





2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 30thSeptember, 2023, No Stations are flowing in Severe Flood Situation. 5 stations (4 in Bihar, 1 in Jharkhand) are flowing in Above Normal Flood situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 11 Dams and Barrages (2 each in Tamil Nadu, Jharkhand and Telangana and 1 each in Maharashtra, Gujarat, Karnataka, Odisha and West Bengal).

2.2 CWC Advisories

Maharashtra and Goa

Due to intensification of monsoon current and presence Low Pressure Area in East Central Arabian Sea off Konkan Coast, IMD has predicted very heavy to extremely heavy rains in **Goa** and in districts **Ratnagiri**, **Sindhudurg, Kolhapur**. Hence keep alert for water rise in rivers such as Jog, Vashisti, Gautami, Kajvi, Machkund (**Ratnagiri** district), Vagothan, Narangi, Gad, Terekhol, Thillari, Mandavi, Zuari (**Sindudurg** dist. And Goa), rivers of upper Krishna basin (**Kolhapur** dist.) and other small west flowing rivers in the mentioned regions. All major /medium dams may be operated as per SOP and releases may be done after informing lower riparian regions.

Odisha

Due to Low Pressure Area, very heavy rains are expected in almost all north and middle regions of Odisha for next 2 to 3 days. Keep alert for water level rise in river Subernarekha in Mayurbhanj, Baleshwar dists., rivers of Brahmani and Baitarni in Jajpur, Bhadrak, Kenjuhar, Kendraparha, Dhenkanal, Anugul, Deogarh, Sundargarh dists., river Mahanadi and its tributaries in Anugul, Sundargarh, Cuttack, Jagatsinghpur, Jharsuguda, Bargarh, Subarnapur, Bolangir districts. All major /medium dams may be operated as per SOP and releases may be done after informing lower riparian regions.

Kerala

As per IMD, due to intensification of monsoon current very heavy rains are expected in districts **Ernakulam, Pattanamthitta, Alappuzha, Kollam and Tiruvananthapuram**. Keep alert for water level rise in Periyar, Manimala, Thodupuzha, Pamba, Achankoil and in rivers of **Tiruvananthapuram** district such as Vamanapuram, Mamom, Karamana, Neyyar. Current flood situation in the state as per CWC network is as follows:

Jharkhand

IMD has predicted very heavy rains in **Gumla, Khunti, Simdega, Pachim Singbhumi** districts for next 48 hrs, hence keep alert for water level rise in Sankh, South Koel rivers and its tributaries over the regions.


West Bengal

IMD has predicted very heavy rains in **Jhargram**, **Purba Medinipur**, **Paschim Medinipur**, **Bankura** districts for next 48 hrs, hence keep alert for water level rise in Kasai, Subarnerekha rivers and its tributaries over the regions.

24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 01-10-2023 :

Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of North Odisha, Gangetic West Bengal, Jharkhand & adjoining Bihar Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.



24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 01-10-2023:

Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of Coastal Karnataka, North Kerala & Mahe and Southern Parts of Konkan & Goa Met Subdivisions during next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.

Note- Based on above information, Project Authority may regulate the reservoirs as per standard operating manuals/ rule levels to avoid downstream flooding and upstream submergence
