


## **Central Water Commission Daily Flood Situation Report cum Advisories** 12-08-2021


#### 1.0 **Rainfall Situation**

Extremely Heavy Rainfall/ Very Heavy Rainfall over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal during 12th-14th August and Bihar and East Uttar Pradesh on 12th August.


## 2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 12th August, 2021, 27 Stations (16 in Bihar, 8 in Uttar Pradesh and 1 each in Assam, Jharkhand & West Bengal) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation and 26 stations (15 in Bihar, 8 in Uttar Pradesh and 3 in Assam) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 22 Barrages & Dams (7 in Karnataka, 4 in Jharkhand, 3 each in Andhra Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh & Tamil Nadu and 2 in West Bengal).

#### 2.2 CWC Advisories

### 2.2.1 Ganga basin- Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand & West Bengal

Due to combined effect of river runoff from Yamuna and northern tributaries of Ganga, main **Ganga** is flowing in severe flood situations from districts **Prayagraj** (**U.P**) to **Murshirabad** (**West Bengal**). From Praygraj to Varanasi Ganga river is in falling to steady state, where as from Varanasi and downstream, it is flowing with rising trend. Alert may be kept in districts **Prayagraj**, **Varanasi**, **Ghazipur** (**U.P**), **Buxar**, **Patna**, **Munger**, **Bhagalpur** (**Bihar**), **Sahibganj** (**Jharkhand**) & **Malda**, **Murshirabad** (**West Bengal**). Passing peak inflow will further increase the water level of main Ganga stem in Bihar in **next 2 to 3 days**.

In district Patna water levels in Ganga river is rising at the rate of 0.7 cm/hr and at site Dighaghat (CWC site) it is expected to reach 51.65 m by 08:00 hrs of 13.08.2021. Ganga at CWC site Hathidah is expected to cross HFL by morning of 13th August. Expected water level at 08:00 AM is 43.24 m.

Middle reaches of Ganga river in districts such as **Hapur**, **Badaun & Farrukhabad** (**Uttar Pradesh**) are in above normal flood situations. River **Ghaghra** in **Barabanki**, **Ayodhya & Ballia** (**Uttar Pradesh**) and **Siwan & Saran** (**Bihar**) districts are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. River Sone & Punpun are flowing in severe flood situation in Patna.

IMD has forecasted heavy rains over river Mahananda, Gandak, and Rapti in next 24 hrs. Alert may be kept in districts such as **Balarampur**, **Basti**, **Sant Kabir Nagar (U.P)**, **Paschim Champaran**, **Arariya**, **Kishanganj & Purnia (Bihar)**. Currently the flood originated in tributaries of Yamuna last week is passing through Ganga and it may take another 4 to 5 days to pass through completely; in such situation further runoff created due to intense rainfall in the catchments of north tributaries of Ganga may not streamed into Ganga easily. The flooding situation in districts such as **Ballia (U.P) & Praygraj**, **Saran**, **Bhagalpur**, **Katihar (Bihar)** may get accentuated.

Currently River Kosi in Supaul, Khagaria & Katihar districts, River Bagmati in Sitamarhi, Muzzafarpur & Darbhanga districts, River Gandak in Gopalganj & Vaishali districts, River Adhwara in Darbhanga District, Rivers Kamla & Kamlabalan in Madhubani district, River Burhi Gandak in Samastipur & Khagaria districts, River Parman in Araria, River Mahananda in Purnia district are flowing in severe to above normal flood situations.

#### 2.2.2 Yamuna and its Tributaries - Uttar Pradesh

Hydrological situation in Yamuna are gradually returning back to normal. In main Yamuna, water levels in districts such as **Jalaun**, **Hamirpur & Banda** are in above normal flood situation with decreasing trend and in **Praygraj** it is flowing in severe flood situation with decreasing trend.

Panchana (Karauli dist.) and RanapratapSagar (Chittorgarh dist.) dams of Rajasthan are having high storages; hence releases from these dams may be done as per SOP by informing downstream Districts of lower riparian states.

# 2.2.3 Brahmaputra, Barak and its tributaries - Assam, West Bengal, Sikkim & Meghalaya

IMD has predicted very heavy rains in the catchment of Brahmaputra and its tributaries in 3 to 4 days, hence, alert may be kept in West Bengal, Assam, Sikkim, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh & Nagaland mainly in districts Kokrajhar, Chirang, Barpeta (Assam) and South – West Khasi hills & East Khasi hills, South & East Garo hills, East & West Jaintia hills (Meghayala), whole Sikkim state, Changlang, Papumpara, Lower Subansiri, Upper Siang, Lower Bibang Valley (Arunachal Pradesh) & Phek (Nagaland). Alert to be kept in the basins of Gurang, Manas, Teesta, Raidak, Jaldhaka, Rangpochu, Rangit, Torsa, Beki, Pagladiya, Puthimari rivers and in all other tributaries of Brahmaputra.

Currently river JiaBharali in **Sonitpur** district is flowing in severe flood situation. River Beki in **Barpeta** district, river Brahmaputra in Dibrugarh & Jorhat districts are flowing above normal flood situation.


#### 2.3 Flash Flood Guidance

IMD has issued flash flood risk over few watersheds and neighbourhoods of East Uttar Pradesh, Bihar adjoining Sub-Himalayan West Bengal (SHWB) & Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh met subdivisions.

# 36 hours Flash Flood Risk (FFR) Outlook Till 2330 IST of 13.08.2021:

Moderate Risk likely over few watersheds and neighborhoods of East UP, Bihar adjoining SHWB & Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh met subdivisions in next 36 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & lowlying areas over AoC as depicted in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 36 hours.



3.0 Storage Position in Dams where Inflow forecast is being issued by CWC as on 12<sup>th</sup>August2021
Reservoirs shown in red are having gross storage capacity more than 80% and those in orange are having gross storage greater than 60%. Close watch is to be maintained at these reservoirs whenever Very Heavy Rainfall (Orange) and Extremely Heavy Rainfall (Red) warning in next 120 hours are given below:

Note- Based on above information, Project Authority may regulate the reservoirs as per standard operating manuals/ rule levels to avoid downstream flooding and upstream submergence.
