


Central Water Commission Flood Situation Report cum Advisories 18-10-2021

1.0 Rainfall Situation

1.1 Significant Amount of Rainfall & Basin wise departure from normal of daily rainfall

Significant Rainfall Amount recorded (0830 hrs IST of yesterday to 0830 hrs IST of today) (10 cm or more):



- West Madhya Pradesh: Sheopur-31, Datia-17, Shivpuri-15, Bhind-14, Rajgarh, Sehore-11, Guna, Gwalior-10
- Odisha: Balasore-21, Mayurbhanj-13, Cuttack-11
- Uttarakhand: Champawat-16, Nainital-10
- East Rajasthan: Baran-16, Karauli-13
- Gangetic West Bengal: East Midnapore-12; South 24 Parganas, West Midnapore-11 each
- Kerala & Mahe: Thrissur-13, Ernakulam-11
 East Madhya Pradesh: Tikamgarh-10
- Tamilnadu: Coimbatore-11

- Very Heavy Rainfall over East Uttar Pradesh, West Madhya Pradesh, Gangetic West Bengal and Odisha on 18th;
 over Uttarakhand and Bihar on 19th; Sub-Himalayan West Bengal on 20th, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya
 on 19th & 20th October, 2021



2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network


On 18th October, 2021, as per daily bulletin (Mid-day):

- 11 stations (5 in Kerala, 3 in Tamilnadu, 2 in Karnataka and 1 in Odisha) is flowing in Severe Flood Situation.
- 11 stations (4 in Kerala, 2 each in Bihar & Tamilnadu and 1 each in Assam, Madhya Pradesh & Uttar Pradesh) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation.
- Inflow Forecast has been issued for 14 Barrages & Dams (3 each in Andhra Pradesh & Jharkhand, 2 each in Karnataka, Maharashtra
 & West Bengal and 1 each in Tamilnadu & Telangana)

2.2 CWC Advisories


2.2.1 Uttarakhand

Water level rise is expected in rivers Sarda, Yamuna, Ganga, Alaknanda, Ramganga, Gori &Kali. Alert may be kept in all districts of Uttarakhand. Heavy rainfall may be associated with landslides and flash floods also. 24-hr outlook for flash floods issued by IMD is as below.

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1730 IST of 19.10.2021:

High Risk likely over few watersheds and neighborhoods of Uttarakhand met subdivisions in next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.



2.2.2 Himachal Pradesh

Extremely heavy rains can cause the water level rise in Satiuj, Beas, Ravi, Spiti & Tons, etc and its tributaries. It may also be associated with landslides and flash floods. Alert may be sounded for districts Lahul & Spiti, Kangra, Kullu, Shimla, Solan, etc.

2.2.3 West flowing rivers from Tadri to Kanyakumari - Kerala

Currently all flood affected rivers are in steady to falling conditions. Severe flood situation exist in rivers such as Manimala, Achankovil (**Pathanamthitta** dist.), Kallada (**Kollam** dist.), Neyyar, Karamana (**Trivandrum** dist.). Above normal flood situation exist in river Gayatri (**Trichur** dist.), Pamba (**Pathanamthitta** dist.).

2.2.3 Odisha and West Bengal

Water level of east flowing rivers in West Bengal & Odisha may rise due to heavy rainfall forecast for that region. Alert may be kept in districts **Mayurbhanj**, **Balasore** (Odisha); **Purba Medinipur**, **Howrah**, **North & South 24 Paragnas** (West Bengal).

1.0 Storage Position in Dams where Inflow forecast is being issued by CWC as on 18th October, 2021

Reservoirs shown in red are having gross storage capacity more than 90% and those in orange are having gross storage greater than 75%. Close watch is to be maintained at these reservoirs whenever Very Heavy Rainfall (Orange) and Extremely Heavy Rainfall (Red) warning in next 120 hours are given below:
