




1.2 Rainfall forecast for next 5 days issued on 29th July 2024 (Midday) by IMD




2.0 Flood Situation and Advisories

2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 29thJuly 2024, 4 Stations (2 in Bihar and1 each in Andhra Pradesh & Uttar Pradesh) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 25 stations (6 each in Assam & Uttar Pradesh, 5 in Bihar, 3 in Andhra Pradesh and1 each in Kerala, Maharashtra, Sikkim, Telangana & West Bengal) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 31 Dams and barrages (12 in Karnataka, 3 each in Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Telangana & Uttar Pradesh, 2 each in Maharashtra & Tamilnadu and 1 each in Gujrat, Odisha & Uttrakhand).

Flood Situation Map




2.2 Flash Flood Guidance

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 30-07-2024 :

Low flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of West Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat Region, North Konkan & Goa and Saurashtra & Kutch Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.



2.3 CWC Advisories

Main Synoptic Feature and Rainfall (as per IMD)

- The Monsoon trough is active and south of its normal position at mean sea level. It is likely to shift gradually northwards during next 4-5 days.
- A cyclonic circulation over southeast Madhya Pradesh & neighbourhood in lower & middle tropospheric levels.
- The shear zone now runs roughly along 20°N over Indian region between 3.1 & 7.6 km above mean sea level tilting southwards with height.
- The off-shore trough at mean sea level now runs along South Gujarat to Kerala coast.
- A cyclonic circulation lies over northeast Arabian Sea and adjoining Saurashtra in lower tropospheric levels.
- 1. Very heavy rainfall very likely at isolated places over Gujarat Region on 29th; Saurashtra & Kutch on 29th & 30th; Konkan & Goa on 01st August; East Madhya Pradesh during 31st July- 02nd August; ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh on 01st & 02nd August, . West Madhya Pradesh on 02nd August.
- Isolated very heavy rainfall also likely over East Rajasthan on 29th; Uttarakhand during 29th July- 02nd August, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu-Kashmir-Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad on 31st July & 01st August, HaryanaChandigarh, West Uttar Pradesh, West Rajasthan on 31st July.
- 3. Very heavy rainfall very likely at isolated places over Kerala & Mahe on 29th; Coastal & South Interior Karnataka on 29th & 30th July.
- **4.** Very heavy rainfall very likely at isolated places over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 29th July- 01st August, Arunachal Pradesh on 01st & 02nd August, Odisha on 31st July & 01st August.

Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh

Increased water levels are expected in Hemavathy, Ghataprabha, Kabini, Harangi, Shambhavi, Swarna, Sharavati, Haladi, Aghanashini, Netravathi, Sita, Varada, Gurpur, Upper Tunga, Mandovi, Zuari and small rivers in Dakshin Kannada, Udupi, Uttara Kannada, Shimoga, Chikmangallur, Kodagu, Above threshold inflows are expected into projects such as Tungabhadra, Upper Tunga, Bhadra, Harangi, Hidkal, Krishnarajasagar, Kabini, Hemavathy, Almatti, Krishnarajasagar, Narayanapur, Malaprabha and other projects located in Tungabhadra and Krishna rivers for next 2 days. All the said projects may be operated as per SOP releases may be done after informing downstream areas.

Gujarat

Due to very heavy rainfall in Gujarat and Saurashtra region, water level rise and flood like situations are expected in Vishwamitry, Purna, Ambia, Mindhola, Kaveri, Damanganga, Mahi, Sabarmati, Banas, lower Tapi and Narmada and it's tributaries for next 2 days. Water level rise and flood like situations are also expected in rivers such as Vatru, Hiran, Bhadar, Sani, Ozat, Madhuwati, Saraswati, Machhundri for next 2 days. Increased inflow is expected into projects such as Mahi dam, Kadana, Ukai, Madhuban, Panam, Dantiwada, SS dam, Shetrunji and Bhadar projects. Dams may be operated as per SOP and releases may be done after informing downstream regions.

Maharashtra

Increased inflows are expected into Hathnur dam. Increased runoff is expected in Krishna river in Satara, Kolhapur districts.
