

1.0 Rainfall Situation


1.1 Basin wise departure from normal of cumulative and daily rainfall

2.0 Flood Situation and Advisories


2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 27th August, 2021, 34 Stations (19 in Bihar, 7 in Uttar Pradesh, 5 in Assam and 1 each in Arunachal Pradesh, Jharkhand & West Bengal) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation and 24 stations (11 in Assam, 8 in Bihar, 3 in Uttar Pradesh and 2 in West Bengal) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 13 Barrages & Dams (3 each in Tamilnadu & Uttar Pradesh, 2 each in Andhra Pradesh & Jharkhand and 1 each in Karnataka, Odisha & West Bengal)

2.2 CWC Advisories

2.2.1 Ganga Basin Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand & West Bengal

2.2.1.1 Uttarakhand

Water level in rivers Bhagirathi, Alaknanda, Mandakini, Ganga, Ramganga, Sharda, etc. is expected to rise. Alert may be kept in districts **Dehradun, Tehri Garwal, Pauri Garhwal, Bageshwar, Pithograh, Champawat** and **Nanital**.

2.2.1.2 Uttar Pradesh

Presently river **Ghaghra** is flowing above Danger Level in **Barabanki**, **Ayodhya & Ballia**. River **Rapti** is flowing in severe to above normal flood situations in **Balrampur**, **Siddharth Nagar & Gorakhpur districts**. River **Gandak** in **Kushinagar is** also flowing in severe flooding situation. Alert may be kept in districts Siddharth Nagar & Sant Kabir Nagar.

2.2.1.3 Bihar

Widespread rainfall happened in Nepal during last 24 hrs and stations located in river basins such as Narayani, Mahakali, Tinau, Banganga, Kosi, Kamala, Bagmati received very heavy rains. Rather heavy to heavy rains were also recorded in Gandaki, Churiya, West Rapti, Karnali, Babai, Kankai etc. With this background it is expected that rivers such as Gandak, Bagmati, Adhwara, Kosi and other rivers of Bihar originating in Nepal may further rise in next 2 days.

Presently, river Ghaghra is flowing above Danger Level in Siwan district. River Gandak in Gopalganj & Muzaffarpur, River Burhi Gandak in Muzaffarpur, Samastipur & Khagaria, River Bagmati in Sitamarhi, Muzzafarpur & Darbhanga, River Adhwara in Darbhanga, Rivers Kamla & Kamlabalan in Madhubani, River Kosi in Supaul, Khagaria & Katihar, River Parman in Araria and River Mahananda in Kishanganj, Purnia & Katihar are flowing in severe to above normal flood situations.

Presently, main Ganga River is flowing in above normal to severe flood situations in districts **Patna & Bhagalpur (Bihar)** with falling trends. River **Punpun** in **Patna** is also flowing above danger level.

2.2.1.4 Jharkhand

Main Ganga in **Sahibganj** is flowing above danger level.

2.2.1.5 West Bengal

Main Ganga in Murshirabad is flowing above danger level.

2.2.2 Brahmaputra and its tributaries, Barak and Others

Due to forecasted very heavy rainfall in Upper and Middle Brahmaputra basin, river levels in Brahmaputra and its tribuatries such as Teesta, Sankosh, Jaldhaka, Torsa, Manas, Beki, Raidak, Aie, Pagaladiya, Puthimari, Dhansiri are expected to rise in next 2 days.

2.2.2.1 Arunachal Pradesh

River Siang in East Siang district is flowing above danger level. Alert may be kept in districts West Siang & Upper Siang also.

2.2.2.2 Assam

Due to past one week rainfall, **Brahmaputra** main river is flowing in above normal to severe flood situations in **Dibrugarh**, **Jorhat**, **Sonitpur**, **Goalpara**, **Kamrup & Dhubri** districts. Also tributaries of Brahmaputra namely **Beki** river in **Barpeta** district, **Jia-Bharali** river in **Sonitpur**, **Pagladiya** river in **Nalbari**, **Gaurang** river in **Kokrajhar**, **Dikhow** river in **Sibsagar**, **Sankosh** river in **Dhubri**, Subansiri & Ranganadi in **Lakimpur** are flowing in above normal flood situations to severe flood situations. Alert may be kept in districts **Chirang** and **Kokrajhar** in **Assam**

2.2.2.3 Sub-Himalayan West Bengal

Torsa & Raidak-1 rivers in Coochbihar is flowing above warning level.

2.2.3 Rivers from Tadri to Kanyakumari – Kerala & Tamilnadu

Due to formation of Low Pressure Area in Bay of Bengal, very heavy to heavy rains are forecasted in districts of Idukki, Kannur, Wayanad, Palakkad, Kozhikode, Malappuram, Pattanamthitta & Palakkad (Kerala) and Dindigul, Teni, Coimbatore & Nilgris (Tamilnadu) for next 3 days, hence alert may be kept. So inflow into Idukki, Edamalayar is expected to rise. Rise is also expected in other medium to major dams situated in Kerala in the river basins of Periyar, upper Periyar, Chalakudi, Pamba & Meenachil.

2.2.4 Krishna Basin

Most of the dams in Upper Krishna Basin are having very high storages. Almatti (100%), Narayanpur (97%), Malaprabha (96%), Bhadra (98%), Ghataprabha (100%) and Tungabhadra (98%) dams are more than 95% filled up. Dams P. D. Jurala, Srisailam, Koyna, Warna, Musi & Veer are also having high storages (more than 80%). Round the clock watch has to be maintained for proper reservoir operation. Releases from any of these reservoirs may be done as per rule curve and standard operating procedure by prior informing the lower riparian areas.

2.2.5 Cauvery Basin

Dams in Cauvery Basin are having storages more than 85% namely **Harangi (94%), Kabini (93%), Hemavathi (90%)** and **KRS (85%).** Round the clock watch has to be maintained for proper reservoir operation. Releases from any of these reservoirs may be done as per rule curve and standard operating procedure by prior informing the lower riparian areas.

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 28.08.2021:


Moderate to High Risk over few watersheds and neighborhood of SHWB & Sikkim, Assam & Meghalaya and Arunachal Pradesh met subdivision in next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 28.08.2021:

Moderate to High Risk over few watersheds and neighborhood of Uttarakhand met subdivision in next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.



3.0 Storage Position in Dams where Inflow forecast is being issued by CWC as on 27th August, 2021

Reservoirs shown in red are having gross storage capacity more than 80% and those in orange are having gross storage greater than 60%. Close watch is to be maintained at these reservoirs whenever Very Heavy Rainfall (Orange) and Extremely Heavy Rainfall (Red) warning in next 120 hours are given below:
