





2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 24th August 2023, 7 stations (3 in Uttar Pradesh & 2 each in Bihar & Assam) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 32 stations (11 in Assam, 10 in Uttar Pradesh, 8 in Bihar, 2 in West Bengal & 1 in Jharkhand) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 15 Dams and Barrages (4 in Uttar Pradesh, 2 each in Telangana, Tamilnadu & Uttarakhand & 1 each in Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh & Odisha).

2.2 CWC Advisories

Sub Himalayan West Bengal

Very heavy rains are expected in **Jalpaiguri**, **Alipurduar**, **Coochbehar** districts and in **Sikkim** hence keep alert for water level rise in Torsa, Jaldhaka, Raidak rivers and their tributaries in above said districts. Current flood situation in the state as per CWC network is as follows:

Uttar Pradesh

Under the effect of very heavy rains occurred over West Uttar Pradesh in last 24 hours, Kali river (Trib.of Ganga) at CWC site Atrauli in **Aligarh** district is flowing in <u>Extreme flood situation</u>. In districts Bijnor, Hapur, Buland Shahar, Budaun, Farukkabhad, the water level at Ganga main stem is in rising condition. Bihar

As per IMD provided synoptic situation, model outputs and forecast, rainfall is expected to rise over Nepal, adjoining U.P and Bihar. Very heavy rainfall is expected in districts **East & West Champaran**, **Sitamarhi**, **Purnea**, **Kishanganj and Kathihar**. Keep alert for water level rise in northern tributaries of Ganga such as Gandak, Burhi Gandak, Adhwara, Bagmati, Kosi, Mahananda and other small rivers in above said districts. Assam

Due to increased rainfall in Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya and in districts **Dhubri, Kokrajhar, Chirang, Bongaigaon, Barpeta, Baksa,** water level rise is expected in northern tributaries of Brahamputra in above said districts and in main Brahamputra in Middle and lower regions. Currently due to yesterday's rainfall in above said regions, water levels at most of the



2.3 Flash Flood Guidance

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 25-08-2023 :

Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of SHWB & Sikkim and adjoining Assam & Meghalaya and Southern & Eastern parts of Arunachal Pradesh Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.
