





2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 23rd August 2024, 22 Stations (10 in Bihar, 7 in Uttar Pradesh, 2 in Assam and 1 each in Tripura, Jharkhand & West Bengal) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 19 stations (10 in Bihar, 03 each in Uttar Pradesh & Assam, 2 in Uttarakhand & 1 in West Bengal) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 28 Dams and barrages (5 in Andhra Pradesh, 3 each in Telangana, Uttar Pradesh & Tamil Nadu, 2 each in Odisha, Jharkhand, West Bengal, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat & Uttarakhand and 1each in Karnataka & Maharashtra)

Flood Situation Map









2.3 CWC Advisories

Main Synoptic features and Rainfall Forecast (As per IMD)

- The low pressure area persisted over east central Arabian sea off Maharashtra coast at 1430 hrs IST of today, 23rd August 2024 with associated cyclonic circulation extending upto lower tropospheric level tilting southwestwards with height. It is likely to weaken during next 12 hours.
- The other low pressure area persisted over northern parts of West Bengal and adjoining areas of northeast Jharkhand at 1430 hrs IST of today, 23rd August 2024 with associated cyclonic circulation extending upto middle tropospheric levels. It is likely to move nearly westwards towards Jharkhand during next 24 hours.
- A cyclonic circulation lies over north Bay of Bengal at 5.8 km above mean sea level.
- 1. Isolated very heavy rainfall also very likely over East Rajasthan on 25th & 26th August.
- 2. Isolated very heavy rainfall also very likely over Chhattisgarh on 23rd , 24th; Konkan & Goa during 23rd 26th; Gujarat State during 23rd 28th; Madhya Maharashtra , Madhya Pradesh during 24th 26th; Vidarbha on 24th; August.
- 3. Isolated extremely heavy rainfall also very likely over Gujarat Region during 24th 26th; Saurashtra & Kutch during 26th & 27th; West Madhya Pradesh on 25th August.
- 4. Isolated very heavy rainfall also very likely over Bihar on 23rd; Jharkhand on 23rd, 25th; Odisha on 23rd & 24th; Gangetic West Bengal during 23rd-25th; Meghalaya, Mizoram during 24th 26th August.
- 5. Isolated extremely heavy rainfall also very likely over Tripura, Mizoram on 25th August.

Madhya Pradesh

Water level rise is expected in rivers Mahi, Tapi, Narmada, Wainganga, Chambal, Kalisindh, Sindh and other rivers in Seoni, Chhindwara, Balaghat, Betul, Harda, Burhanpur, Khargone, Barwani, Sehore, Dewas, Indore, Dhar, Jhabua, Ratlam, Mandsaur, Ujjain, Agar – Malwa, Shajapur, Rajgarh, Guna, Shivpuri, Sheopar Kalan districts for the next two days. Increased runoff is expected in Ken river in districts Panna, Chhatarpur, Damoh, Sagar districts for the next 24 hrs. Current flood situation in the state as per CWC network is as follows:

Gujarat

Water level rise is expected in rivers Mahi, Sabarmati, Panam, Lower Tapi, Lower Narmada, Damanganga, Ambika, Purna and other rivers in districts Surat, Baruch, Panchmahal, Mahisagar, Aravalli, Sabar kantha, Ahmedabad, Valsad, Navsari, Dangs, Tapi, Narmada districts for next two days. Increased runoff is expected in Shetrunji, Kalubhar, Ghela and other rivers in Surendranagar, Bhavnagar, Amreli districts for next two days.

Maharashtra and Dadar & Nagar Haveli

Water level rise is expected in Upper Bhima, Nira and other tributaries of Krishna in Pune Satar districts for the next two days. Increased runoff is also expected into Vaitarna, Ulhas, Amba, Vashisti, Kajvi, Savitri and other small rivers in Nandurbar, Nashik, Palghar, Thane, Raigad, Ratnagiri districts for the next two days. Dams may be operated as per SOP and releases may be done after informing downstream areas.

Tripura

Water level is expected to fall along rivers Manu, Gumti, Longai, Deo, Dhalai, Khowai, Hoari, Muhari, Juri, Feni, Burima and other rivers in all districts of Tripura for the next 24 hrs. Current flood situation in the state as per CWC network is as follows:
