


Central Water Commission Daily Flood Situation Report cum Advisories 30-08-2021

1.0 Rainfall Situation


1.1 Basin wise departure from normal of cumulative and daily rainfall

Very heavy rainfall over Marathwada and Telangana on 30th August; Madhya Maharashtra on 31st August; Konkan & Goa on 31st August & 01st September and over Gujarat State during 01st - 02nd September, 2021.

2.0 Flood Situation and Advisories


2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 30th August, 2021, 41 Stations (22 in Bihar, 8 each in Uttar Pradesh & Assam and 1 each in Arunachal Pradesh, Jharkhand & West Bengal) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation and 20 stations (10 in Bihar, 6 in Assam, 2 each in Uttar Pradesh and Tamil Nadu) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 17 Barrages & Dams (3 each in Tamil Nadu, Telengana & Uttar Pradesh, 2 each in Karnataka, Jharkhand & Andhra Pradesh, 1 each in West Bengal & Uttar Pradesh).

2.2 CWC Advisories

2.2.1 Ganga Basin- Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand & West Bengal

2.2.1.1 Uttar Pradesh

In Ghagra and Rapti rivers the flood wave created due to heavy rainfall has progressed downstream, so the upper reaches of these rivers are in steady to falling conditions. Presently, river **Ghagra** is flowing above Danger Level in **Barabanki**, **Ayodhya & Ballia districts**. River **Rapti** is flowing in severe flood situations in **Balrampur**, **Siddharth Nagar & Gorakhpur districts** and **Gandak** in **Kushinagar** district is flowing above warning level. Main Ganga is flowing in severe to above normal flood situation with rising trend in **Budaun & Farukkabad** with rising trends.

2.2.1.2 Bihar

Presently, river Ghagra is flowing above Danger Level in Siwan district with rising trend. River Gandak in Purba Champaran, Gopalganj & Muzaffarpur, River Burhi Gandak in Purba Champaran, Muzaffarpur, Samastipur & Khagaria, River Bagmati in Sitamarhi, Muzzafarpur & Darbhanga, River Adhwara in Darbhanga, Rivers Kamla & Kamlabalan in Madhubani, River Kosi in Supaul, Khagaria & Katihar, River Parman in Araria and River Mahananda in Kishanganj, Purnia & Katihar districts are flowing in severe to above normal flood situations. The rivers like Gandak may rise further due to heavy inflows passing from Gandak Barrage at Valmikinagar.

Presently, main Ganga River is flowing in above normal to severe flood situations in districts **Patna**, **Munger & Bhagalpur** districts with rising trend. River **Punpun** in **Patna** district is also flowing above danger level but with falling trend.

2.2.1.3 Jharkhand

Main Ganga in **Sahibganj** district is flowing above danger level with rising trend.

2.2.1.4 West Bengal

Main Ganga in Murshirabad district is flowing above danger level with rising trend

2.2.2 Brahmaputra and its tributaries, Barak and Others

2.2.2.1 Arunachal Pradesh

River **Siang** in East Siang district is flowing above warning level with falling trend.

2.2.2.2 Assam

Due to past one week rainfall, **Brahmaputra** main river is flowing in above normal to severe flood situations in **Dibrugarh**, **Jorhat**, **Sonitpur**, **Goalpara**, **Kamrup & Dhubri** districts. Also tributaries of Brahmaputra namely **Beki** river in **Barpeta**, **Jia-Bharali** river in **Sonitpur**, **Dikhow** river in **Sibsagar**, **Sankosh** river in **Dhubri**, **Subansiri** in **Lakimpur**, **Dhansiri** south river in **Golaghat**, **Gaurang** in **Kokrajhar**, **Puthimari** in **Kamrup** districts are flowing in above normal to severe flood situations.

Kushiyara river (Barak and others) in Karimganj (Assam) are flowing in above normal flood situation.

2.2.4 Krishna Basin - Karnataka, Andra Pradesh, Telangana

Most of the dams in Upper Krishna Basin are having very high storages. Almatti (100%), Narayanpur (97%), Malaprabha (96%), Bhadra (98%), Ghataprabha (100%) and Tungabhadra (98%) dams are more than 95% filled up. Dams P. D. Jurala, Srisailam, Koyna, Warna, Musi & Veer are also having high storages (more than 80%). Round the clock watch has to be maintained for proper reservoir operation. Releases from any of these reservoirs may be done as per rule curve and standard operating procedure by prior informing the lower riparian areas. Alert may be kept in rivers such as Bhima, Akeru, Palleru, Halla, etc and Guntur and Krishna district.

2.2.6 Godavari Basin - Telangana, Andra Pradesh

Alert may be kept in Penganag, Purna, Middle & Upper Godavari, Maneru, Manjira rivers especially in districts East Godavari, West Godavari (Andra Pradesh), Adilabad, Nirmal, Kamareddy, Jagital, Nizamabad, Peddapalle, Karimnagar, Siddipet, Medak, Sangareddy, Kumaram Bheem, & Rajanna Sircilla (Telangana).

2.2.7 Tapi Basin, Damanganga Basin - Gujarat, Maharasthra

Heavy rains are expected in Upper, Middle & Lower Tapi reaches, hence, alert may be kept for next 2 days. Increased inflows are expected in Ukai and Hathnur dams. Damanganga basin is also expected to receive heavy rains. Alert may be kept in Valsad and Navasari districts. Increased inflows are expected in Madhuban dam.

3.0 Storage Position in Dams where Inflow forecast is being issued by CWC as on 30thAugust, 2021
Reservoirs shown in red are having gross storage capacity more than 80% and those in orange are having gross storage greater than 60%. Close watch is to be maintained at these reservoirs whenever Very Heavy Rainfall (Orange) and Extremely Heavy Rainfall (Red) warning in next 120 hours are given below:
