




2.0 Flood Situation and Advisories


2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 13th July 2024, 19 Stations (9 in Bihar, 6 in Assam and 4 in Uttar Pradesh) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 28 stations (11 in Assam 7 in Bihar, 5 in Uttar Pradesh, 4 in West Bengal & 1 in Sikkim) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 5 dams and barrages in Karnataka.

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 14-07-2024 :

Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of Southern parts of Gujarat Region, Konkan & Goa, Coastal Karnataka & adjoining SI Karnataka Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 14-07-2024:






24 hours Flash Flood Risk (FFR) Outlook till 0600 UTC of 14.07.2024:

Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighborhoods of Central Nepal (as shown in adjacent map) during next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.







2.3 CWC Advisories

Main Synoptic Features and Very Heavy Rainfall (as per IMD)

- The Monsoon trough is north of its normal position at mean sea level.
- The off-shore trough runs along south Gujarat-north Kerala coasts at mean sea level.
- A cyclonic circulation over East Bihar and another over northeast Assam & a trough runs from northeast Assam to northwest Bay of Bengal in lower tropospheric levels.
- 1. Isolated very heavy rainfall also likely over Konkan & Goa, Kerala, Coastal & South Interior Karnataka, Ghat regions of Madhya Maharashtra during 13th-17th and Gujarat State on 16th & 17th July.
- 2. Isolated very heavy rainfall also likely over Nagaland on 14th and Odisha during 15th-17th July.

Gujarat

Increased water levels is expected in Ambika, Purna (Surat dist.), Damanganga (Valsad dist.) for 24 hrs. Increased inflow expected into Madhuban dam.

Assam

Water level is expected to fall in rivers of Lower Brahamputra, Middle and Upper Brahamputra for next 24 hrs. Current flood situation in the state as per CWC network is as follows:
