

1.0 Rainfall Situation



 Gujarat Region and Konkan & Goa on 01st Sept. and over Gujarat State on 02nd September, 2021.


2.0 Flood Situation and Advisories

2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 29th August, 2021, 38 Stations (21 in Bihar, 7 each in Uttar Pradesh & Assam and 1 each in Arunachal Pradesh, Jharkhand & West Bengal) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation and 24 stations (18 in Bihar, 3 in Uttar Pradesh, 2 each in Tamil Nadu, 1 in West Bengal) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 16 Barrages &Dams (3 each inTamilnadu, Jharkhand & Uttar Pradesh, 2 each in Karnataka & Andhra Pradesh, 1 each in West Bengal, Odisha & Uttarakhand)

2.2 CWC Advisories

2.2.1 Ganga Basin- Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand & West Bengal

2.2.1.1 Uttarakhand

Water level in rivers Bhagirathi, Alaknanda, Mandakini, Ganga, Ramganga, Sharda, etc. is expected to rise. Alert may be kept in districts **Dehradun, Udham Singh Nagar, Bageshwar, Pithograh, Champawat** and **Nanital**.

2.2.1.2 Uttar Pradesh

Presently river **Ghaghra** is flowing above Danger Level in **Barabanki**, **Ayodhya** & **Ballia districts** with rising trend. River **Rapti** is flowing in severe flood situations in **Balrampur**, **Siddharth Nagar** & **Gorakhpur districts** and Gandak in **Kushinagar** district is flowing above warning level. Main Ganga is flowing in severe to above normal flood situation with rising trend in **Hapur**, **Budaun** & **Farukkabad** with rising trends.

2.2.1.3 Bihar

Presently, river Ghaghra is flowing above Danger Level in Siwan district with rising trend. River Gandak in Purba Champaran, Gopalganj & Muzaffarpur, River Burhi Gandak in Purba Champaran, Muzaffarpur, Samastipur & Khagaria, River Bagmati in Sitamarhi, Muzzafarpur & Darbhanga, River Adhwara in Darbhanga, Rivers Kamla & Kamlabalan in Madhubani, River Kosi in Supaul, Khagaria & Katihar, River Parman in Araria and River Mahananda in Kishanganj, Purnia & Katihar districts are flowing in severe to above normal flood situations. The rivers like Gandak may rise further due to heavy inflows passing from Gandak Barrage at Valmikinagar.

Presently, main Ganga River is flowing in above normal to severe flood situations in districts **Patna**, **Munger & Bhagalpur** districts with rising trend. River **Punpun** in **Patna** district is also flowing above danger level but with falling trend.

2.2.1.4 Jharkhand

Main Ganga in **Sahibganj** district is flowing above danger level with rising trend.

2.2.1.5 West Bengal

Main Ganga in Murshirabad district is flowing above danger level with rising trend

2.2.2 Brahmaputra and its tributaries. Barak and Others

2.2.2.1 Arunachal Pradesh

River **Siang** in East Siang district is flowing above danger level with falling trend.

2.2.2.2 Assam

Due to past one week rainfall, **Brahmaputra** main river is flowing in above normal to severe flood situations in **Dibrugarh**, **Jorhat**, **Sonitpur**, **Goalpara**, **Kamrup & Dhubri** districts. Also tributaries of Brahmaputra namely **Beki** river in **Barpeta**, **Jia-Bharali** river in **Sonitpur**, **Dikhow** river in **Sibsagar**, **Sankosh** river in **Dhubri**, **Subansiri** in **Lakimpur**, **Gaurang** in **Kokrajhar**, **Puthimari** in **Kamrup** districts are flowing in above normal to severe flood situations.

Kushiyara river (Barak and others) in Karimgani (Assam) are flowing in above normal flood situation.

2.2.2.3 Sub-Himalayan West Bengal

Torsa river in Coochbihar district is flowing above warning level.

2.2.3 Rivers from Tadri to Kanyakumari - Kerala & Tamilnadu

Due to formation of Low Pressure Area in Bay of Bengal, very heavy to heavy rains are forecasted in districts of Kannur, Kozhikode, Wayanad, Palakkad, Malappuram, Kottayam, Thrissur, Eranakulam (Kerala) and Teni, Coimbatore & Nilgris (Tamilnadu) for next 2 days, hence alert may be kept. Inflows into Idukki, Edamalayar dams are expected to rise. Water level rise is also expected in other medium to major dams situated in Kerala in the river basins of Periyar, upper Periyar, Chalakudi, Pamba & Meenachil.

2.2.4 Krishna Basin – Karnataka, Andra Pradesh, Telangana

Most of the dams in Upper Krishna Basin are having very high storages. Almatti (100%), Narayanpur (97%), Malaprabha (96%), Bhadra (98%), Ghataprabha (100%) and Tungabhadra (98%) dams are more than 95% filled up. Dams P. D. Jurala, Srisailam, Koyna, Warna, Musi & Veer are also having high storages (more than 80%). Round the clock watch has to be maintained for proper reservoir operation. Releases from any of these reservoirs may be done as per rule curve and standard operating procedure by prior informing the lower riparian areas. Alert may be kept in rivers such as Bhima, Akeru, Palleru, Halla, etc and Mahabubad district (Telangana)

2.2.5 Cauvery Basin - Karnataka

Dams in Cauvery Basin are having storages more than 85% namely Harangi (94%), Kabini (93%), Hemavathi (90%) and KRS (85%). Round the clock watch has to be maintained for proper reservoir operation. Releases from any of these reservoirs may be done as per rule curve and standard operating procedure by prior informing the lower riparian areas. Alert may be kept in districts Uttar and Dakshin Kannada, Shimoga, Hassan, Kodagu, Chamarajanagar (Karnataka), Nilgris (Tamil Nadu), Wayanad (Kerala).

2.2.6 Godavari Basin - Telangana

Alert may be kept in Middle & Lower Godavari, Pranhita, Manjira, Manair, Sabari rivers specially in districts Kamareddy, Jagital, Suryapet, Nizamabad, Peddapalle, Karimnagar, Siddipet, Jangoan, Kumaram Bheem, Mancherial, Khammam, Warangal, Rajanna Sircilla.

IMD has issued flash flood risk over few watersheds and neighbourhoods of Kerala, Mahe & Coastal Karnataka met subdivisions.

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 30.08.2021:

Moderate Risk over few watersheds and neighborhood of Kerala & Mahe and Coastal Karnataka met subdivision in next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.



3.0 Storage Position in Dams where Inflow forecast is being issued by CWC as on 28thAugust, 2021
Reservoirs shown in red are having gross storage capacity more than 80% and those in orange are having gross storage greater than 60%. Close watch is to be maintained at these reservoirs whenever Very Heavy Rainfall (Orange) and Extremely Heavy Rainfall (Red) warning in next 120 hours are given below:
