




## 2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 14<sup>th</sup>August 2023, 23 station (10 in Bihar, 5 in Assam, 4 in Uttar Pradesh, 2 in Uttarakhand and 1 each in Jharkhand & West Bengal) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 35 stations (11 each in Uttar Pradesh & Bihar, 10 in Assam and 2 in West Bengal & 1 in Uttarakhand) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 9 Dams and Barrages (3 in Uttar Pradesh and 2 each in Karnataka, Tamilnadu & Uttarakhand).

#### 2.2 CWC Advisories

#### **Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh**

As per IMD very heavy to extremely heavy rainfall are expected to continue in districts of **Dehradun**, **Haridwar**, **Tehri Grahwal**, **Pauri Grahwal**, **Nainital**, **Champawat and Udham Singh Nagar** for next 24 hours. Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Sharda, Ramganga, Alaknanda, Tons and rivers of upper Yamuna and other small rivers over the region. Yesterday's extremely heavy rains Dehradun and adjoining areas has triggered flood wave in upper Ganga, Bhagirathi 1, Alaknanda etc. As per CWC network sites Devprayag (Tehri Grahwal dist., Bhagirathi 1 river), Rishikesh (Dehradun, Ganga stem), Haridwar (Ganga stem river) are in severe flood situation. Projects such as Tehri dam (Tehri Garhwal dist) and projects of adjoining Uttar Pradesh such as Ch. Charan Singh Madhya Ganga barrage are getting increased inflow. It is expected that the flood wave created in Uttarakhand regions of Ganga will be travelling downstream in the coming 2 to 4 days and water level rise is expected in main Ganga in districts Bijnor, Hapur, Buland Shahar, Budaun, Farrukhabad districts and severe flood situations is expected in Hapur, Budaun, Farukkabad districts. #### Himachal Pradesh, New Delhi

As per IMD very heavy to extremely heavy rainfall are expected to continue in districts. Kangra, Una, Hamirpur, Mandi, Bilaaspur, Solan, Shimla, Sirmaur, Chamba and Kullu for next 24 hours. Hence rivers such as Tons, rivers of upper Yamuna, Beas, Satiuj, Ravi and their tributaries are expected to get increased runoff. Yesterday's very heavy rains has triggered flood wave in Yamuna and expected water level at Yamuna at CWC site Delhi Railway bridge will rise to Above normal flood situation by 15.08.2023.

# Bihar



Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of Uttarakhand Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.


