


1.0 Rainfall Situation


2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 19thAugust 2023, 1 station in Uttar Pradesh is flowing in Extreme Flood Situation.12 stations (7 in Bihar, 3 in Uttar Pradesh,1 each in Assam and Jharkhand) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 28 stations (9 each in Assam and Bihar, 8 in Uttar Pradesh and 1 each in Odisha and West Bengal) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 12 Dams and Barrages (4 in Telangana, 3 each in Uttar Pradesh & Tamil Nadu and 1 each in Odisha & Uttarakhand).

2.2 CWC Advisories

Madhya Pradesh

Due to the presence of LPA over north Chhattisgarh and neighbourhood rainfall is expected to very heavy in M.P, so keep alert for water level rise in river Narmada in **Hoshangabad**, **Betul**, **Khandwa**, **Chhindwara** dists.; river Tapi in **Betul** dist.; Wainganaga in **Seoni**, **Chhindwara** dists.

Himachal Pradesh

As per IMD very heavy rainfall are expected in districts Kangra, Mandi, Bilaaspur, Solan, Shimla, Sirmaur for next 24 hours. Hence rivers such as Tons, rivers of upper Yamuna, Beas, Satluj, Ravi and their tributaries are expected to get increased runoff.

Maharashtra

Due to existence of Low pressure Area over north Chhattisgarh and neighbourhood, IMD has predicted increased rainfall over districts such as **Chandrapur**, **Nagpur** hence keep alert for water level rise in rivers such as Wardha, Wainganga and their tributaries in the said regions. Releases from projects may be done as per SOP after informing lower riparian regions.




