

1.0 **Rainfall Situation**


1.1 District wise departure from normal of cumulative and daily rainfall


2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 30thAugust 2023, 19 stations (9 in Bihar, 2 in Uttar Pradesh and 8 in Assam) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 32 stations (13 in Bihar, 8 each in Assam & Uttar Pradesh. 1 in Jharkhand and 2 in West Bengal) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 4 Dams and Barrages (1 each in Uttar Pradesh & Uttrakhand and 2 in Tamil Nadu).
