


1.0 Rainfall Situation

- Isolated extremely heavy rainfall over ghat areas of Tamil Nadu and Kerala &Mahe on 04th andover Coastal & South Interior Karnataka on 05th August, 2022.
- Isolated very heavy rainfall over Rayalaseema on 04th; Coastal & South Interior Karnatakaduring 04th 06th; Kerala &Mahe on 05th; North Interior Karnataka on 05th; ghat areas of TamilNadu on 05th; Telangana during 06th 08th; Coastal Andhra Pradesh on 08th; Chhattisgarh during 05th-8th; Madhya Pradesh and Vidarbha and Gujarat State on 08th; Madhya Maharashtra and Konkan& Goa during 05th-08th August, 2022.


2.1 Summary of Flood Situation as per CWC Flood Forecasting Network

On 04th August 2022, 12stations (8in Bihar and 2 each in Uttar Pradesh & Tamilnadu) are flowing in Severe Flood Situation, 24 stations (9 in Bihar, 7 in Assam, 4 in Uttar Pradesh, and 1 each in Andhra Pradesh, Jharkhand, Kerala & West Bengal) are flowing in Above Normal Flood Situation. Inflow Forecast has been issued for 19 Barrages & Dams (6 in Karnataka, 4 in Tamilnadu, 3in Telangana and 2 each in Andhra Pradesh, Kerala & Uttar Pradesh).

2.2 CWC Advisories

Kerala

IMD has predicted very heavy rains to extremely heavy rains in districts Kasaragode, Kannur, Wyanad, Kozhikode, Malapuram, Palakkad, Thrissur, Idukki, Ernakulam, Kottayam, Alappuzha, Kollam and Pathanamthitta next 24 hours. Alert for water level rise may be kept in Meenachil, Manimala, Pamba, Chalakudy, Thodupuzha, Muvattupuzha, Periyar, Achankovil, Bharathapuzha their tributaries and in rivers of north Kerala. Due to very heavy rains in Chalakudy river upper catchment and dam releases, flood like situation may be expected in Chalakudy river in Thrissur district as well as in the regions of Ernakulam after river confluence with Periyar. Increased inflow is expected into Idukki and Edamalayar dams. Present flooding situation in the State as per CWC network is as under:

IMD has predicted very heavy rains to extremely heavy rains in districts **Nilgris**, **Coimbatore**, **Thiruppur**, **Dindigul**, **Theni**, **Virudhunagar and Thenkasi** next 2 days hence alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Cauvery, Parambikulam, Aliyar, Vaigai, Pandipuzha and the tributaries of said rivers in above said districts. Karnataka


IMD has predicted very heavy in districts **Uttara Kannada**, **Shimoga**, **Udupi**, **Chikmangalur**, **Dakshin Kannada**, **Kodagu**, **Dharwad**, **Gadag and Belgaum for next 2 to 3 days**. Alert for water level rise may be kept in rivers Kalinadi, Bhadra, Tungabhadra, Ghataprabha, Shimsha, Sharavati, Kumaradhara, Netravathi, Bedthi, Aghanashini, and other tributaries of Krishna and Cauvery rivers in above said districts. Projects such as Harangi, KRS, Kabini, Hemavathy, Bhadra, Tungabhadra, Ghataprabha, Almatti and Narayanapura are having high storages hence dams may be operated as per SOP and releases from the said dams may be done as per SOP after informing lower riparian areas. Present flooding situation in the State as per CWC network is as under:


