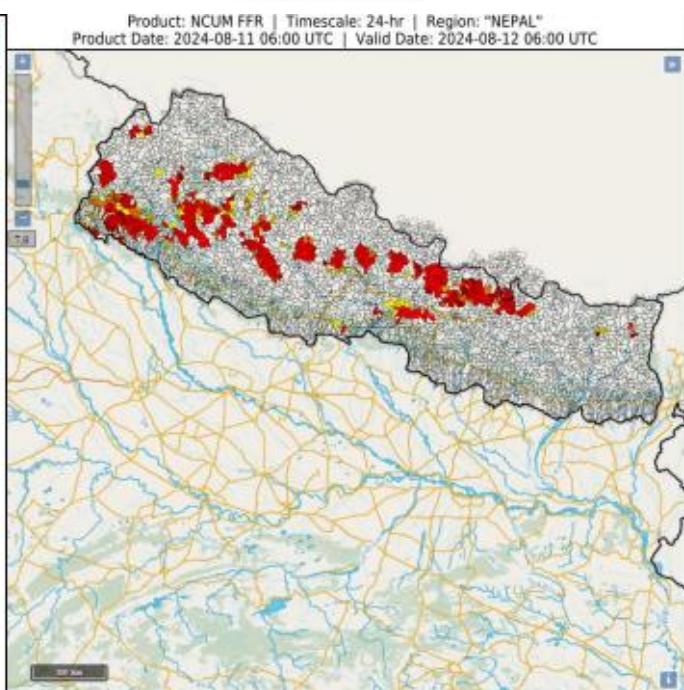

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.



2.3 CWC Advisories

Main Synoptic Situation and Rainfall Forecast (As per IMD)

- A cyclonic circulation lies over northeast Rajasthan & neighbourhood extending upto middle tropospheric levels. A trough runs from this cyclonic circulation to Bangladesh in lower tropospheric levels.
 - The Monsoon trough is near its normal position at mean sea level. It is likely to oscillate near its normal position during most days of the week.
 - Another trough runs from South Interior Karnataka to Comorin area in lower tropospheric levels.
 - Another cyclonic circulation over northeast Assam extending upto middle tropospheric levels.
1. Isolated very heavy rainfall also very likely over Punjab, Haryana-Chandigarh, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand on 11th and over East Rajasthan on 11th & 12th August.
 2. Very heavy rainfall also very likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh on 11th; Assam & Meghalaya on 11th& 12th; Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura on 11th & 14th, Bihar on 12th August.
 3. Extremely heavy rainfall also very likely at isolated places over Meghalaya on 11th August.
 4. Isolated very heavy rainfall also very likely over Tamil Nadu on 11th, 14th & 15th; Kerala & Mahe on 11th, 13th & 14th August.

Rajasthan

Water level rise is expected in Banas, Banganga, Chambal, Gambhir river and its tributaries for next 24 hrs.

Assam and Manipur

Water level rise is expected in rivers Dikhow, Bhogdai, Dhansiri, Kopili, Kalang, Buridihing, Dibru (Upper Brahmaputra) for next 24 hrs. Current flood situation in the state as per CWC network is as follows:

Water level rise is expected in Beas, Sutlej, Upper Yamuna, rivers and other small rivers in Kangra, Una districts for next 24 hrs.

Delhi and Haryana

Since IMD has predicted very heavy rainfall in Delhi and neighbourhood, alert may be kept for localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region. Caution is advised for probable disruption of traffic in due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time. It is also informed that Upper Yamuna has received heavy rainfall and outflow from Hathnikund Barrage (Yamunanagar dist.) is 1667 cumec (58870 cusec) (1600 hrs of 11.08.2024).

Kerala

Water level rise and flood like situation is expected in rivers such as Kuttyadi, Korapuzha, Kabini, Bhavani, Bharathapuzha and Periyar rivers for next 2 days.

Tamilnadu

Water level rise is expected in rivers such as Cauvery, Vellar and other small rivers in Selam, Kallakurichi, Thiruchirappalli, districts for next 2 days. Current flood situation in the state as per CWC network is as follows:

Gate No. 19 at Tungabhadra Dam has suffered a chain link breakage on 10.08.2024, and heavy releases done from Tungabhadra dam. Current outflow from the dam is 2521 cumec (1500 hrs of 11.08.24), and heavy inflows are expected into downstream projects such as Sunkesula Barraage, Srisailem projects and other projects situated downstream in Krishna river. Water level rise is expected in downstream districts such as Raichur, Bellary, Kurnool, Mahabubnagar and further downstream for next 2 days.
