


1.0 **Rainfall Situation**

1.2 Rainfall forecast for next 5 days issued on 26th August, 2021 (Midday) by IMD



Extremely heavy/very heavy rainfall over East Uttar Pradesh on 26th; over Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam & Meghalaya and Arunachal Pradesh on 26th -27th August; over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe during 28th - 30th August; over Coastal & South Interior Karnataka on 29th & 30th August, 2021.

2.0 Flood Situation and Advisories


2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 26th August, 2021, 29 Stations (17 in Bihar, 5 in Uttar Pradesh, 4 in Assam and 1 each in Arunachal Pradesh, Jharkhand & West Bengal) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation and 25 stations (10 in Bihar, 8 in Assam, 5 in Uttar Pradesh and 2 in West Bengal) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 10 Barrages & Dams (2 each in Andhra Pradesh, Tamilnadu & Uttar Pradesh and 1 each in Karnataka, Jharkhand, Odisha & West Bengal)

2.2 CWC Advisories

2.2.1 Ganga basin- Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand & West Bengal

Very heavy to Extremely Heavy rainfall is forecasted for Eastern Uttar Pradesh and Bihar in the next 2 days. Hence there is likelihood of rise in water levels in rivers such as Ghaghra & Rapti in Uttar Pradesh. Also, due to heavy rainfall in Nepal and North Bihar, levels of rivers in Gandak, Kosi etc. are expected to rise.

Main Ganga river is flowing in above normal to severe flood situations in districts Patna & Bhagalpur (Bihar), Sahibganj (Jharkhand) & Murshirabad (West Bengal) with falling trends.

River Ghaghra is flowing above Danger Level in **Barabanki**, **Ayodhya**, **Ballia** (**Uttar Pradesh**) and **Siwan** (**Bihar**) districts. River Rapti is flowing in severe to above normal flood situations in **Balrampur**, **Siddharth Nagar & Gorakhpur districts** (**U.P.**).

Currently, River Kosi in Supaul, Khagaria & Katihar (Bihar), River Punpun in Patna, River Bagmati in Sitamarhi, Muzzafarpur & Darbhanga (Bihar), River Gandak in Kushinagar (U.P.), Gopalganj & Muzaffarpur (Bihar), River Parman in Araria (Bihar), River Adhwara in Darbhanga, Rivers Kamla & Kamlabalan in Madhubani, River Burhi Gandak in Muzaffarpur, Samastipur & Khagaria, River Mahananda in Kishanganj, Purnia & Katihar in Bihar are flowing in severe to above normal flood situations.

Alert may be kept in districts Siddharth Nagar, Sant Kabirnagar in Uttar Pradesh, Paschim Champaran & Kishanganj Districts in Bihar.

2.2.2 Brahmaputra and its tributaries, Barak and Others - Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & North West Bengal

Due to forecasted heavy to very heavy/extremely heavy rainfall in Upper and Middle Brahmaputra basin, river levels in Brahmaputra and its tribuatries such as Teesta, Sankosh, Jaldhaka, Torsa, Manas, Beki, Raidak, Aie, Pagaladiya, Puthimari, Dhansiri are expected to rise in next 2 to 3 days.

Due to past 4 to 5 days rainfall, Brahmaputra Main River is flowing in above normal flood situations to severe flood situations in **Dibrugarh**, **Jorhat**, **Sonitpur**, **Goalpara**, **Kamrup & Dhubri** districts (Assam). Also tributaries of Brahmaputra namely Beki river in **Barpeta** district, Jia-Bharali river in **Sonitpur** and Sankosh river in **Dhubri** (Assam); Torsa river in **Coochbihar**, Teesta river in **Jalpaiguri** (West Bengal); Siang river in **East Siang** (Arunachal Pradesh) are flowing in above normal flood situations to severe flood situations.

Alert may be kept in districts Chirang, Kokrajhar & Baksa in Assam, South & East Sikkim, Upper Siang, East Siang and Lower Subansiri in Arunachal Pradesh.

2.2.3 Krishna basin-Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka

Most of the dams in Upper Krishna Basin are having very high storages. Almatti (100%), Narayanpur (97%), Malaprabha (96%), Bhadra (98%), Ghataprabha (100%) and Tungabhadra (99%) dams are more than 95% filled up. Dams P. D. Jurala, Srisailam, Koyna, Warna, Musi & Veer are also having high storages (more than 80%). Round the clock watch has to be maintained for proper reservoir operation. Releases from any of these reservoirs may be done as per rule curve and standard operating procedure by prior informing the lower riparian areas.

2.3. Flash Flood Guidance

IMD has issued flash flood risk over few watersheds and neighborhood of Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam & Meghalaya and Arunachal Pradesh met subdivisions.



24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 27.08.2021:

Moderate Risk over few watersheds and neighborhood of Uttarakhand met subdivision in next 24 hours.

3.0 Storage Position in Dams where Inflow forecast is being issued by CWC as on 26th August, 2021

Reservoirs shown in red are having gross storage capacity more than 80% and those in orange are having gross storage greater than 60%. Close watch is to be maintained at these reservoirs whenever Very Heavy Rainfall (Orange) and Extremely Heavy Rainfall (Red) warning in next 120 hours are given below:
