


# Central Water Commission Daily Flood Situation Report cum Advisories 02-08-2022


#### 1.0 Rainfall Situation

#### 1.2 Rainfall forecast for next 5 days issued on 02nd August 2022 (Midday) by IMD



- Isolated extremely heavy rainfall over Tamil Nadu and Kerala & Mahe during 02nd-04th; South Interior Karnataka on 03rd-05th and over Coastal Karnataka during 02nd-05th August, 2022.
- Isolated very heavy rainfall over Rayalaseema on 02nd; South Interior Karnataka on 02nd & 06th; North Interior Karnataka during 04th-06th; Kerala & Mahe and Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal on 05th; Coastal Karnataka & Odisha on 06th; Konkan & Goa on 5th & 06th August, 2022.


#### 2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 02<sup>nd</sup>August2022,11stations(9in Biharand1 each in Uttar Pradesh&Assam)are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 24stations(7inAssam, 6 each in Bihar & Uttar Pradesh, 3 in West Bengal, 1 in Tamilnadu and Delhi)are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 18Barrages&Dams (5inKamataka,4in Tamilnadu, 3each in Andhra Pradesh,Uttar Pradesh &Telangana).

#### Kerala

IMD has predicted very heavy to extremely heavy rains in **most of the** districts for next 3 to 4 days. Alert for water level rise may be kept in Meenachil, Manimala, Pamba, Thodupuzha, Muvattupuzha, Periyar, Achankovil, Kallada, Vamanapuram, their tributaries. Increased inflow is expected into Idukki and Edamalayar dams. Present flooding situation in the State is as under:

#### Tamilnadu

IMD has predicted very heavy rains to extremely heavy rains in districts **Erode**, **Nilgris**, **Coimbatore**, **Thiruppur**, **Dindigul**, **Madurai and Virudhunagar**, **Theni**, **Thenkasi**, **Thirunelveli and Kanyakumari**for next 2 to 3 days hence alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Cauvery, Parambikulam, Aliyar, Vaigai, Vaippar, Thamirabharani and the tributaries of said rivers in above said districts. Major dams with high storages are as follows:

The dams may be operated as per SOP and <u>rule levels may be followed</u> and releases from the said dams may be done as per SOP after informing lower riparian areas.

#### Karnataka

IMD has predicted very heavy to extremely rains in districts **Uttara Kannada**, **Shimoga**, **Udupi**, **Chikmangalur**, **Hassan**, **Dakshin Kannada**, **Kodagu**, **Chitradurga**, **Bellary**, **Anantapuramu**. Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Kalinadi, Bhadra, Tungabhadra, Shimsha, Sharavati, Kumaradhara, Netravathi, Bedthi, Aghanashini, and other tributaries of Krishna and Cauvery rivers in above said districts. Projects such as Harangi, KRS, Kabini, Hemavathy, Bhadra, Tungabhadra, Ghatapura, Almatti and Narayanapura are having high storages hence dams may be operated as per SOP and releases from the said dams may be done as per SOP after informing lower riparian areas.

#### Bihar

Since very heavy rains has been recorded on Nepal portion of river Bagmati hence alert may be kept for water level rise in districts **Sitamarhi, Muzzafarpur and Samastipur**. Present flooding situation in the State is as under:

# Forecasted Flash Flood Threat (FFFT) till 1130 IST of 02.08.2022:


Moderate Flash flood threat over Ernakulam, Kottyam, Idukki, Alappuzha and Pattanamitia districts of Kerala & Mahe Met Sub-division likely in next 06 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 6 hours.

#### 24 hours Outlook for the Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 0530 IST of 03.08.2022:

Moderate Flash Flood Risk over Coastal Karnataka & adjoining parts of South Interior Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe Met Subdivision likely in next 24 hours.

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.

Note- Based on above information, Project Authority may regulate the reservoirs as per standard operating manuals/ rule levels to avoid downstream flooding and upstream submergence.
